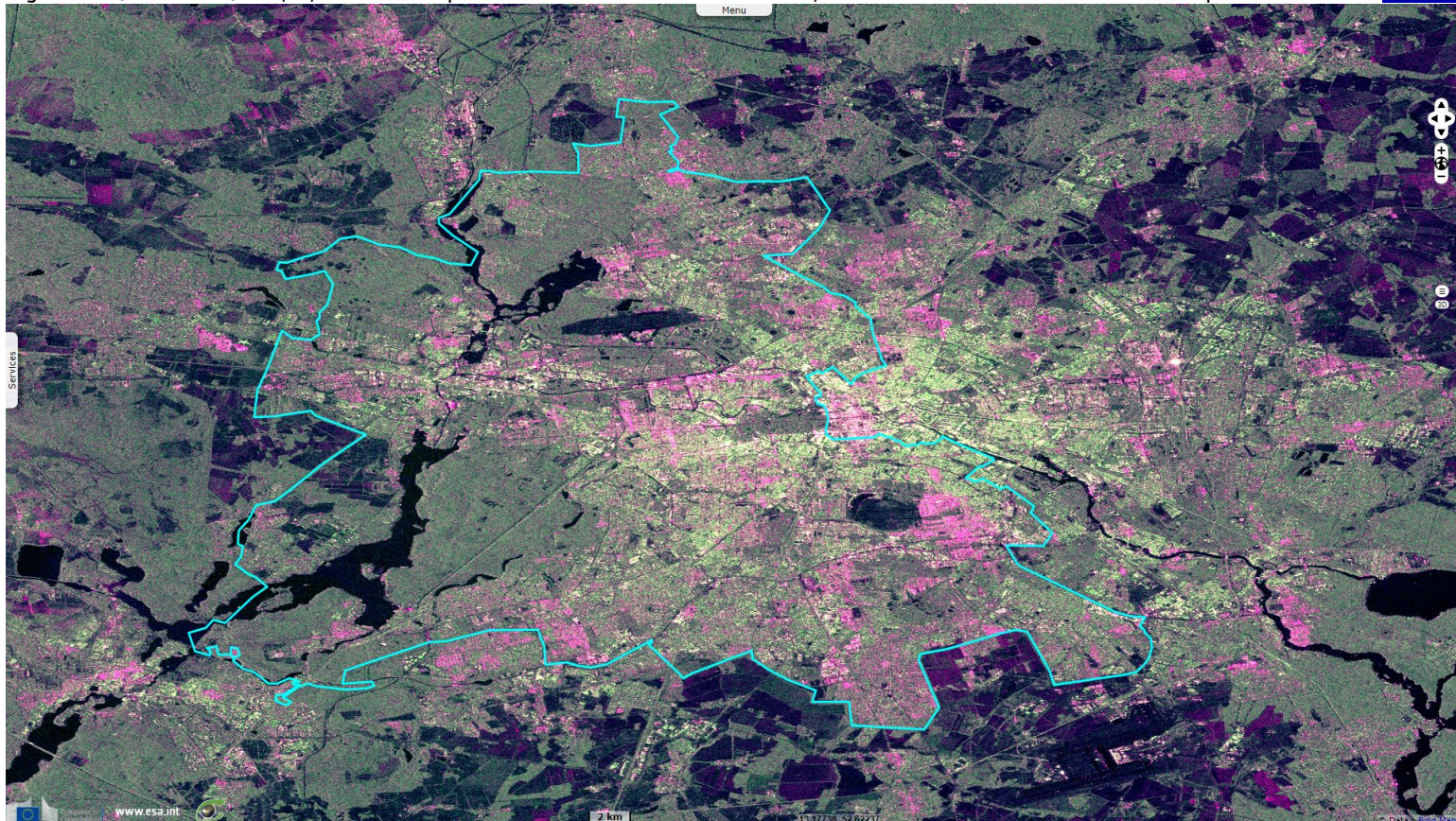


Fig. 2 - S2 (11.09.2019) - 4,3,2 composite - Bornholmer Straße (north), Brandenburg Gate (S-W) & Alexanderplatz (S-E) took a role in its fall. [2D view](#)



