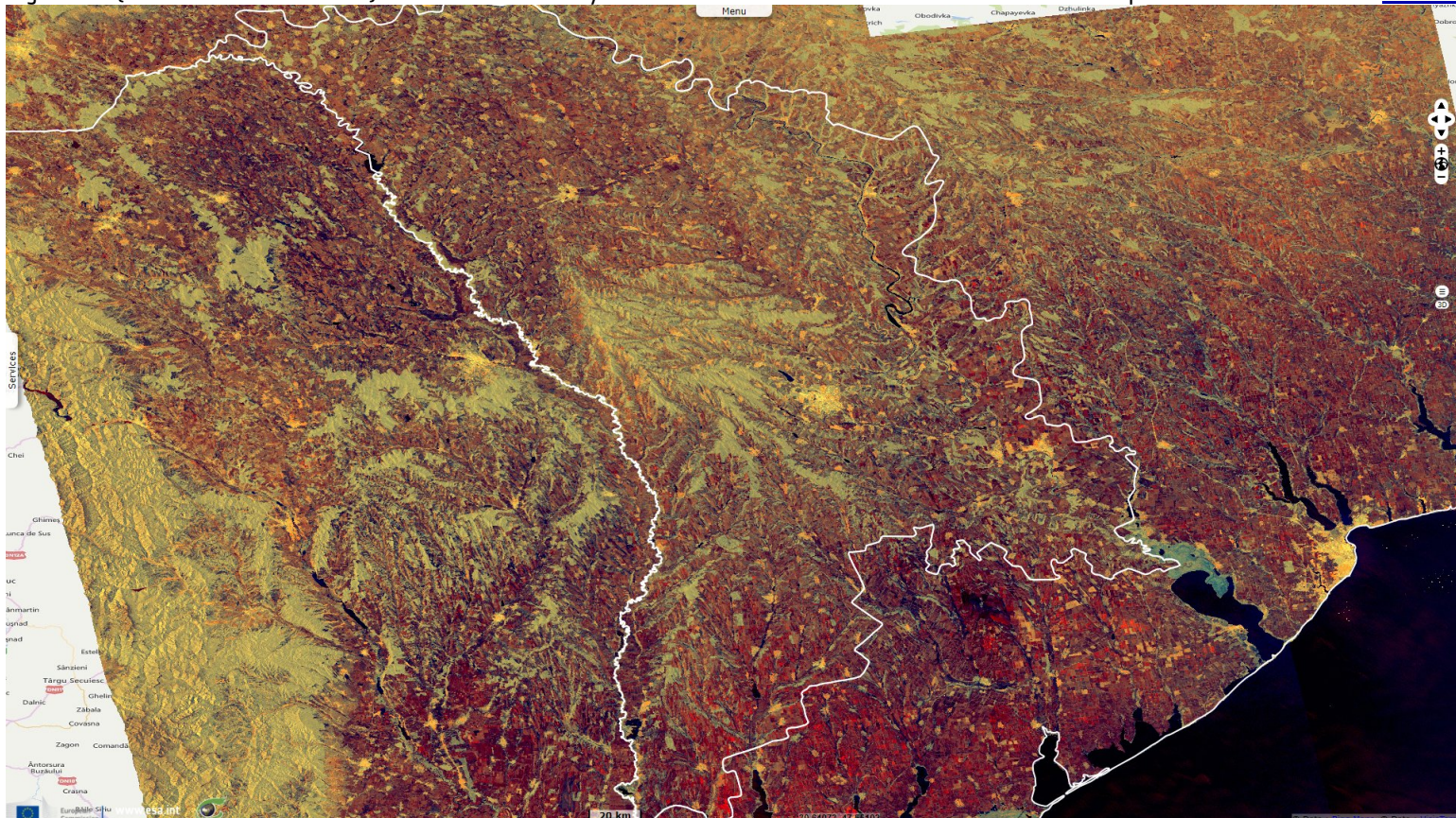


Fig. 2 - S1 (19 & 20.11.2021) - 40 km away from the Black Sea, Moldova is landlocked between Romania at SW and Ukraine on other sides.

