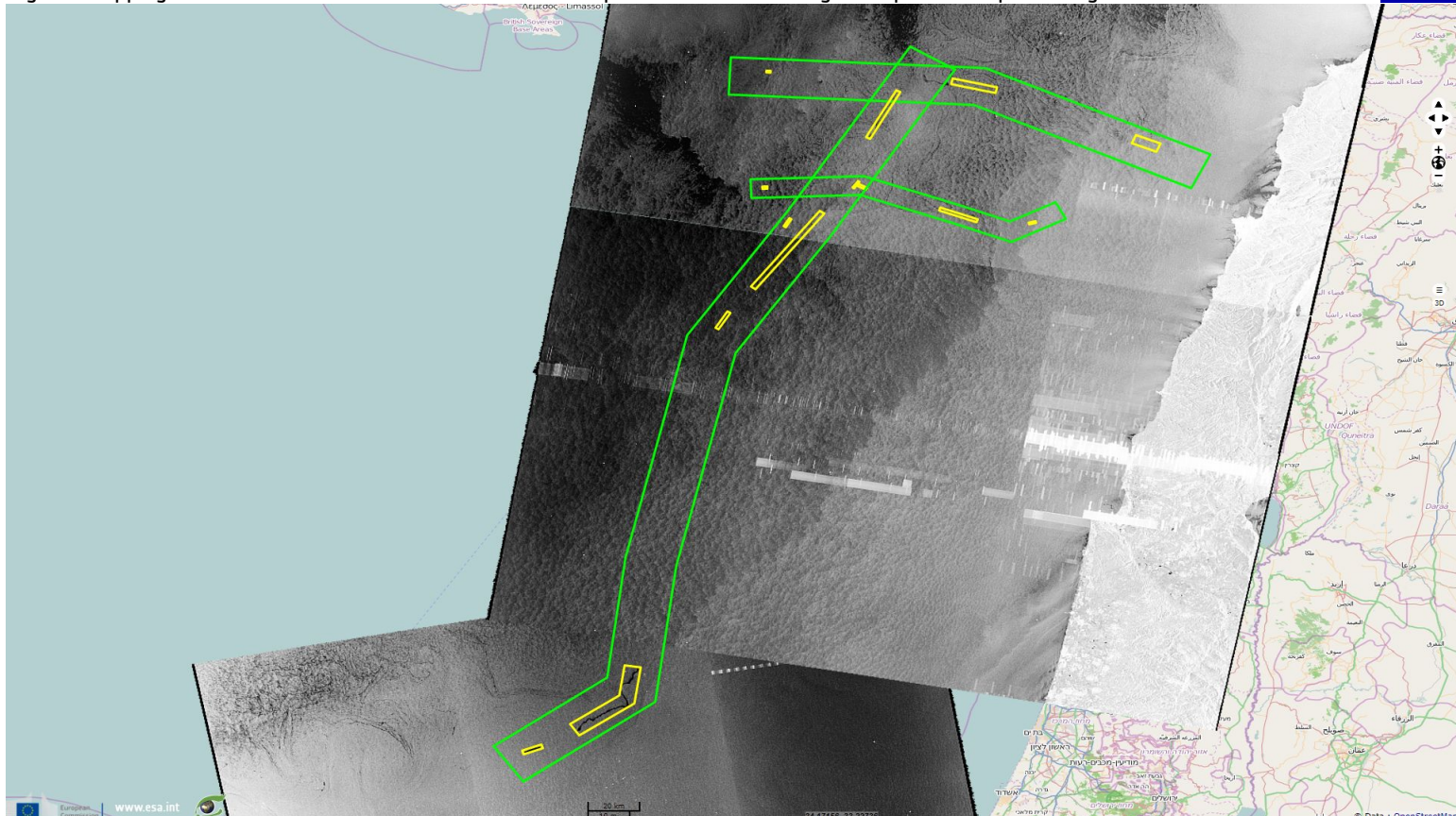


Fig. 2 - S1 (2017.04.05) - Ship oil slicks between Cyprus and Lebanon.

