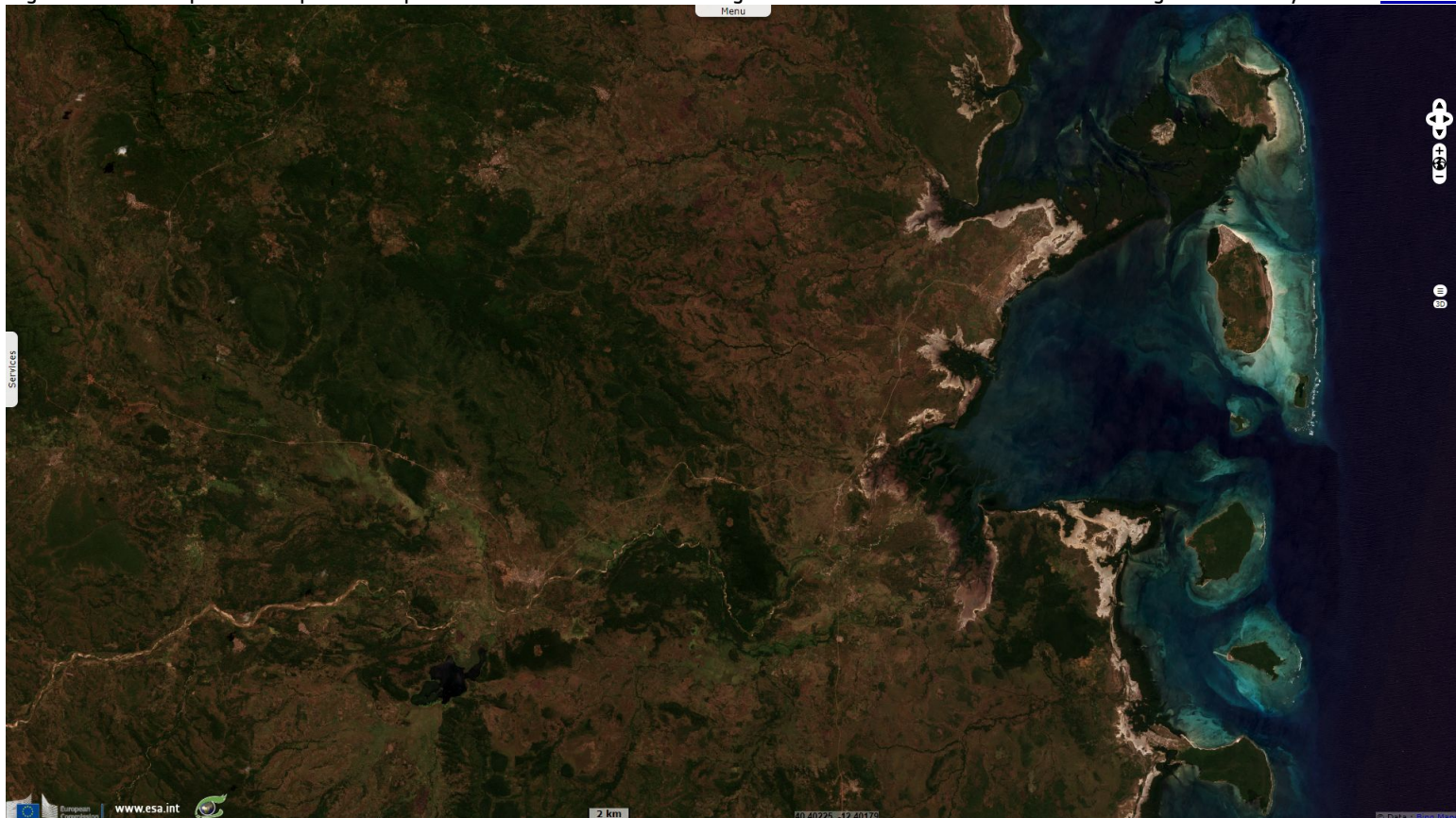


Fig. 3 - Zoom on Quiriba & Ibo islands, the sandy beaches contrasts with the bright blue water & the dark mangrove forests.
