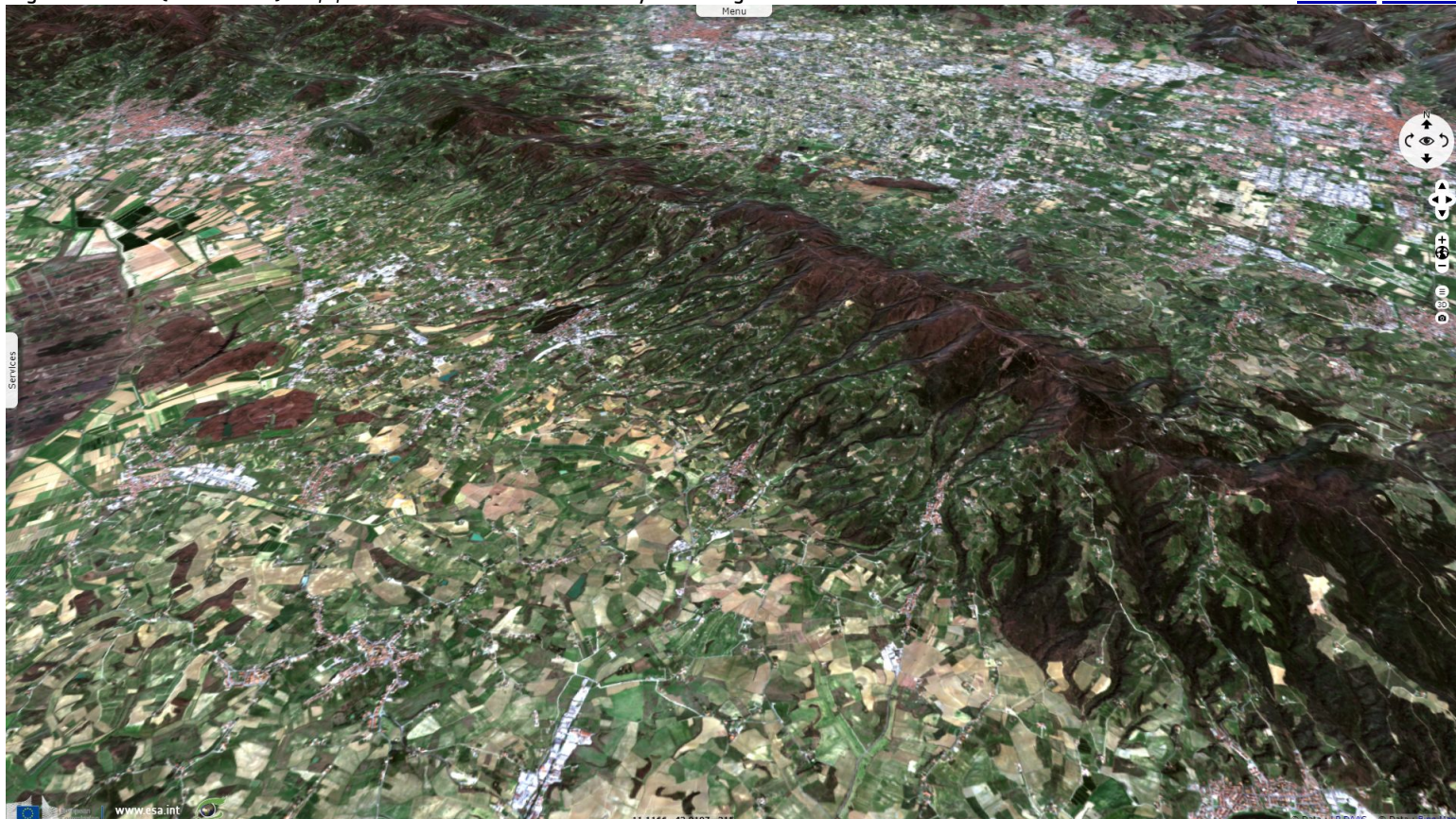


Fig. 2 - He worked most of his life for Lorenzo de' Medici in Florence, cradle of the Italian renaissance, now a UNESCO World heritage site.

