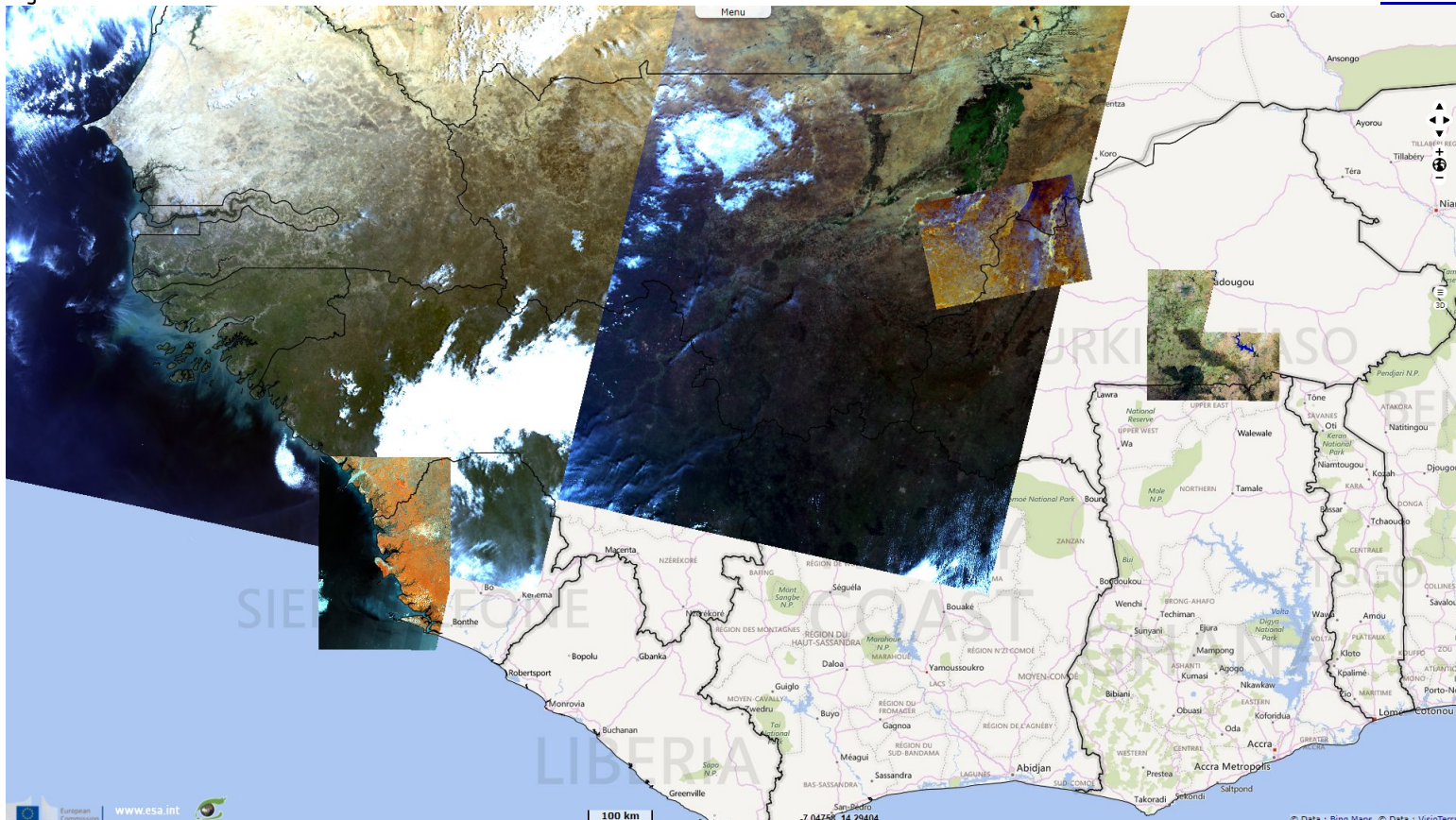


Fig. 2 - S3 OLCI (28.04.2021) - Sediment rich coastal waters on the shore of Senegal, Gambia and Guinea Bissau.