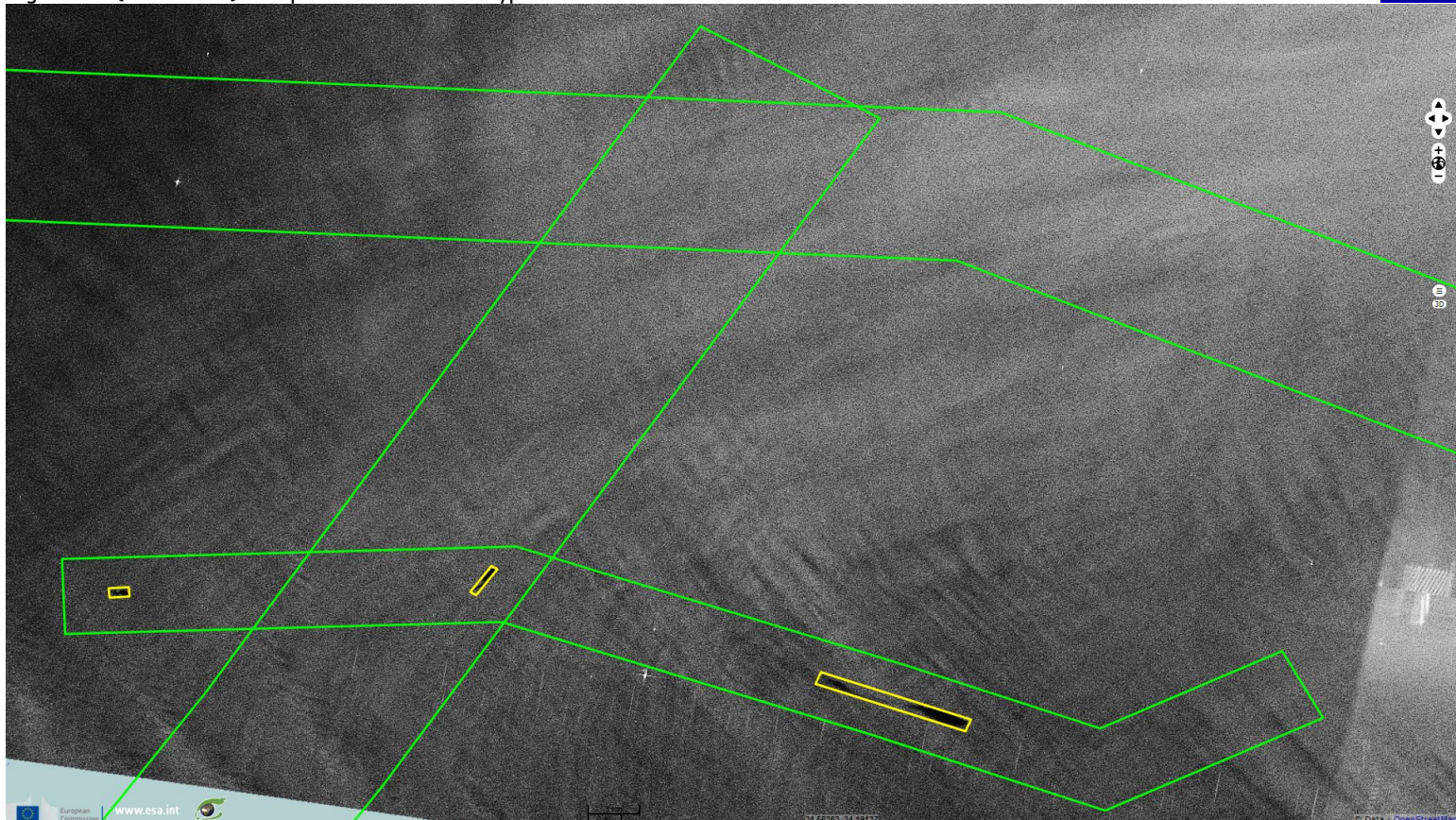


Fig. 3 - S1 (2017.02.04) - Ship oil slicks between Cyprus and Lebanon.