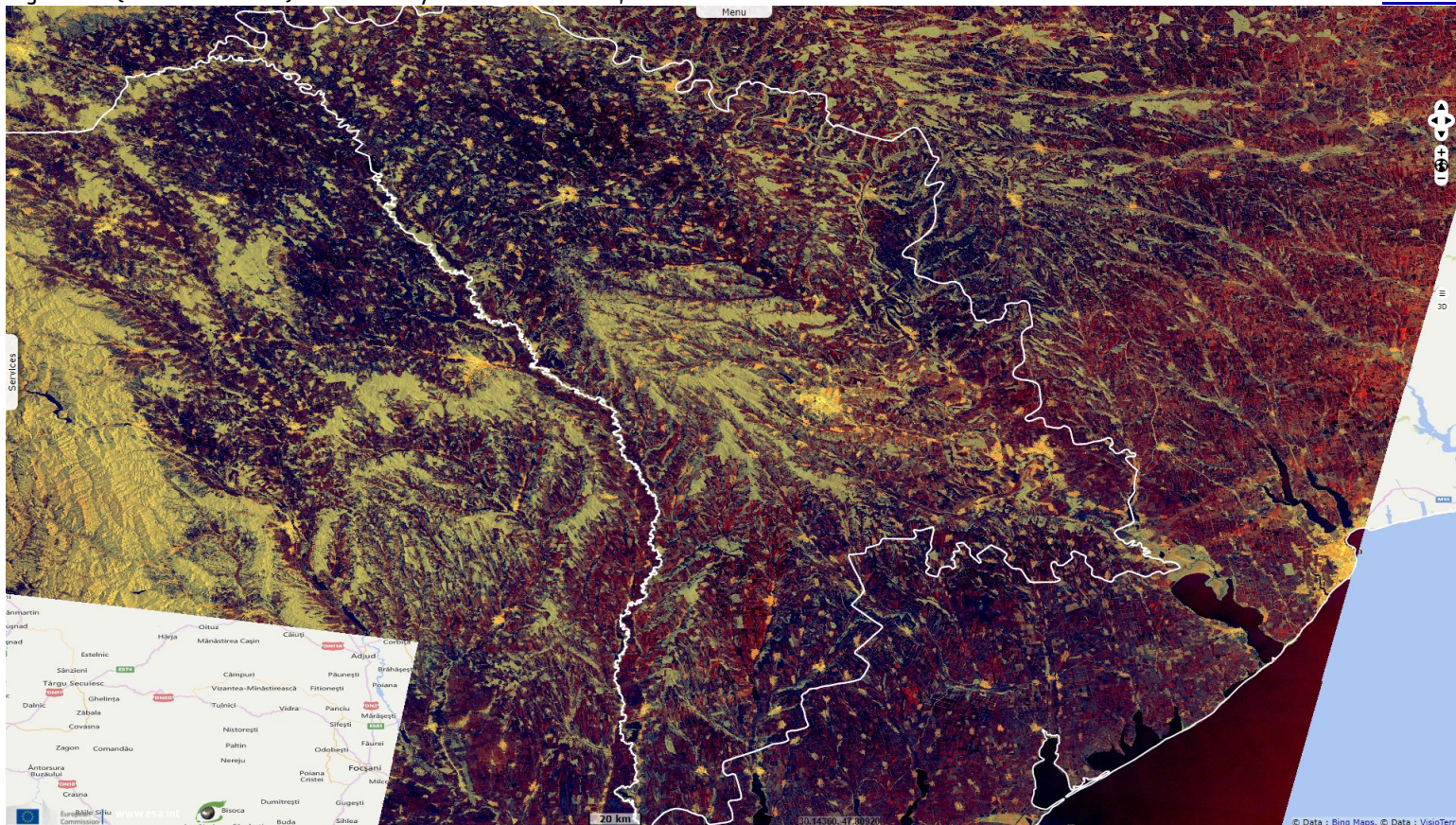


Fig. 3 - S2 (23.03.2022) - Lying in the middle of the country, Chişinău is the capital and largest city of Moldavia with over 500 000 inhabitants.