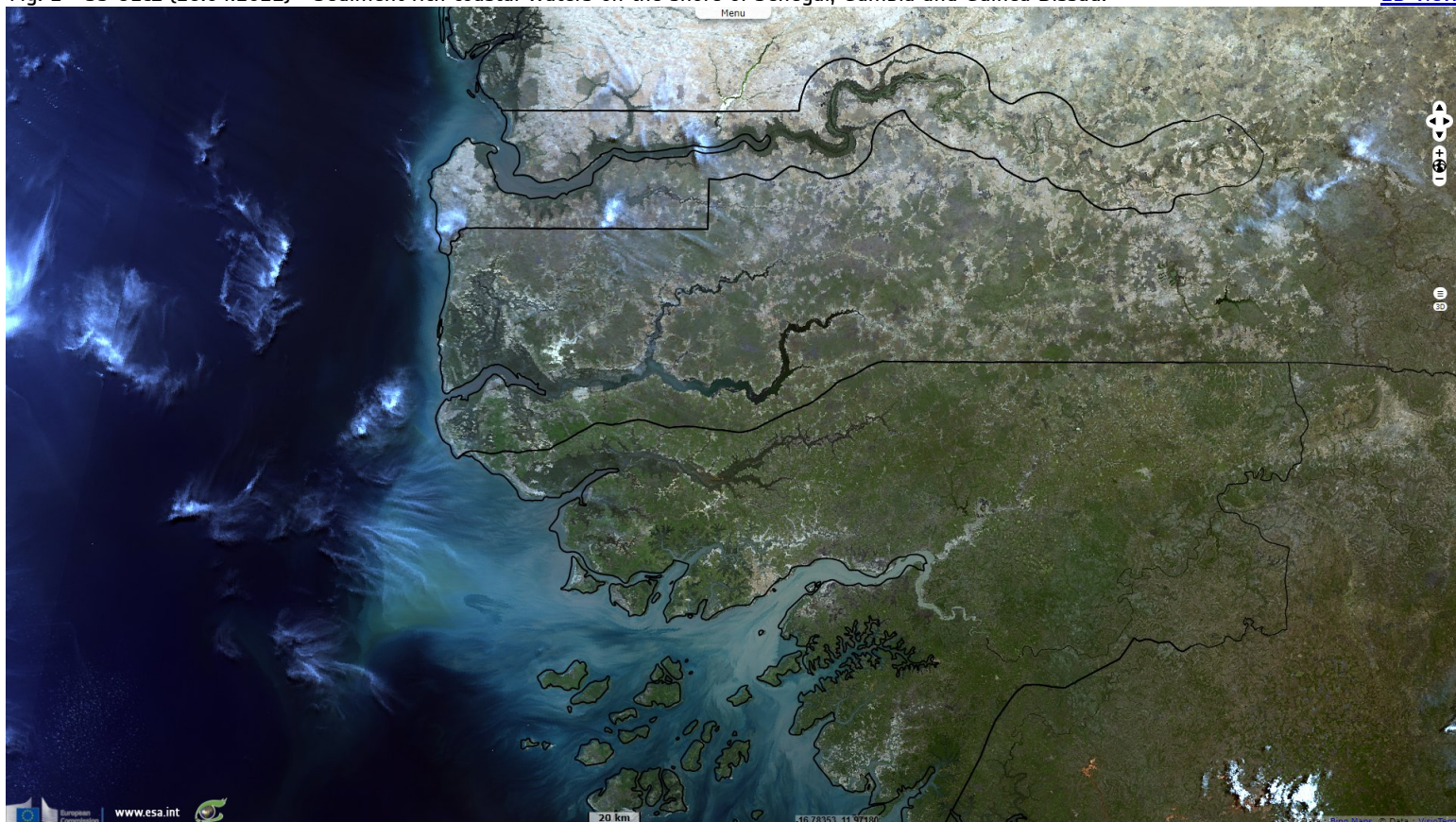


Fig. 3 - S2 (03.03.2018) - Mangrove forests on the coast of Guinea.

