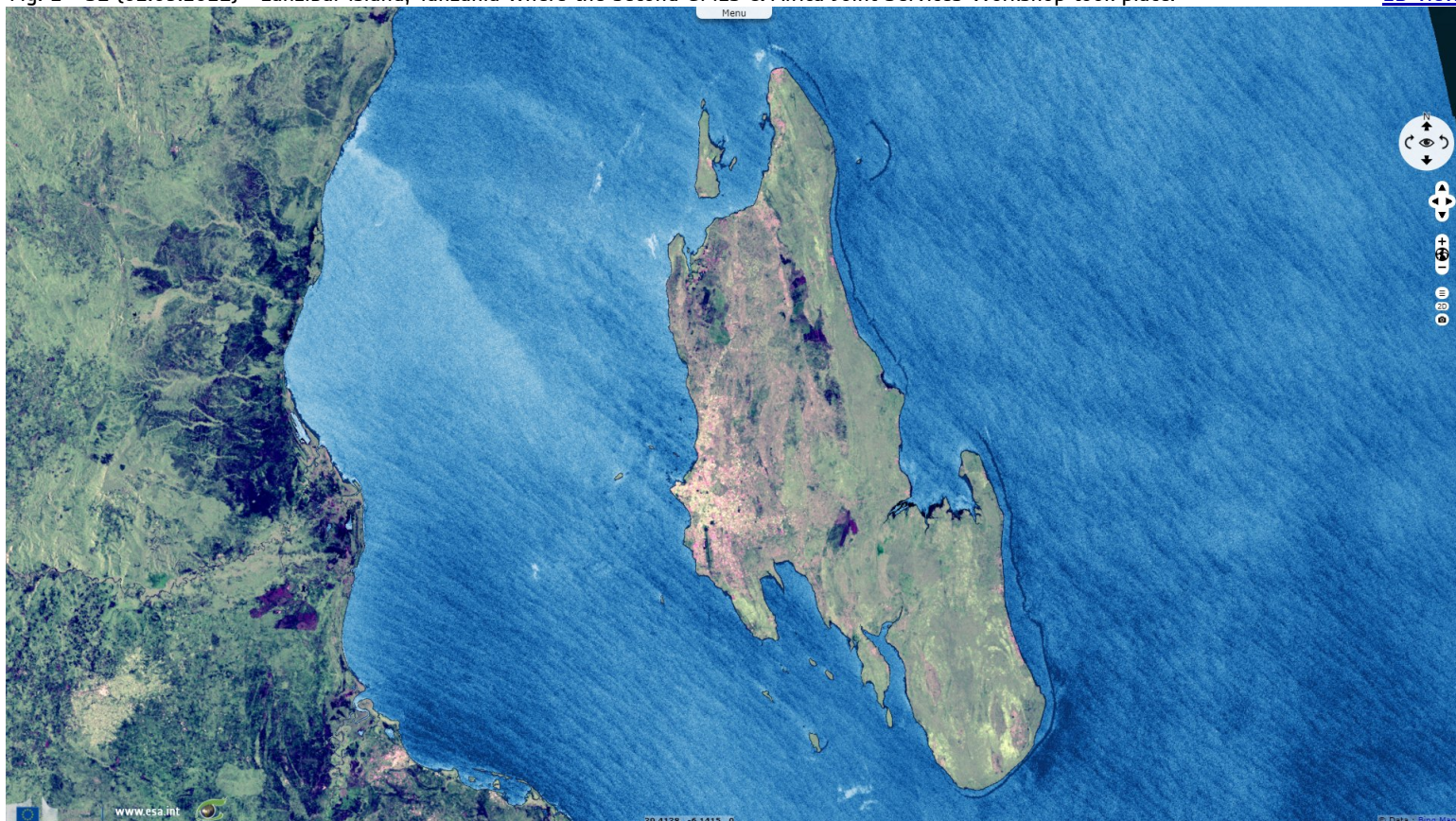


Fig. 3 - S1 (21.03.2020) - Large mangrove filled-coastline at north-east Kenya.