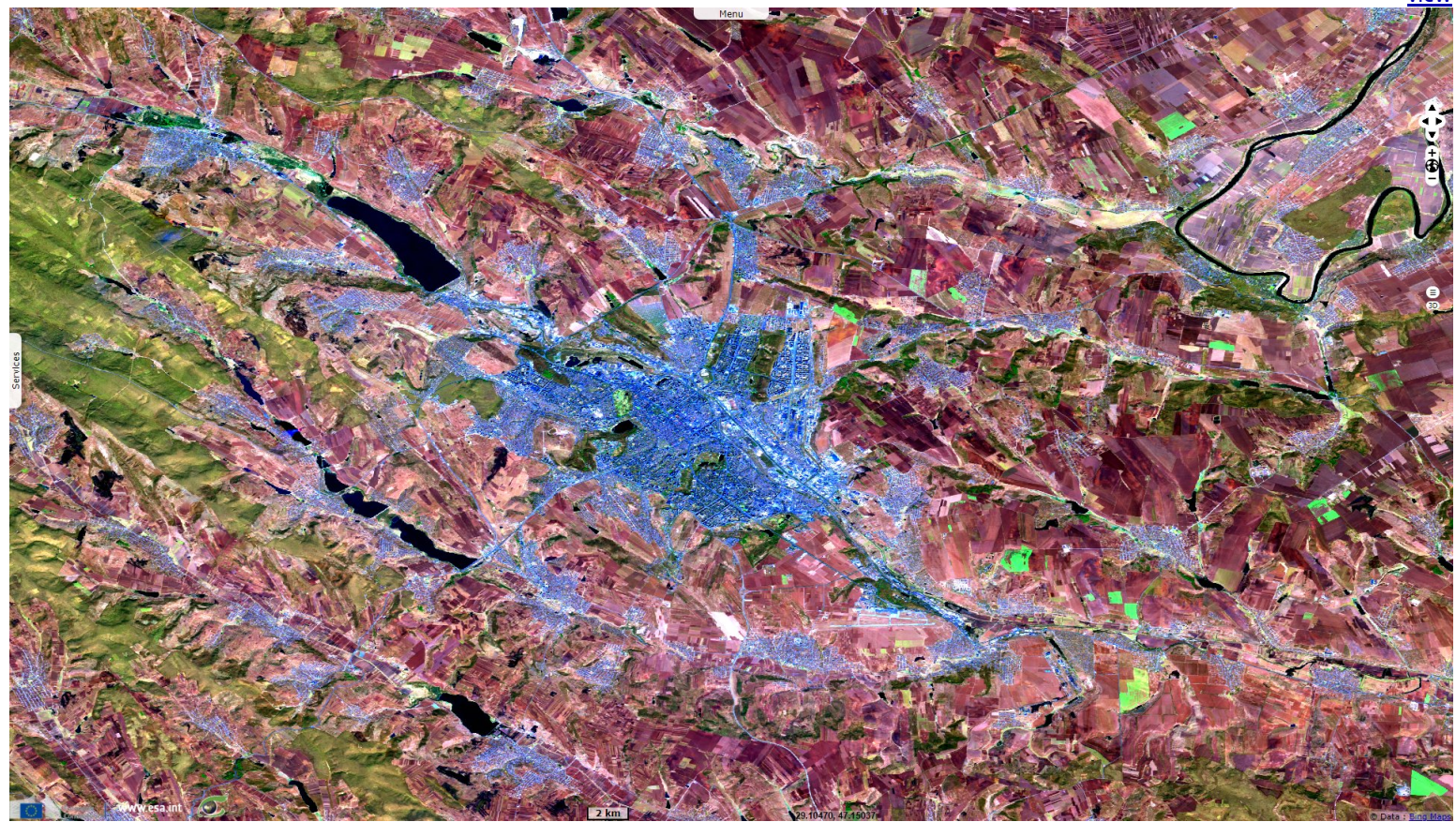


Fig. 4 - S1 (14 & 15.07.2022) - At east of Moldavia, the province of Transnistria is on the eastern side of the Dnestr river.