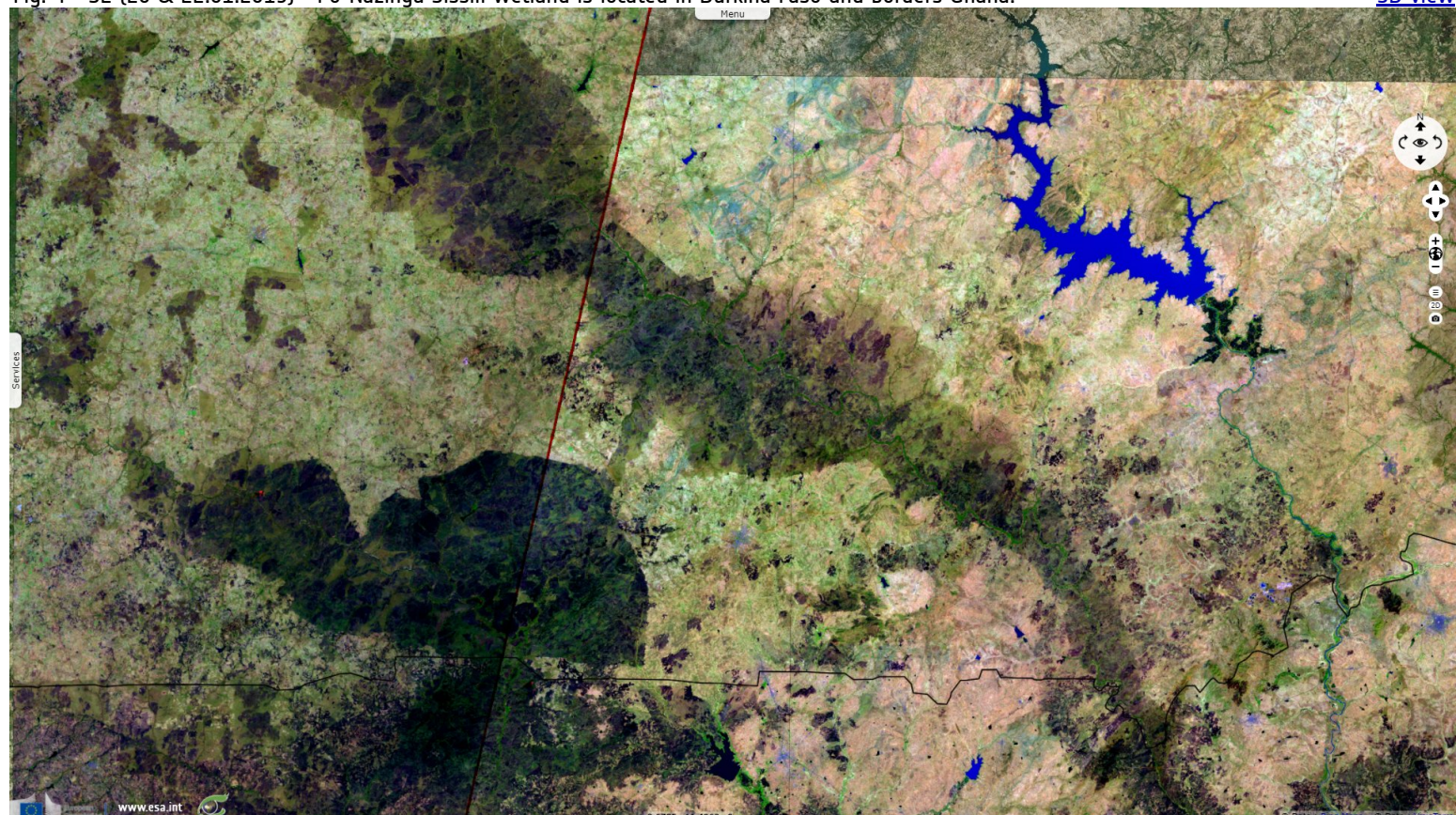


Fig. 5 - S3 OLCI (04.11.2021) - During its 4100km course, Niger river feeds an ecosystem of