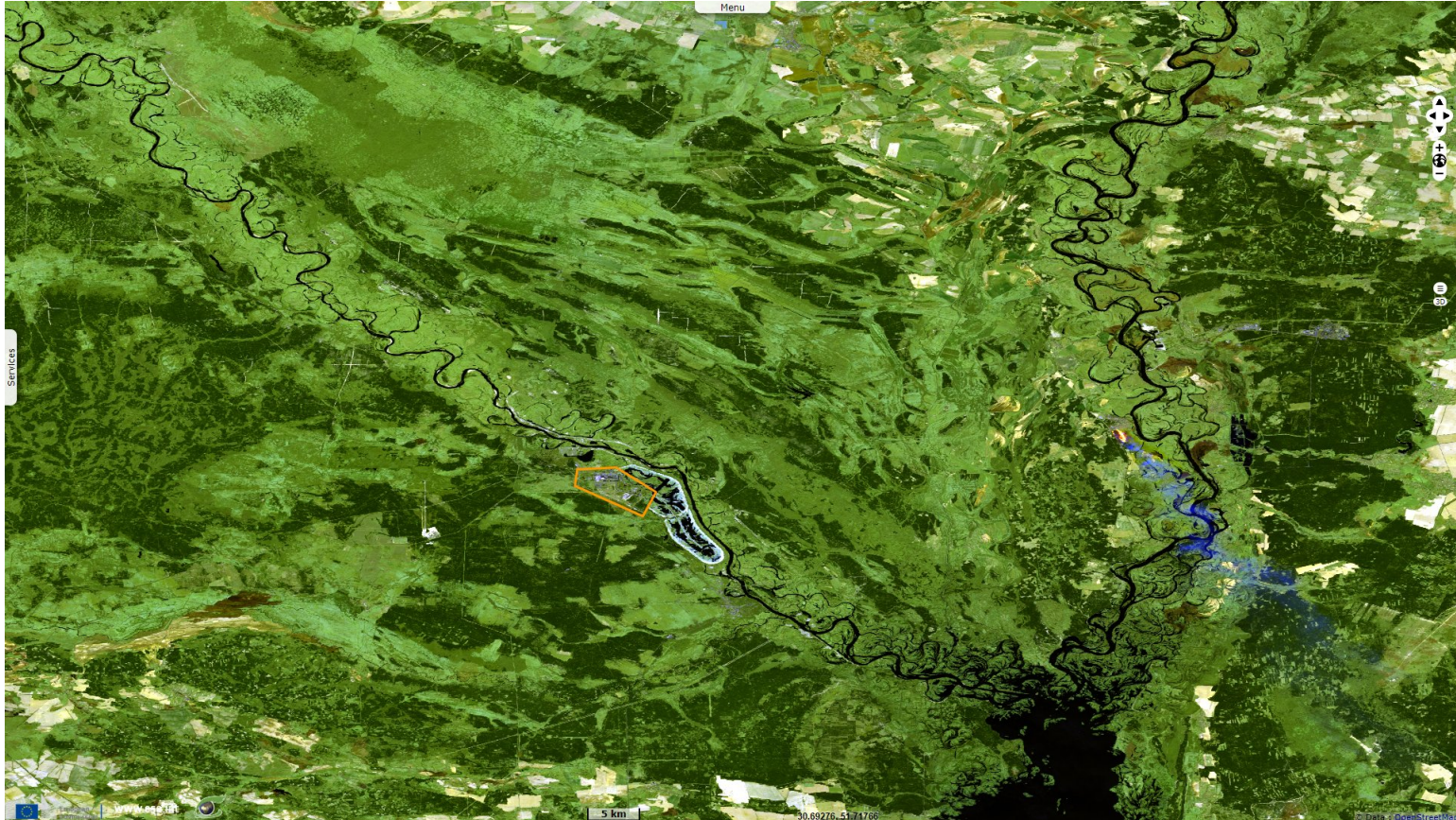


Fig. 2 - S2 (12.04.2020) - 12,11,2 colour composite - While not the largest, one of these is approaching Chernobyl power plant. [2D animation](#) [2D view](#)

