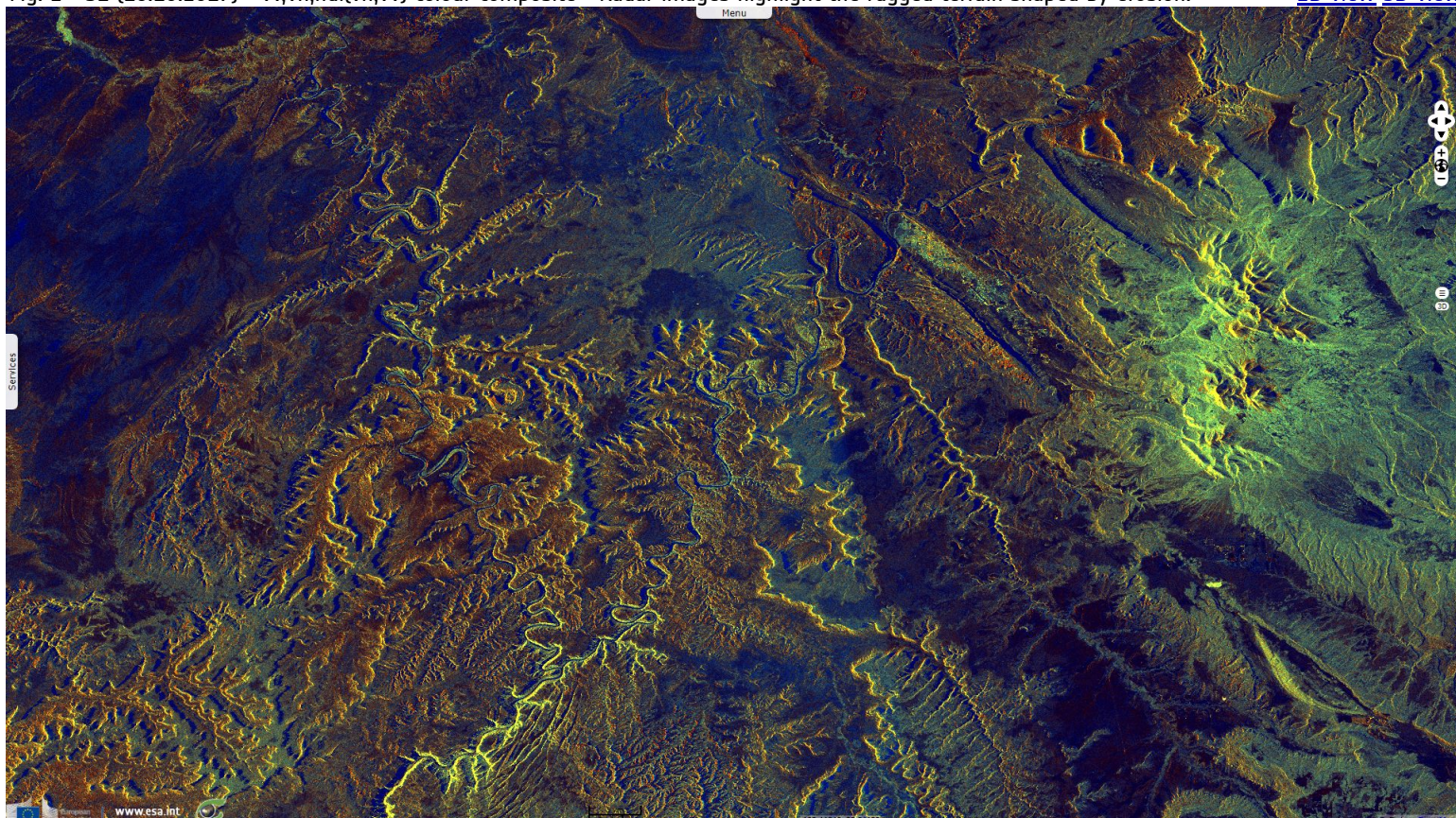


Fig. 3 - S1 (15.10.2017) - vh,vv,ndi(vh,vv) colour composite - Labyrinthine valleys, tableland, past & future oxbows.

