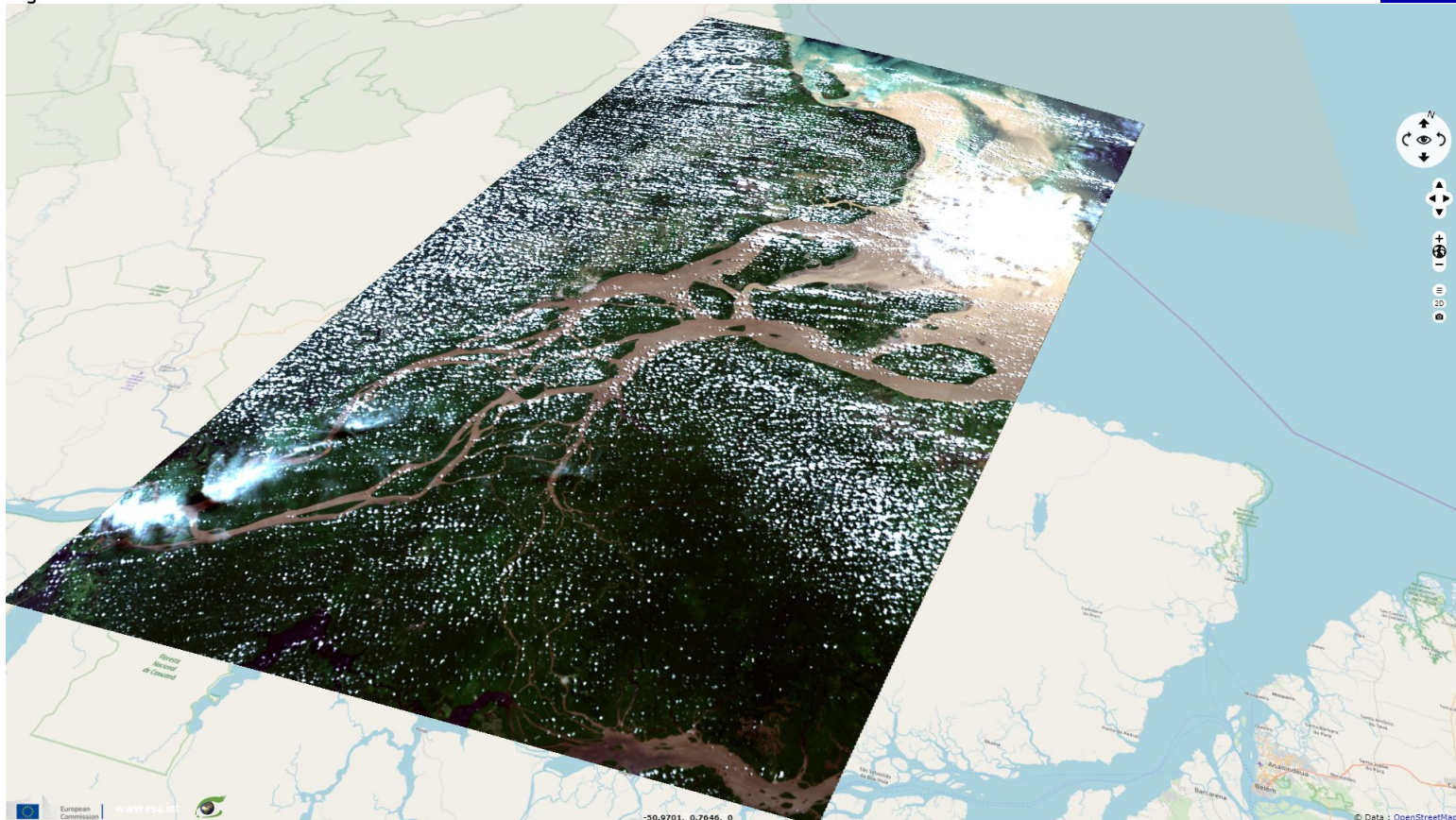


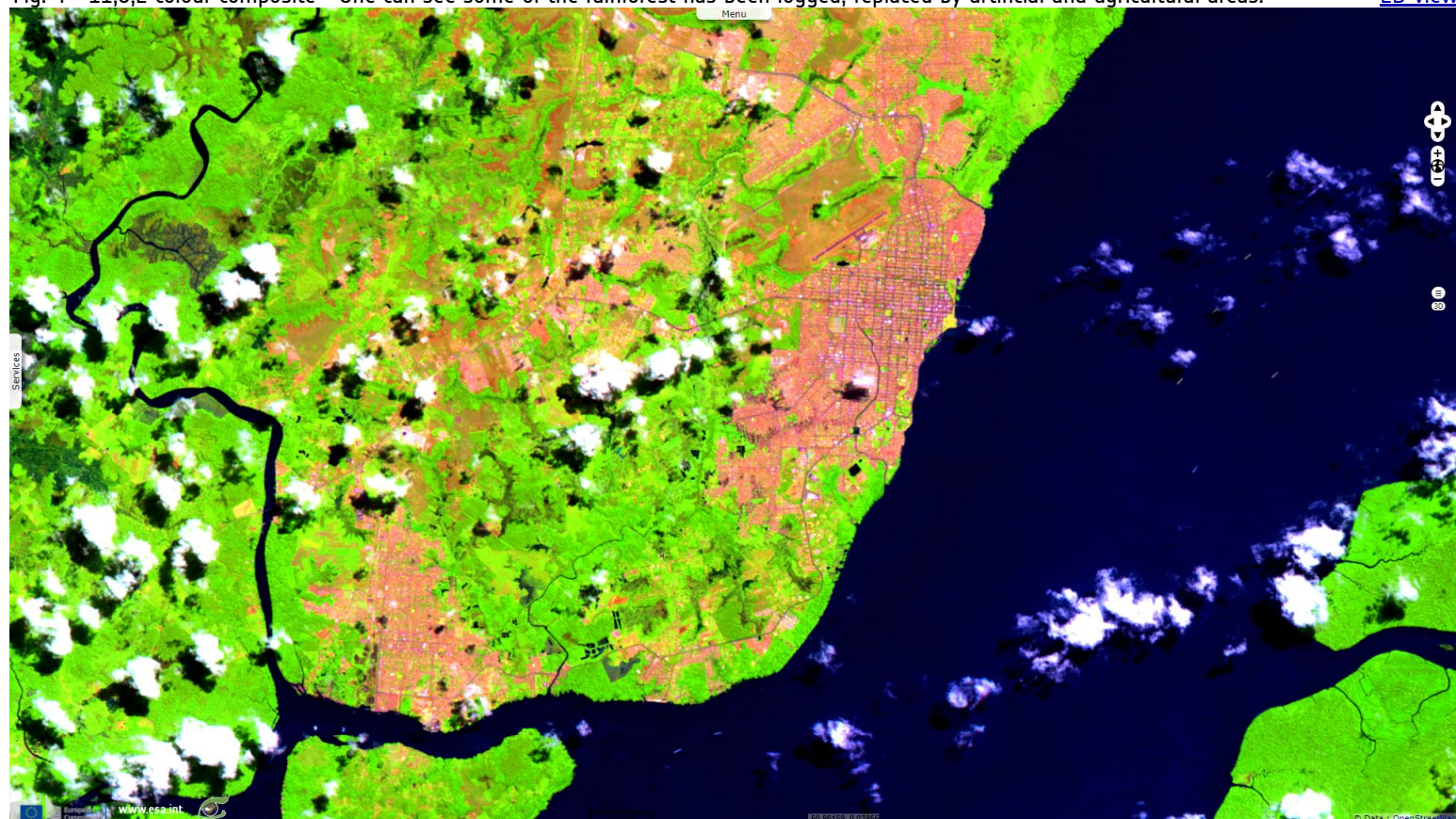
Fig. 3 - 8,4,3 colour composite - City of Macapá on the north-west arm of the estuary.