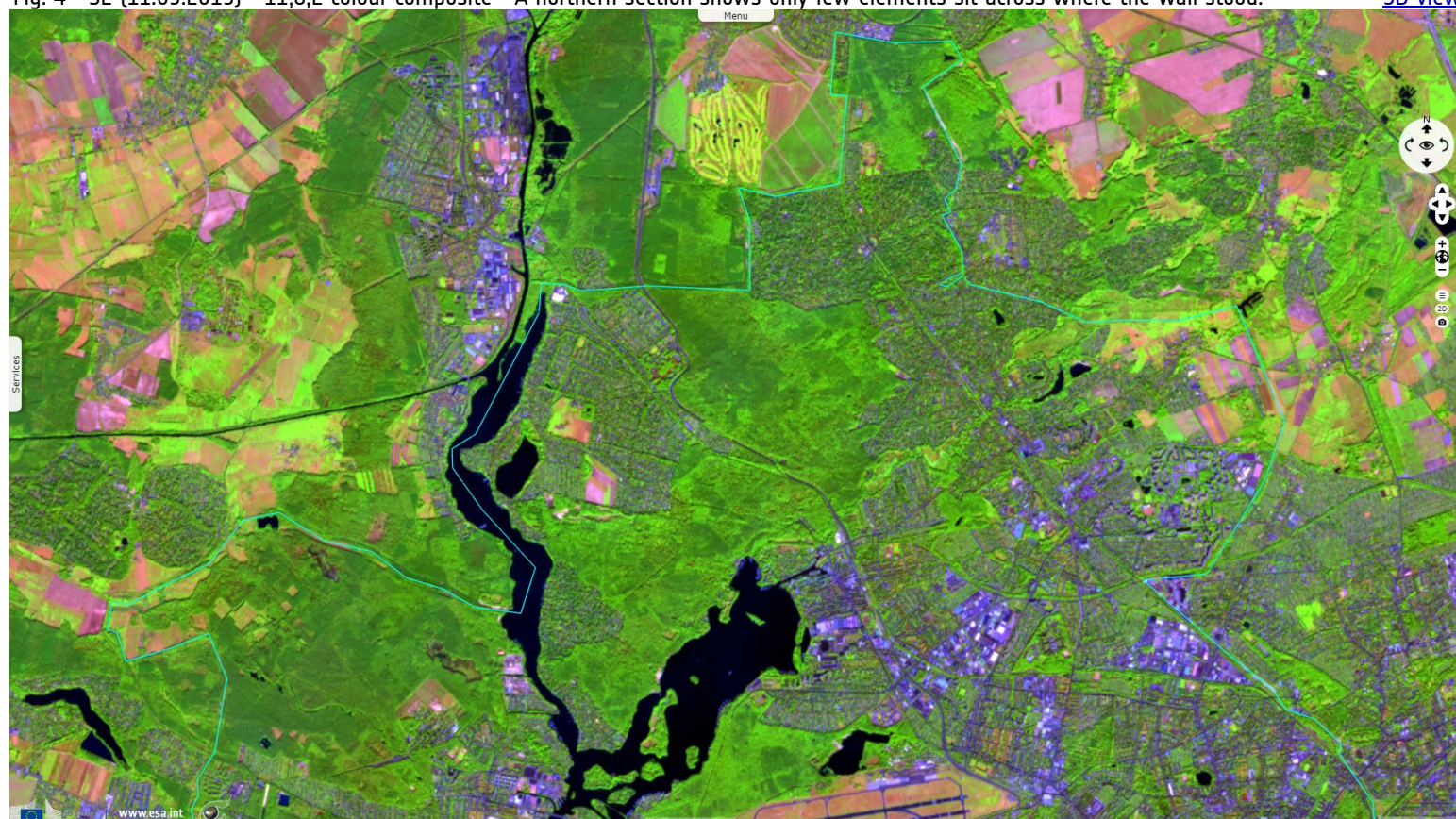
Fig. 3 - S1 (07.09.2019) - vv,vh,vv colour composite - A southern section of where the wall once stood; the delineation still shows.