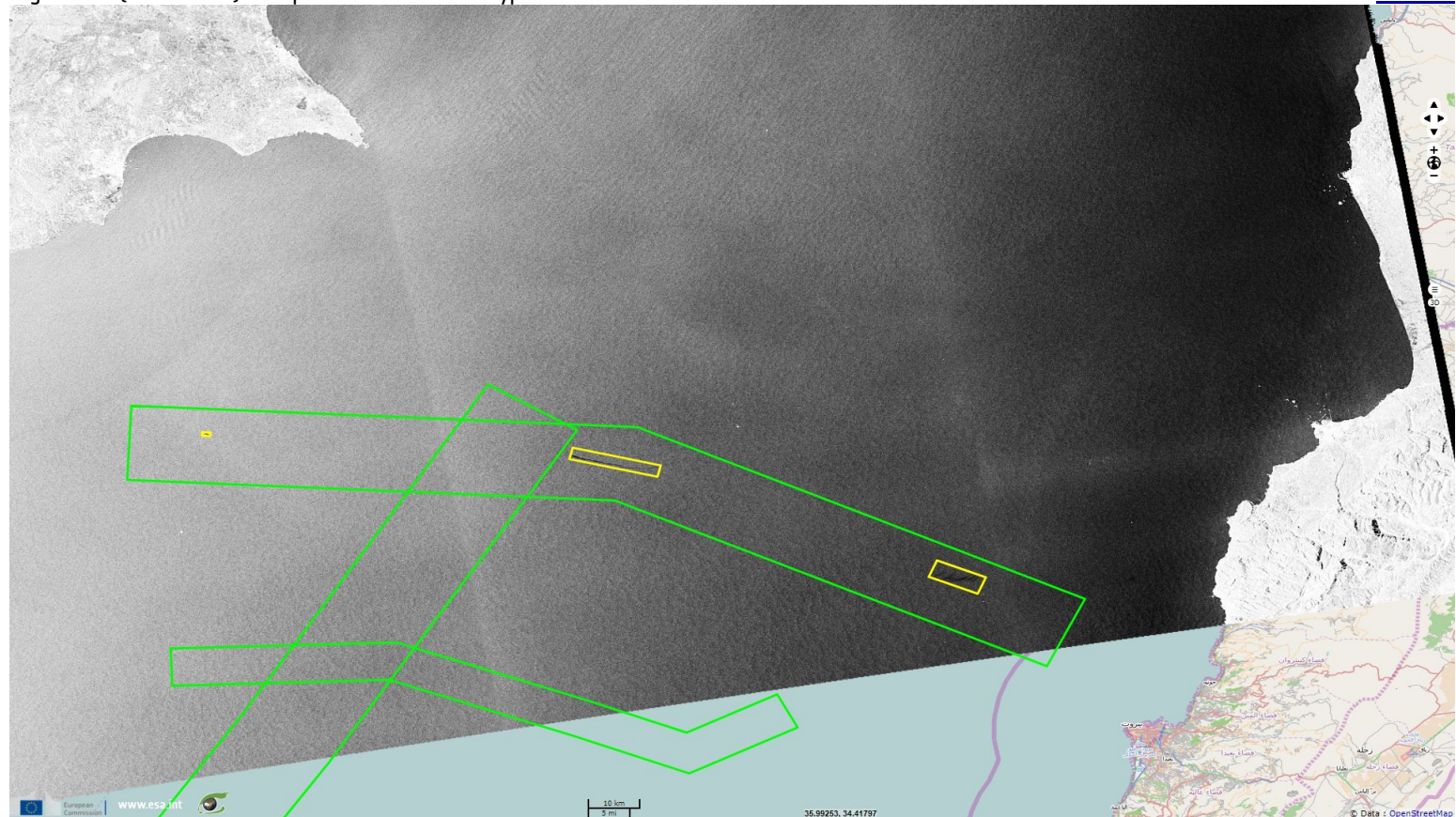


Fig. 5 - S1 (2016.02.15) - Ship oil slicks between Cyprus and Lebanon.