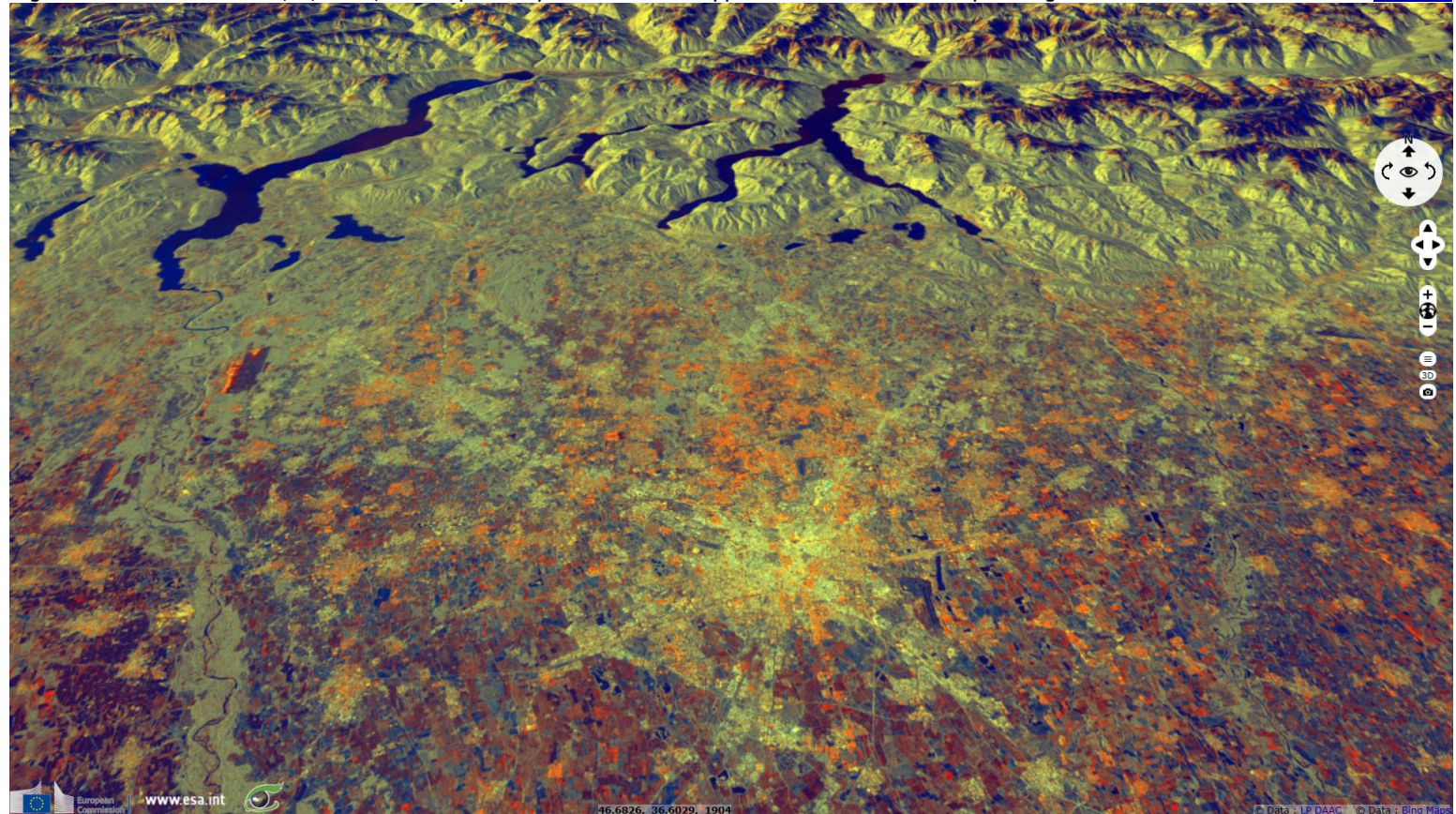














Fig. 4 - 26.09.2018 - He spent his late years in Clos Lucé, Ambroise, Loire Valley (also a UNESCO World Heritage site), protected by Francis I. [2D view](#)
