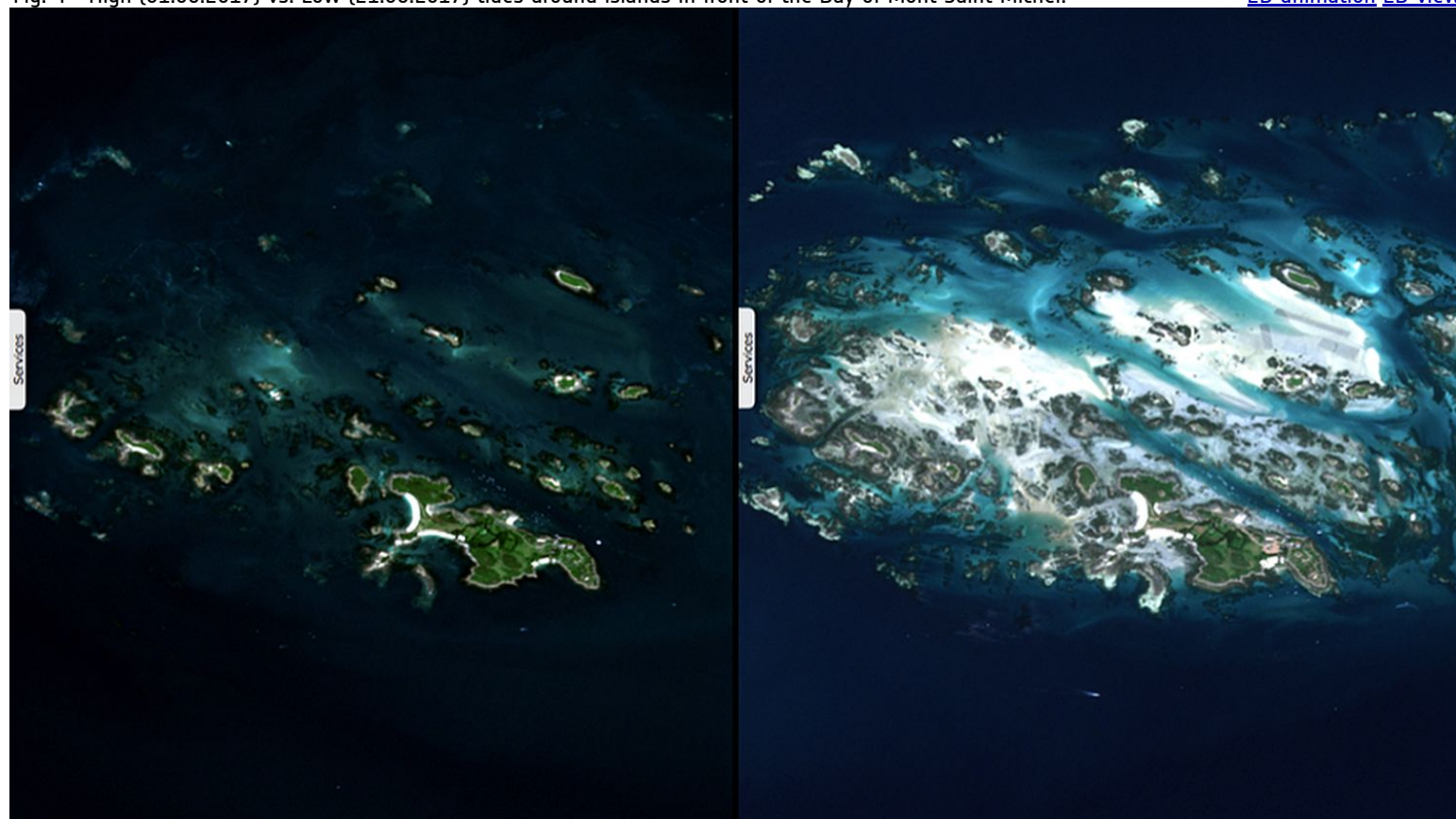
Fig. 3 - (21.06.2017) - Bay of Mont Saint Michel during low tide (tidal coefficient of 75).
