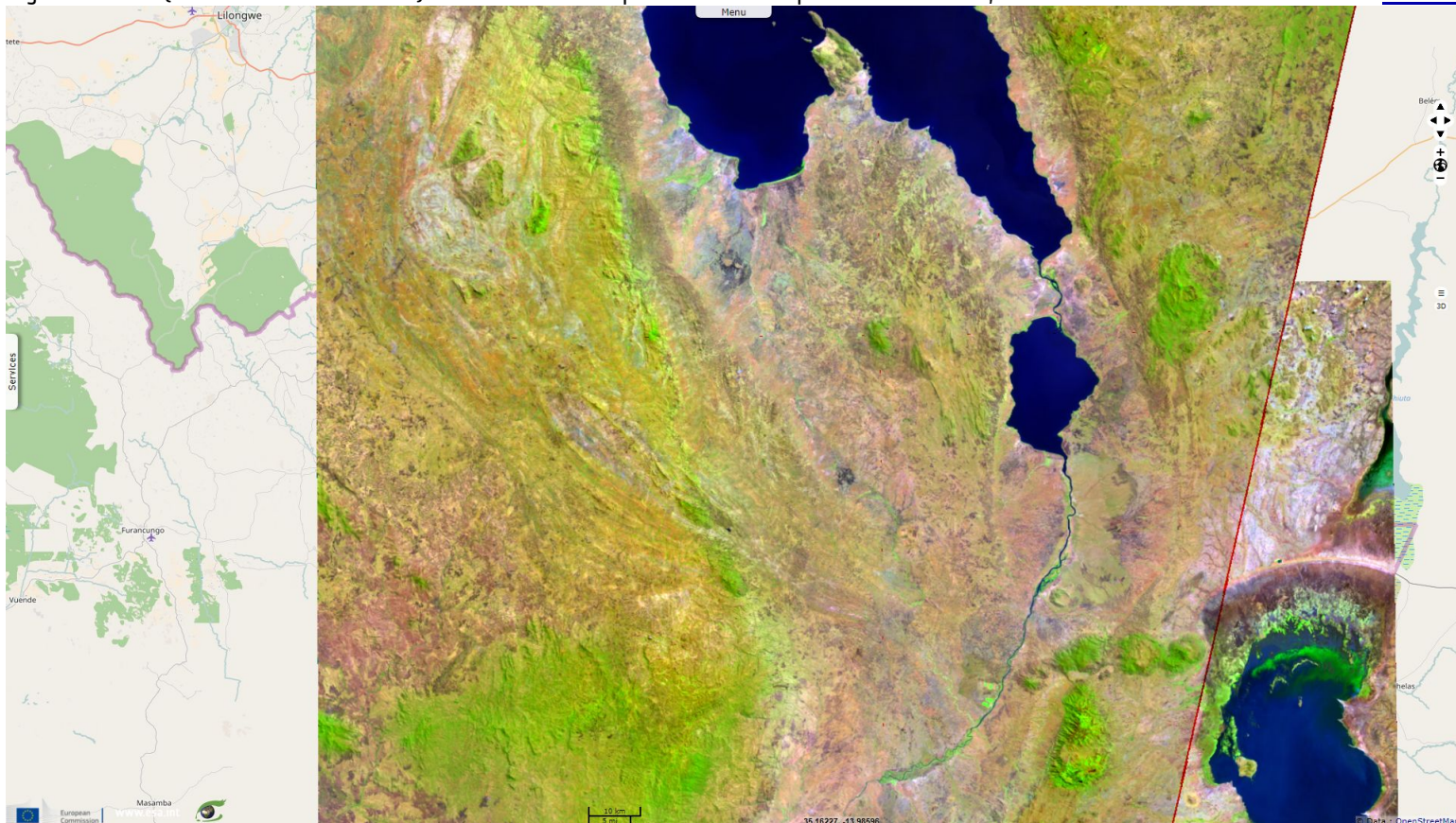


Fig. 2 - S2 MSI (22.08.2016 & 09.08.2016) - 4-3-2 natural colour - Water colour change from one lake to the next.