prime importance, the Inner Niger Delta, Mali. [3D view](#)

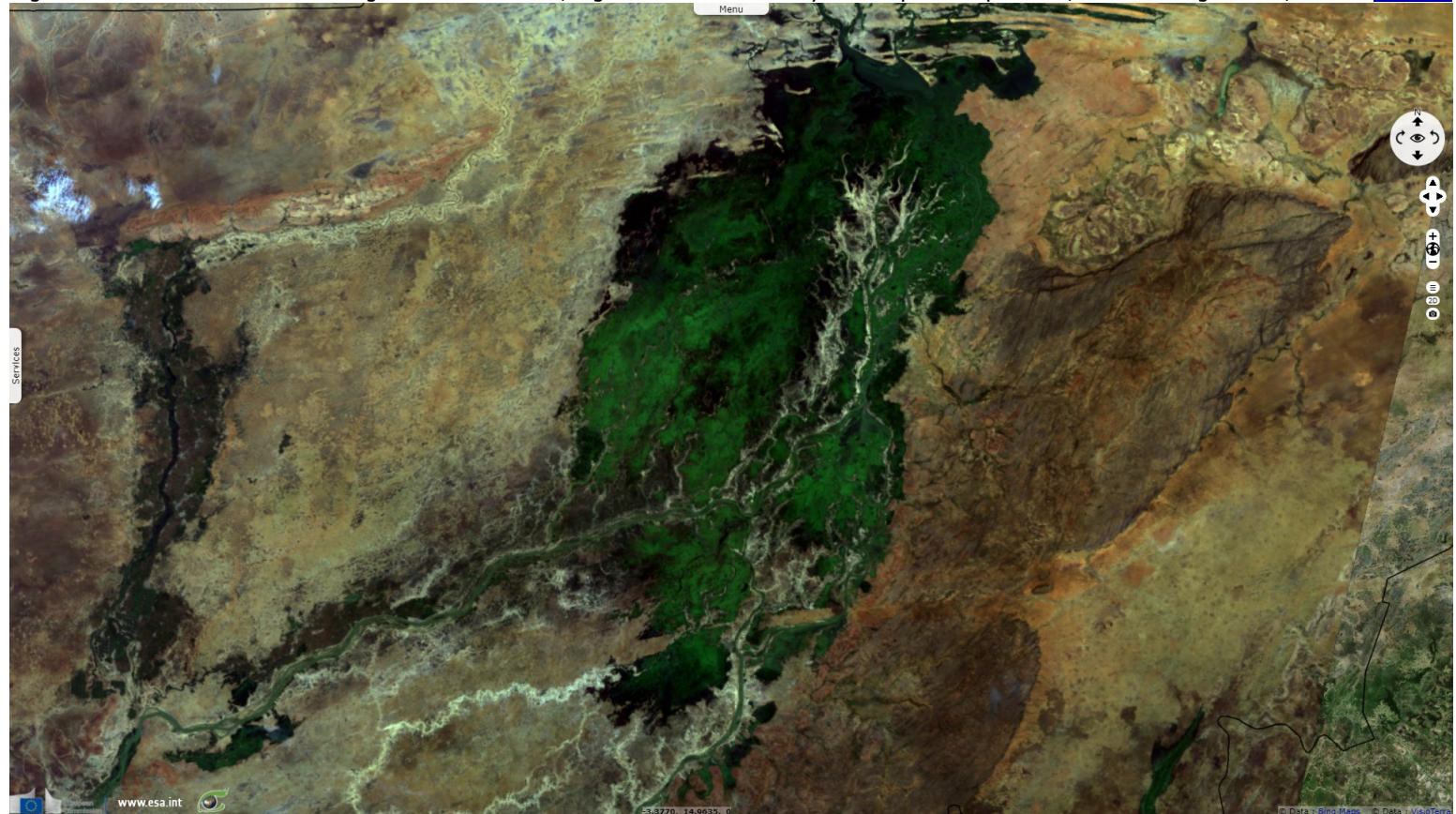
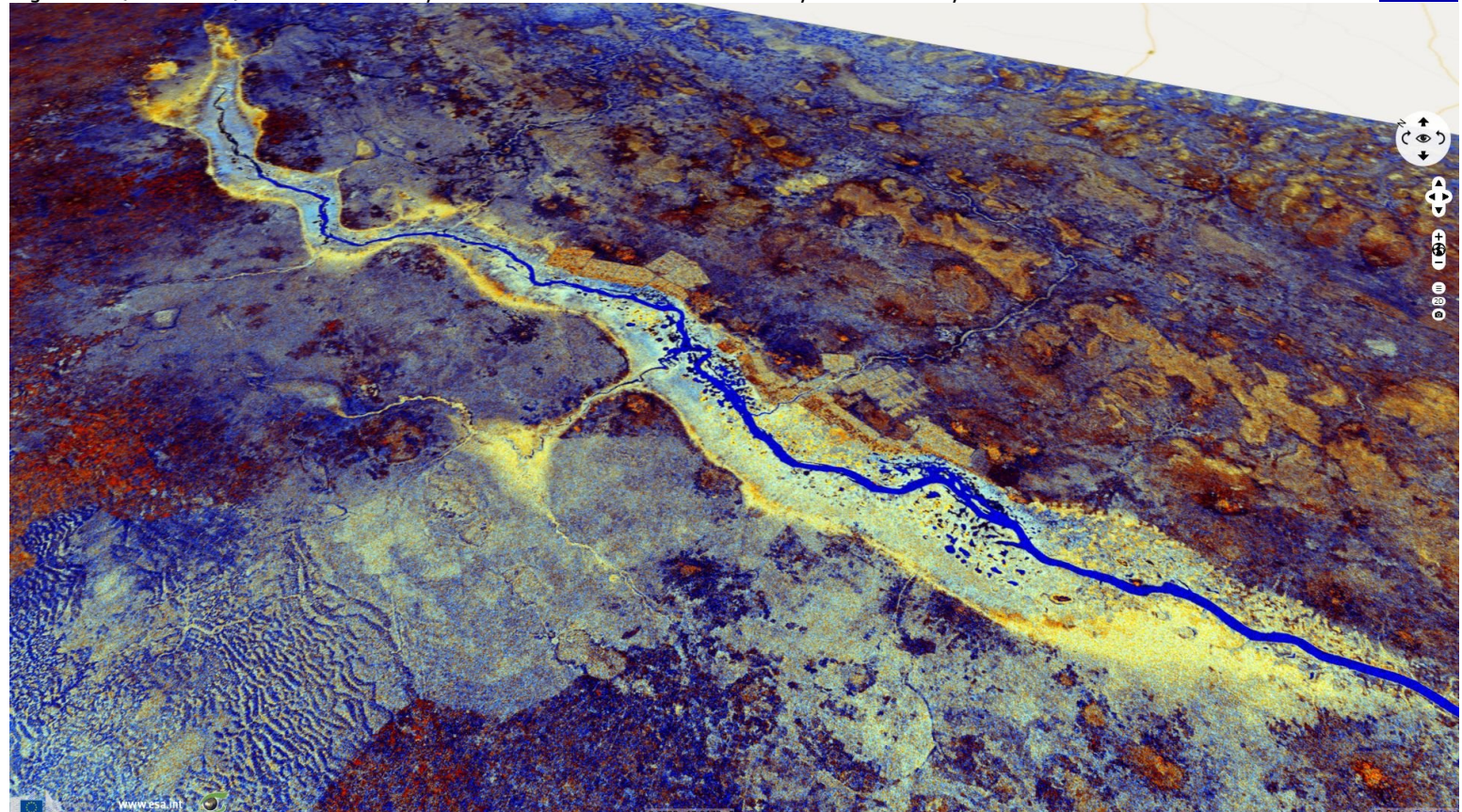


Fig. 6 - S1 (15.01.2019) - The Sourou Valley has been declared as a Transboundary Ramsar Site by Burkina Faso & Mali. [3D view](#)