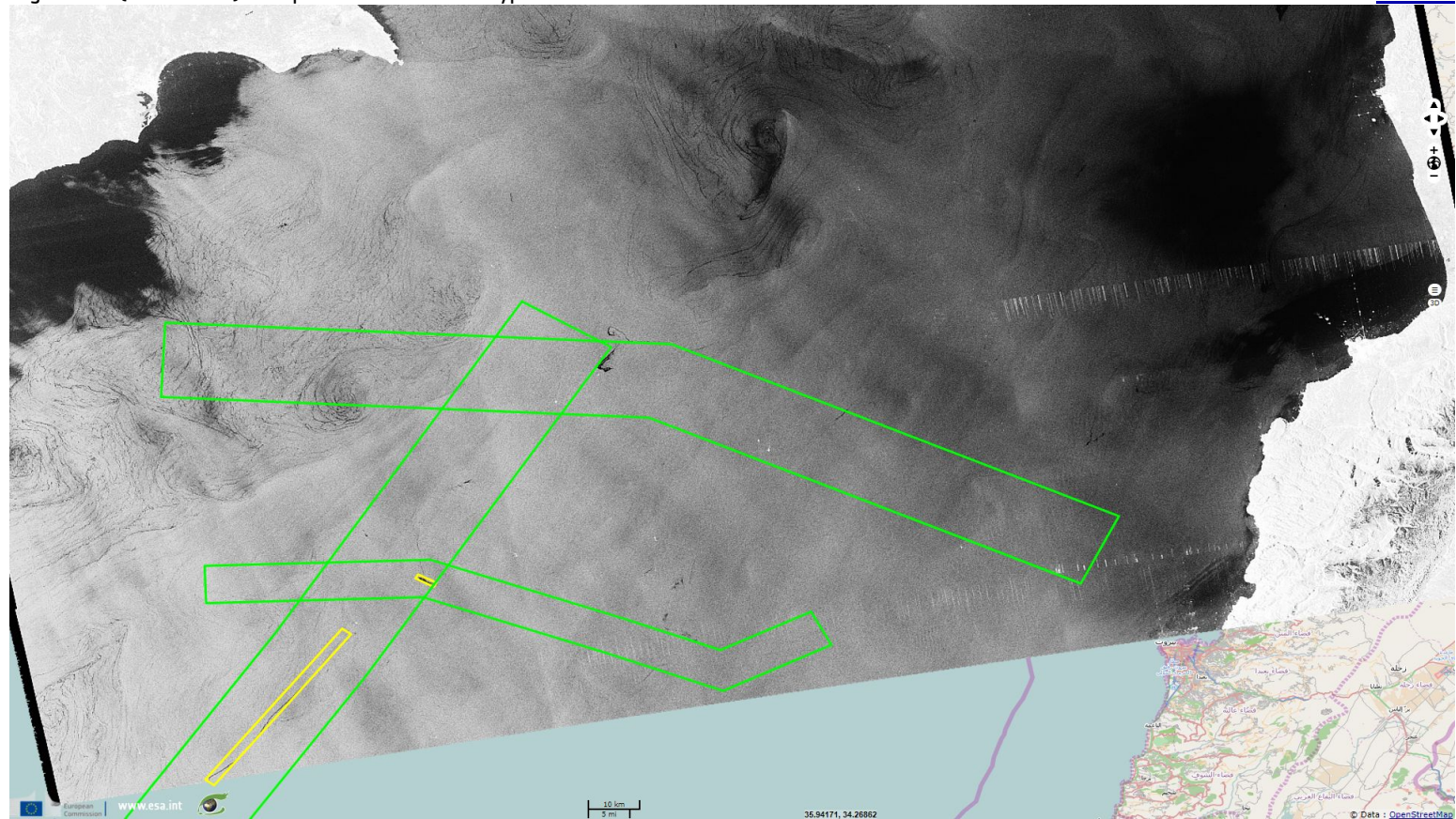
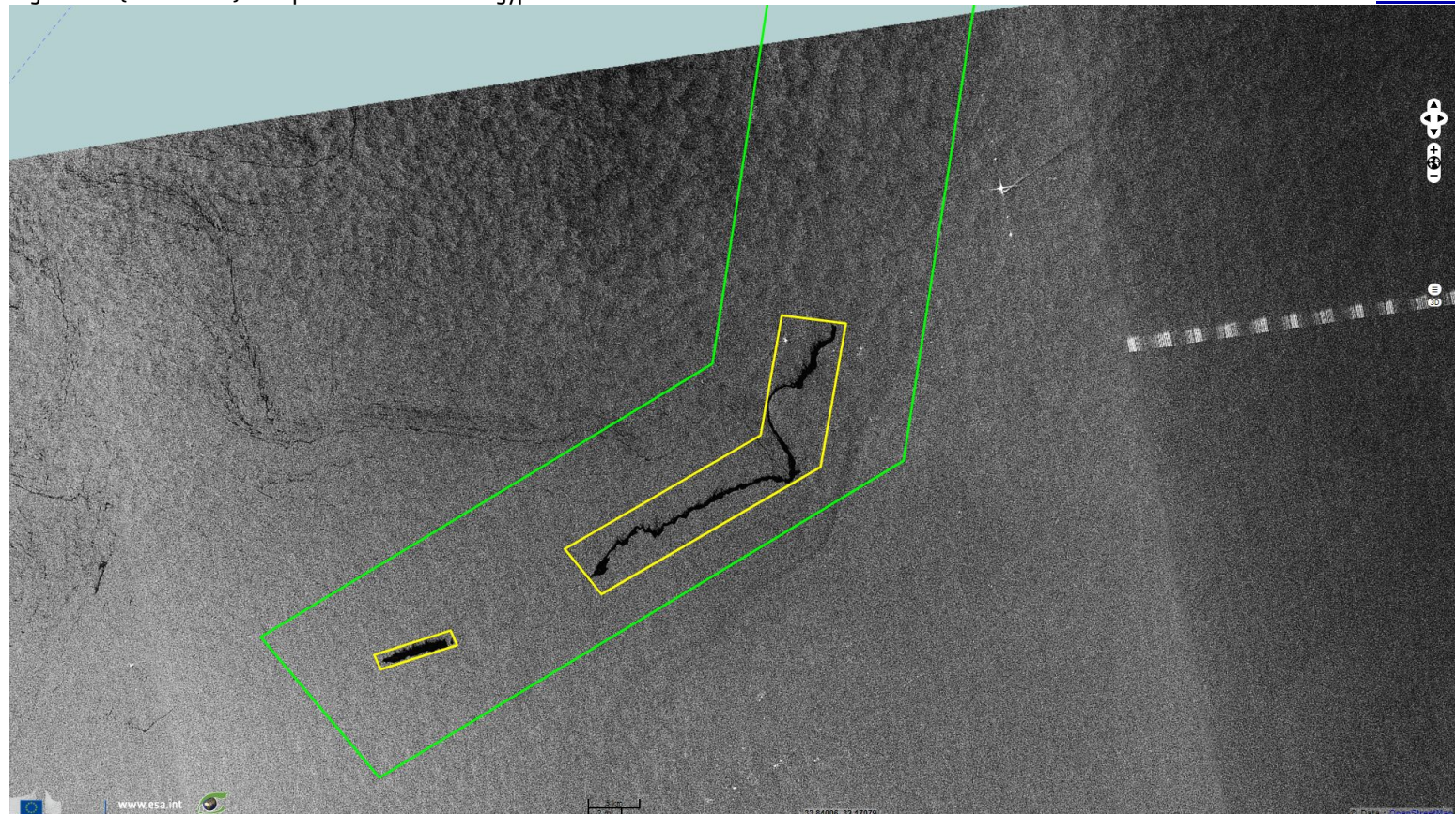


Fig. 6 - S1 (2015.09.17) - Ship oil slicks North of Egypt.