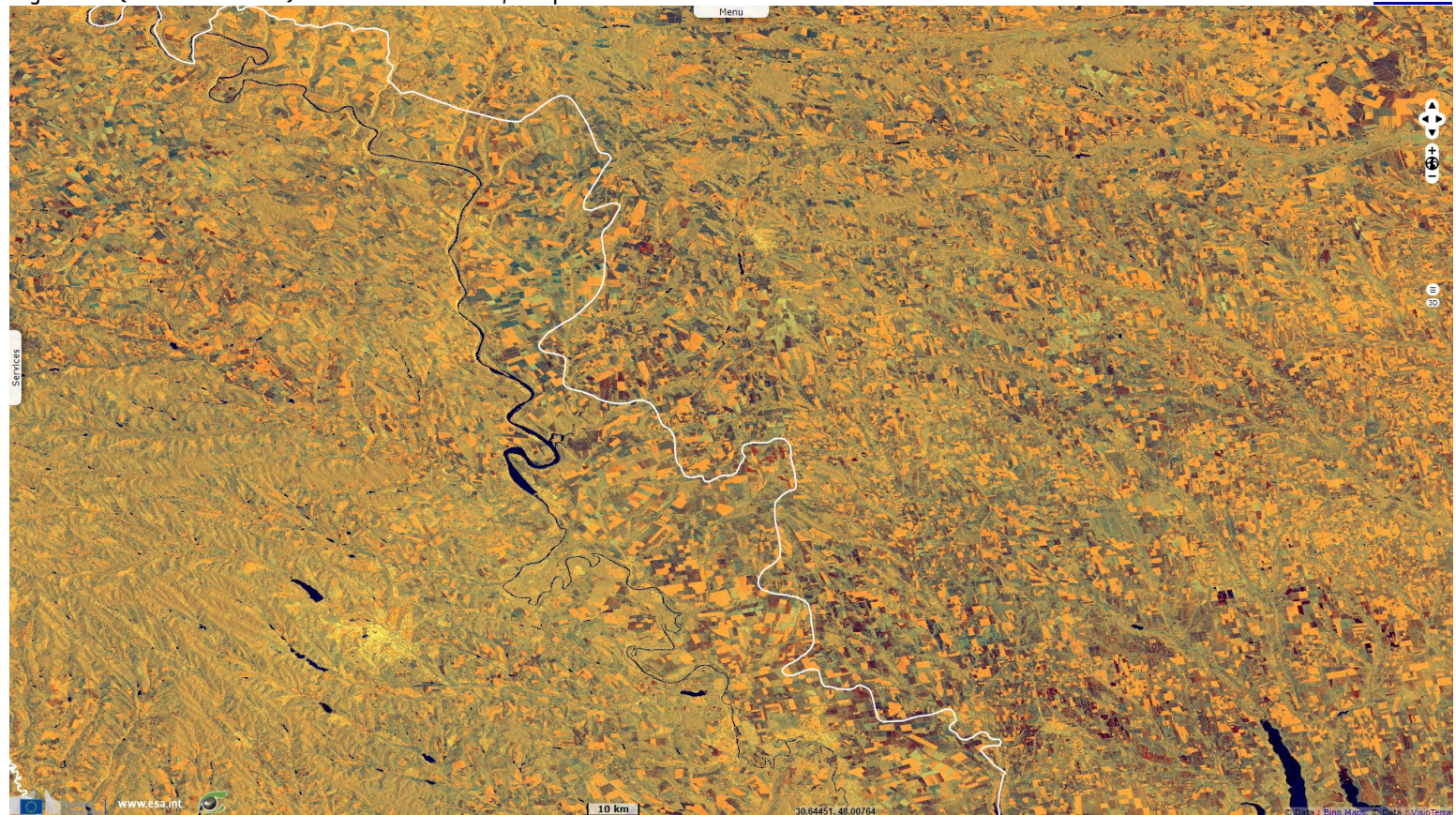
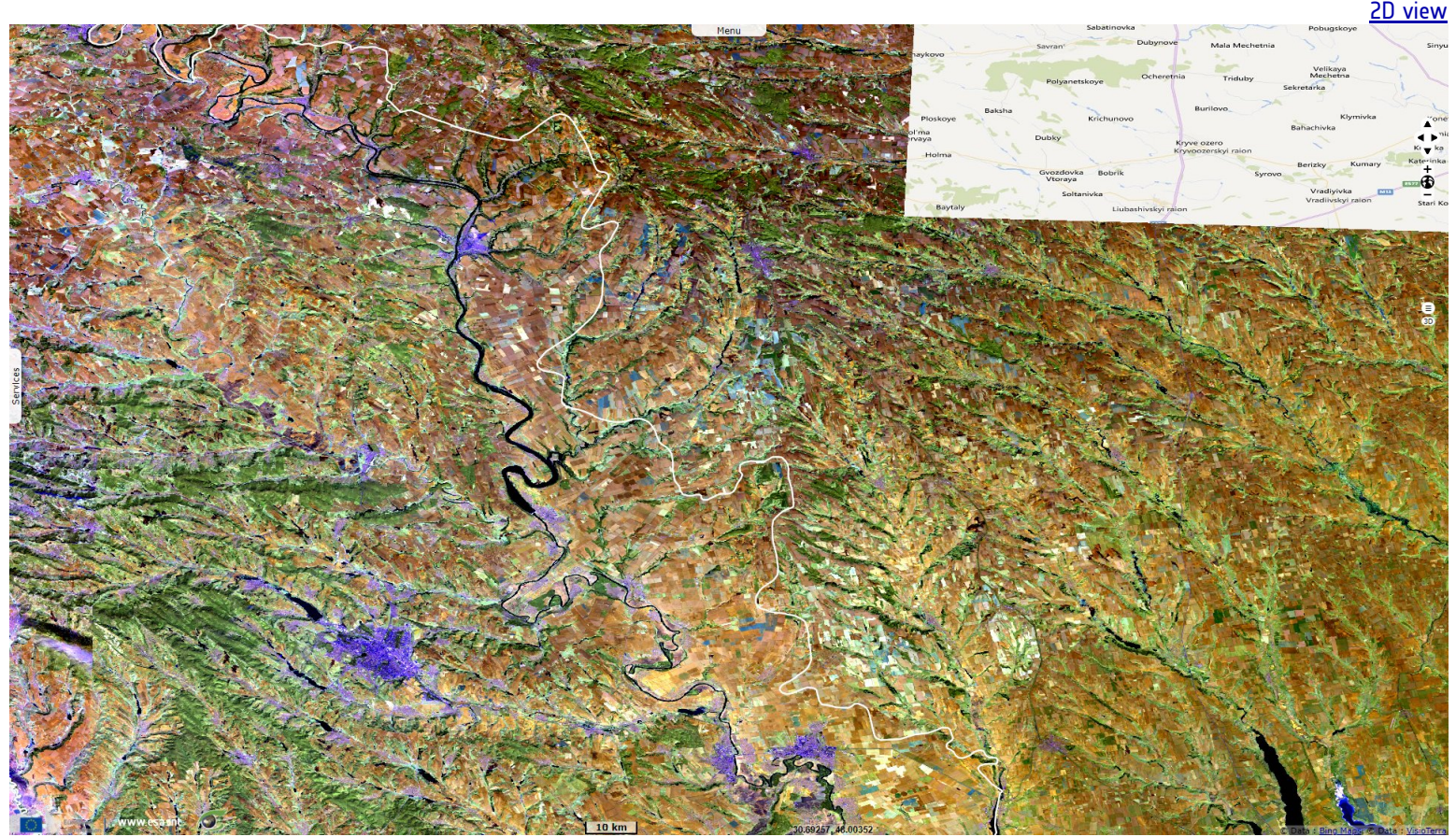


Fig. 5 - S2 (21 & 23.03.2022) - Since 1990, Transnistria separatists backed by Russia forces broke away from Moldova; the conflict remains frozen to this day.