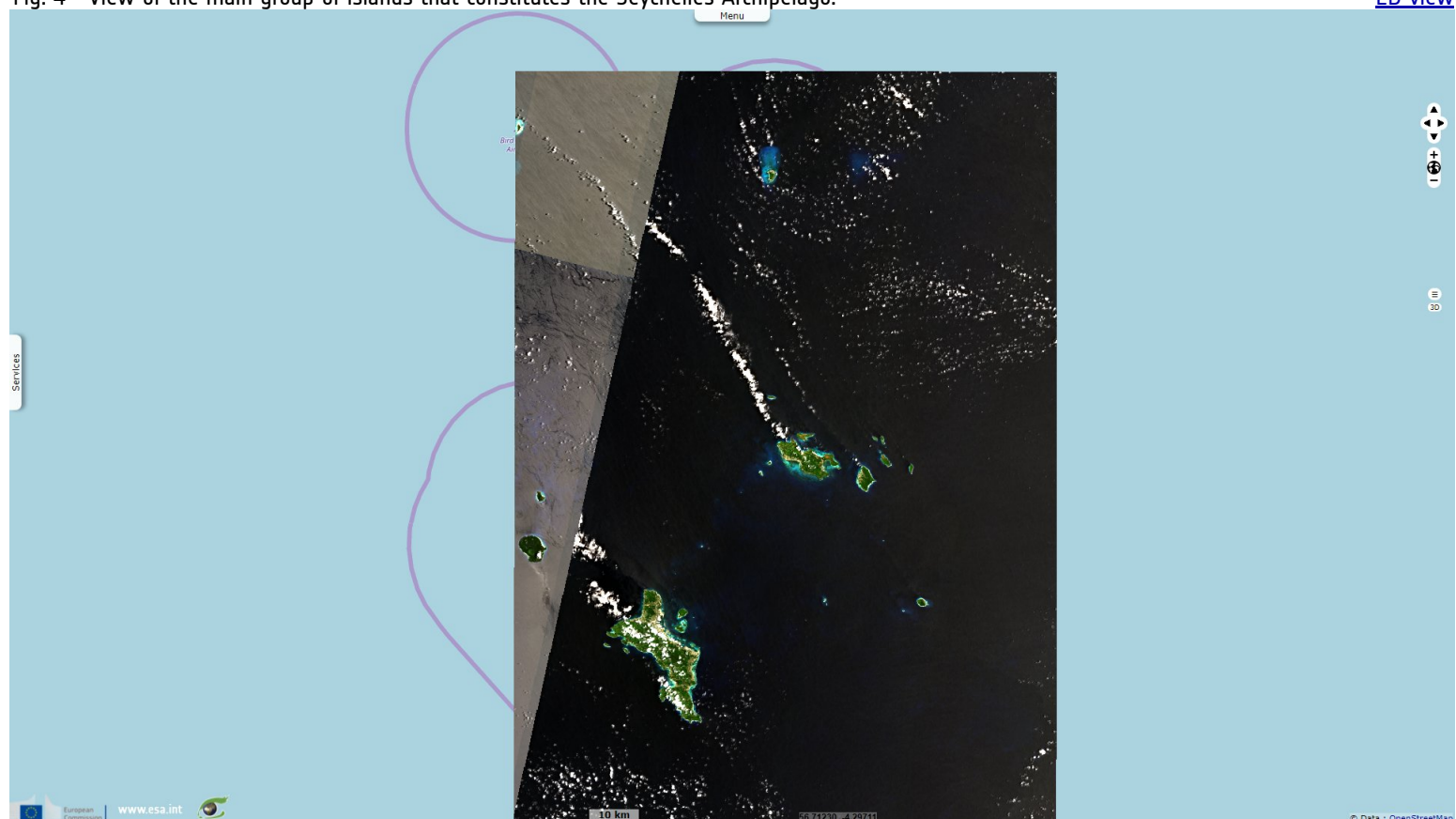


Fig. 5 - S2 (06.08.2020) - A bulk carrier caused at least 1000 tons of oil to spill in a coral reef S-E of Mauritius on 25 July 2020.