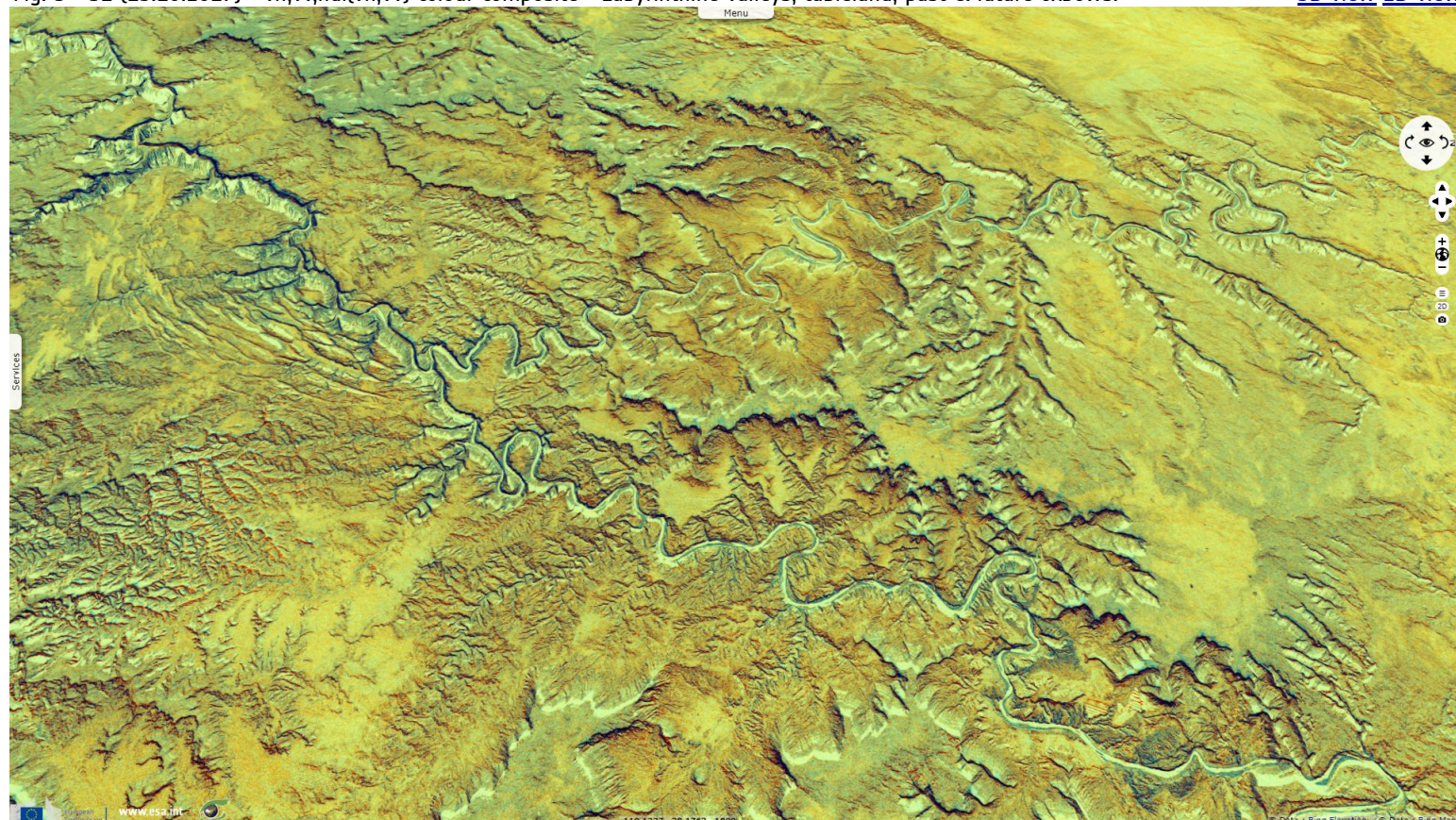
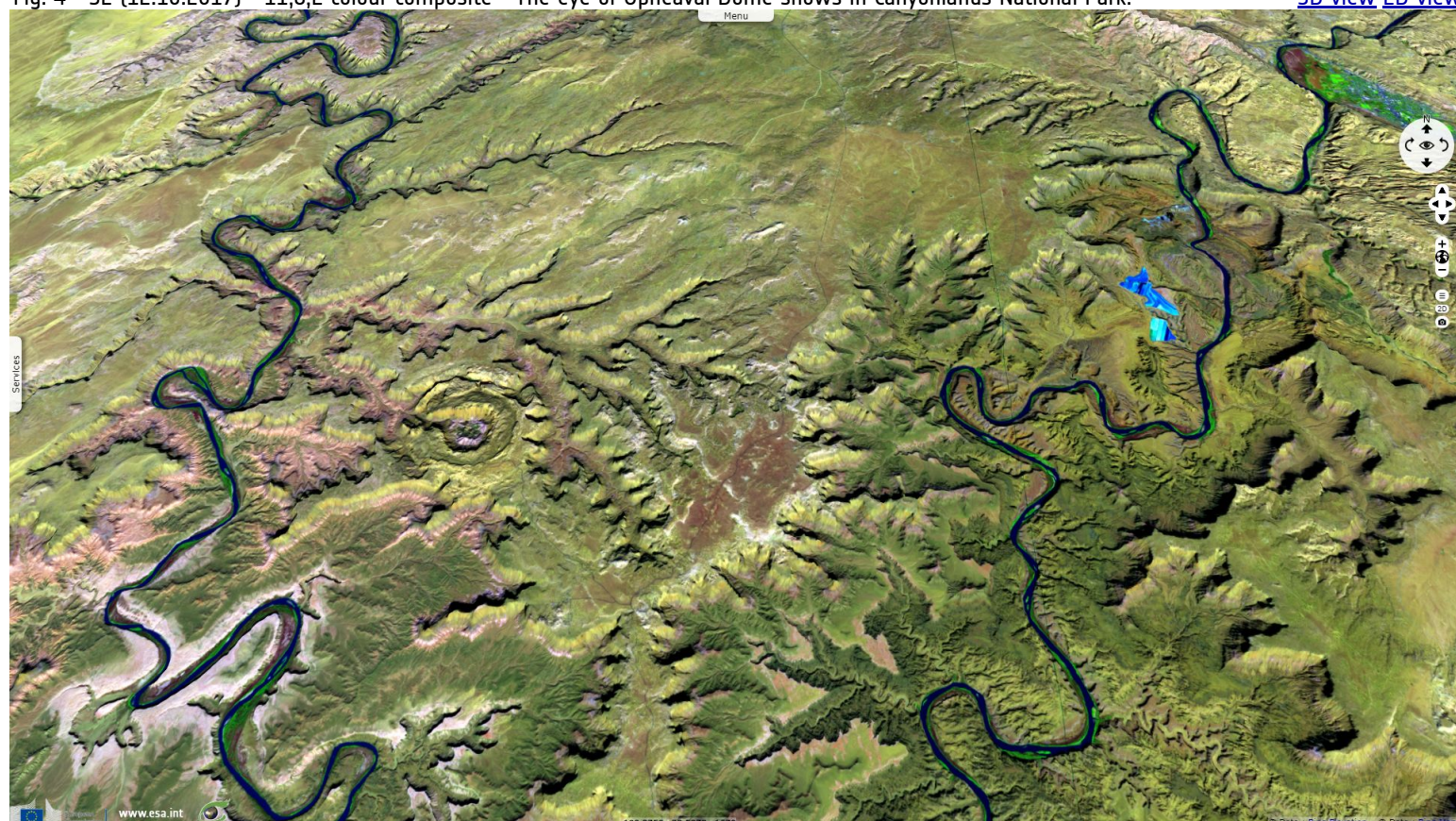


Fig. 4 - S2 (12.10.2017) - 11,8,2 colour composite - The eye of Upheaval Dome shows in Canyonlands National Park.
