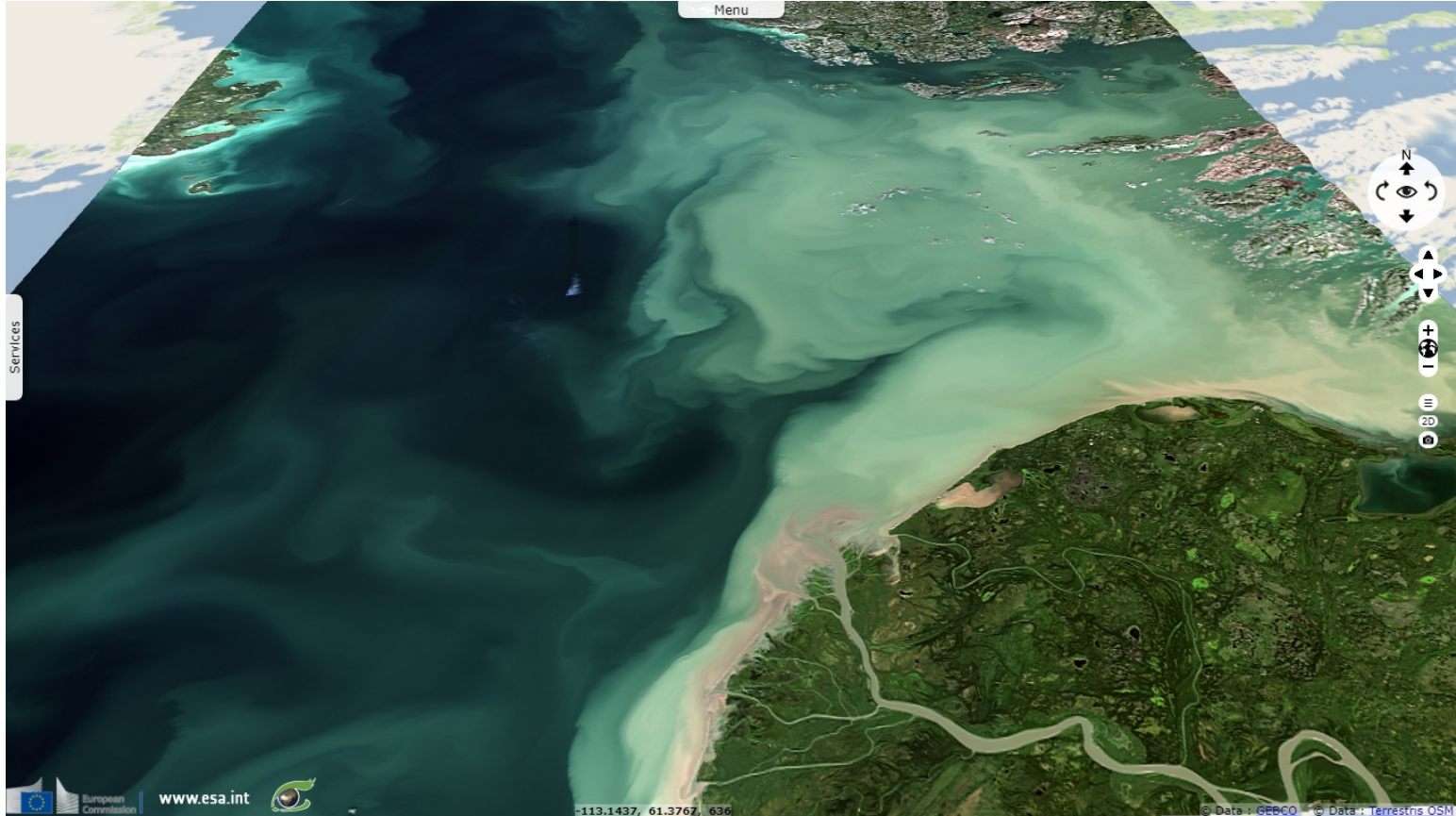


Fig. 2 - S2 (17.11.2017) - 8,11,4 land/water colour composite - Ice forming during winter, north western part of the lake.