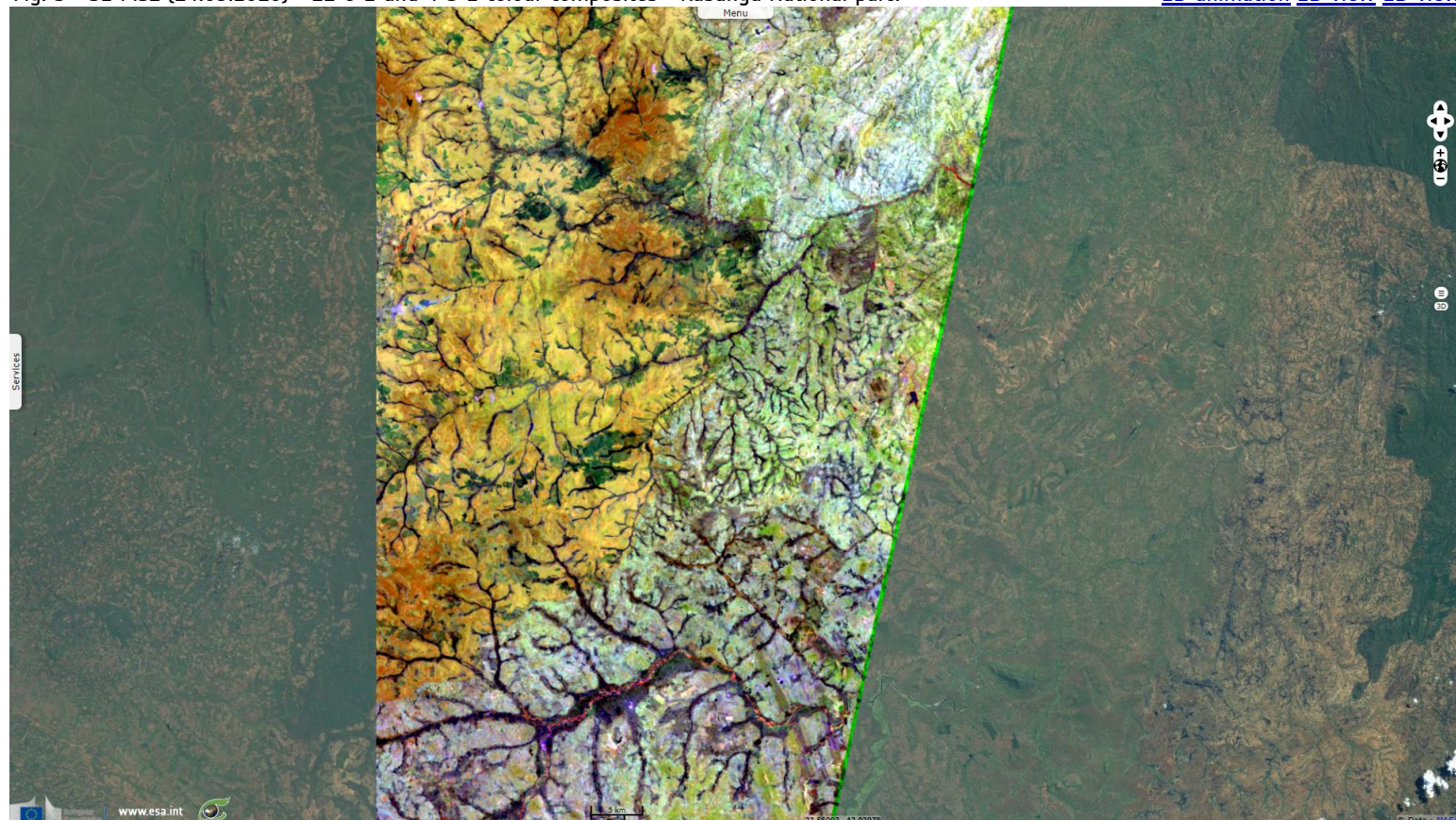


Fig. 4 - S2 MSI (22.08.2016) - 4-3-2 natural colour - Part of the huge rift Lake Malawi (also called Niassa) seen from its west bank. [3D view](#) [2D view](#)



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