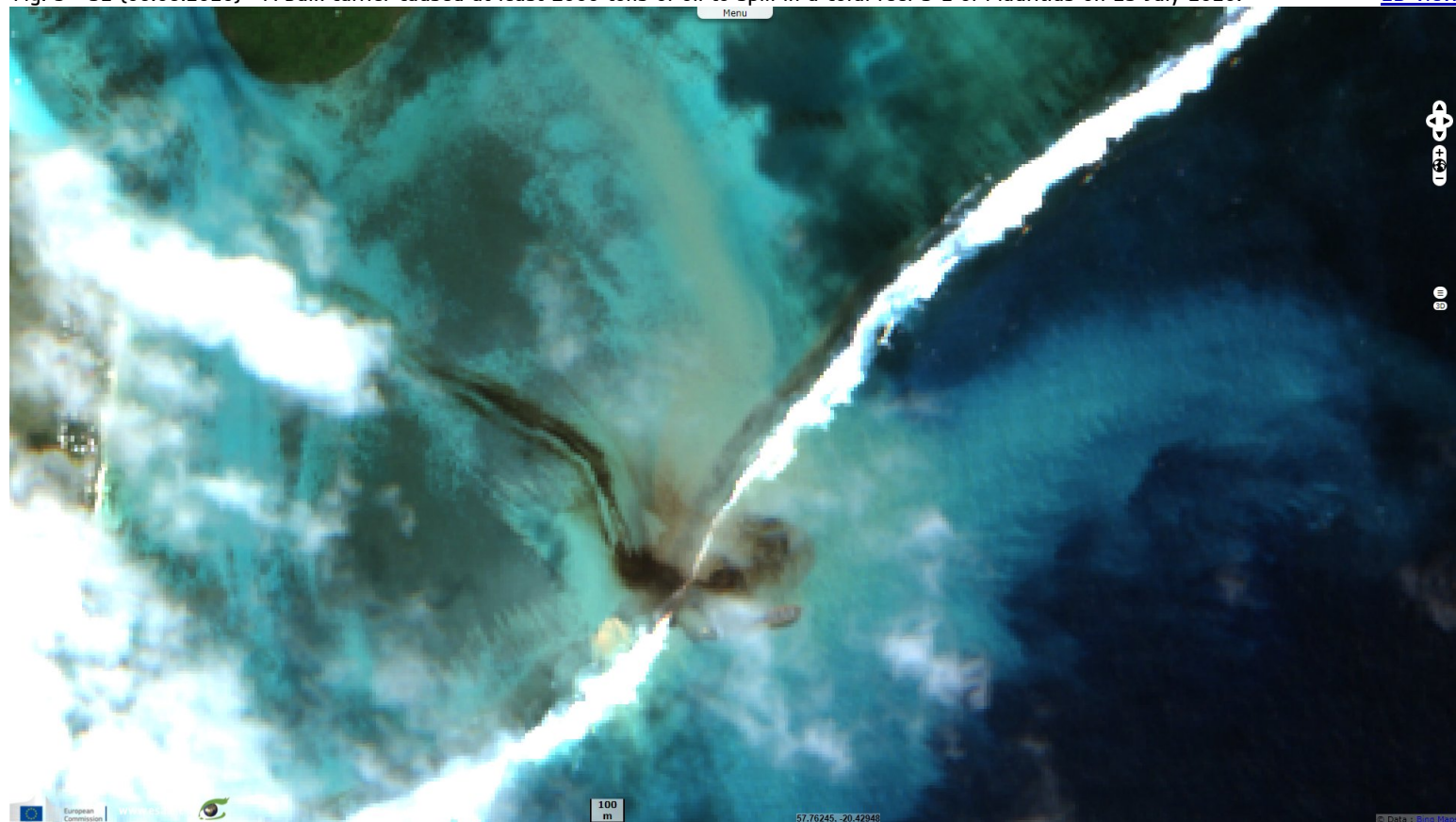


Fig. 6 - S2 (18.02.2018) - Madagascar is known for its coloured waters due to land erosion.