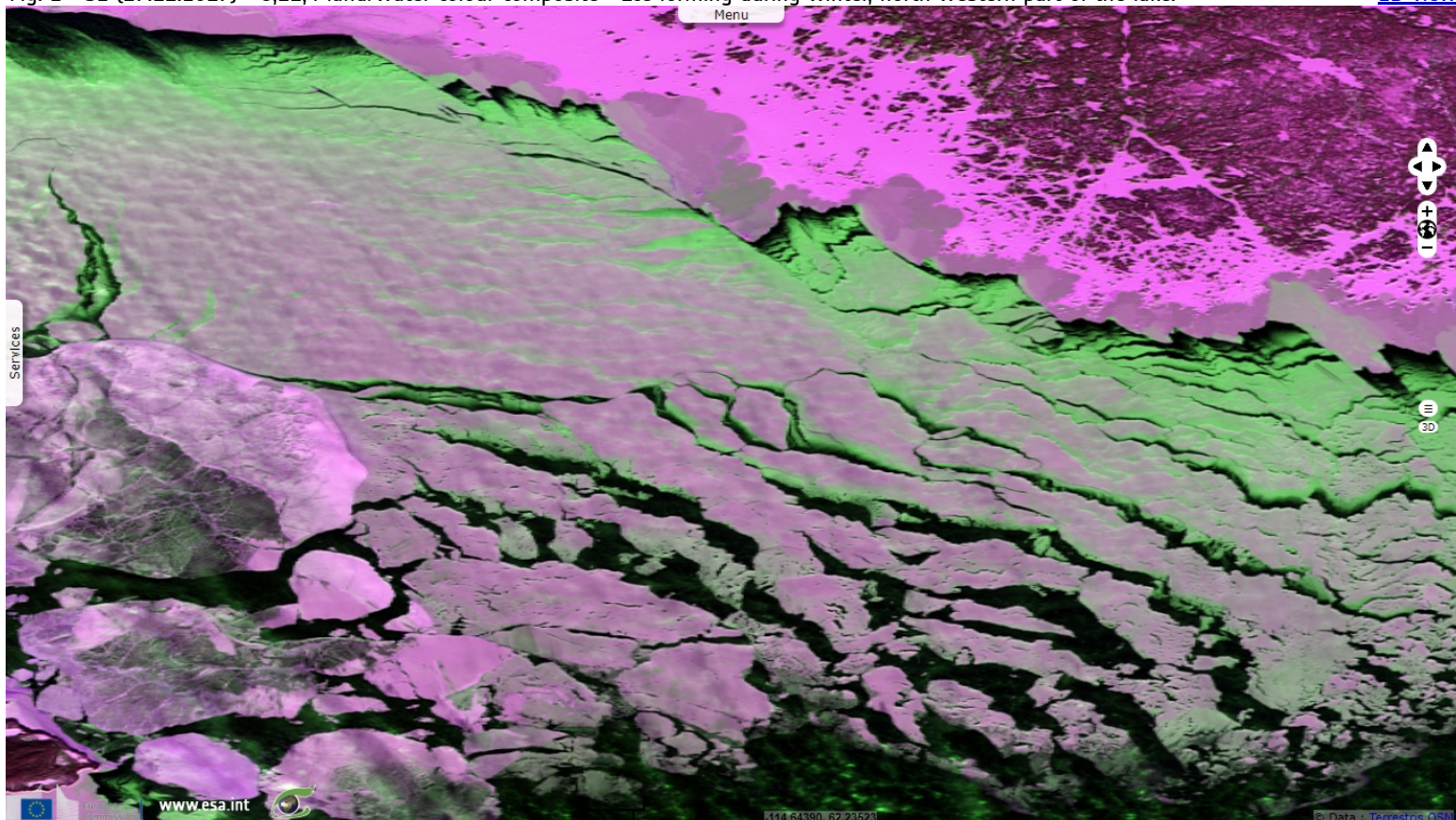


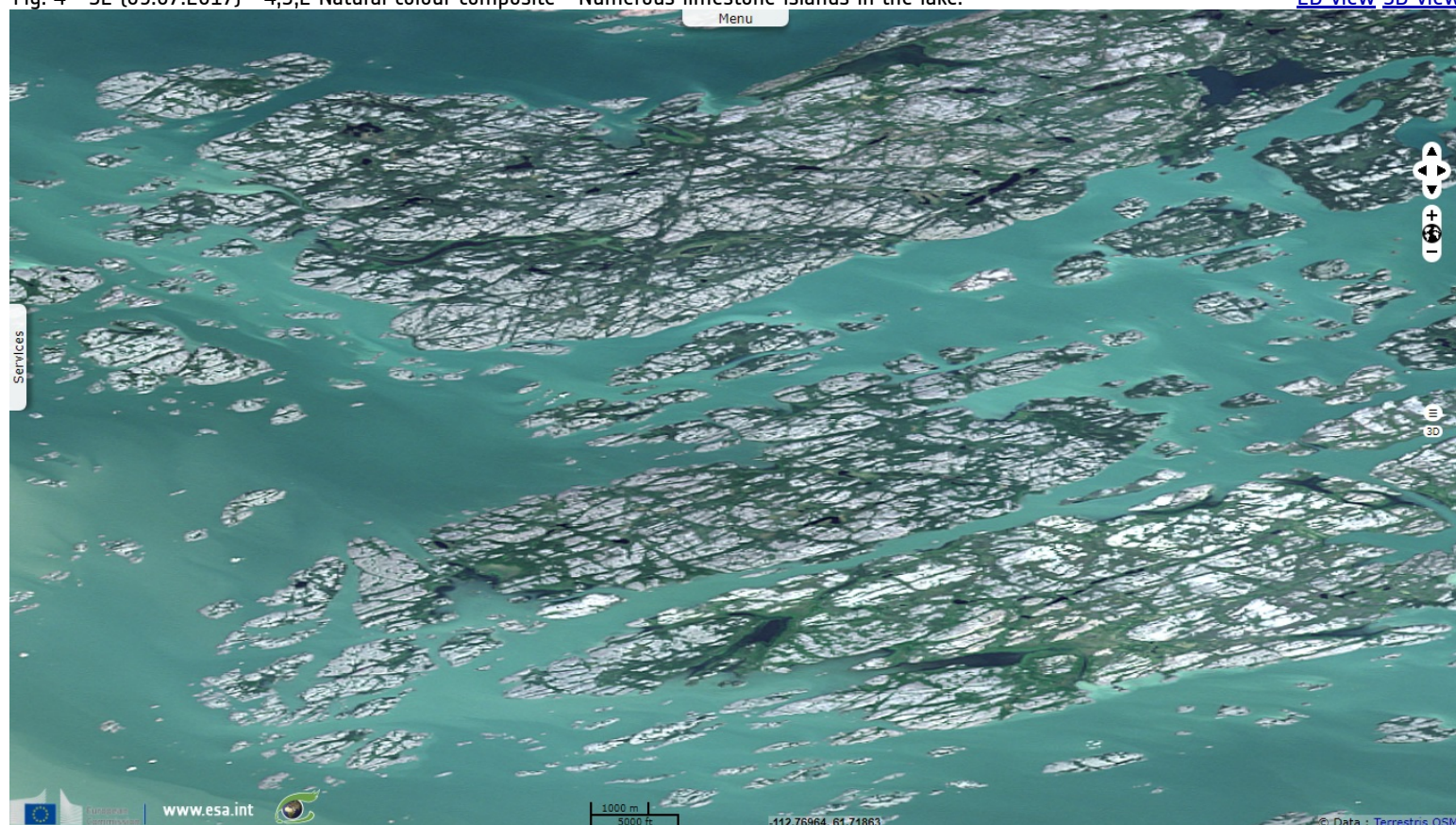
Fig. 3 - S2 (31.08.2017) - 8,4,3 Vegetation colour composite - Numerous little lakes along the Great Slave Lake coasts.