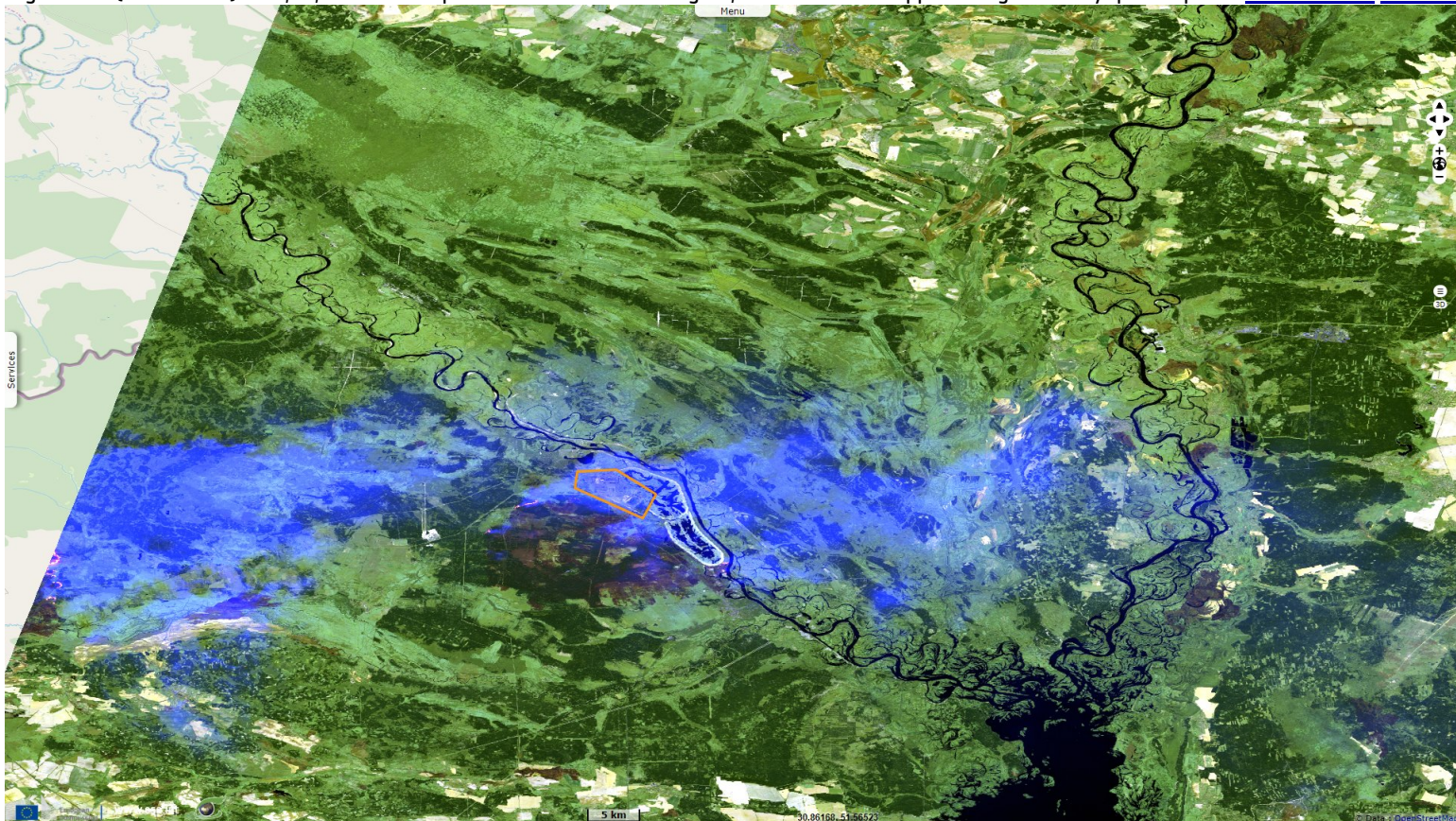


Fig. 3 - S2 (07.04.2020) - 8,4,3 colour composite - View before this wildfire started.

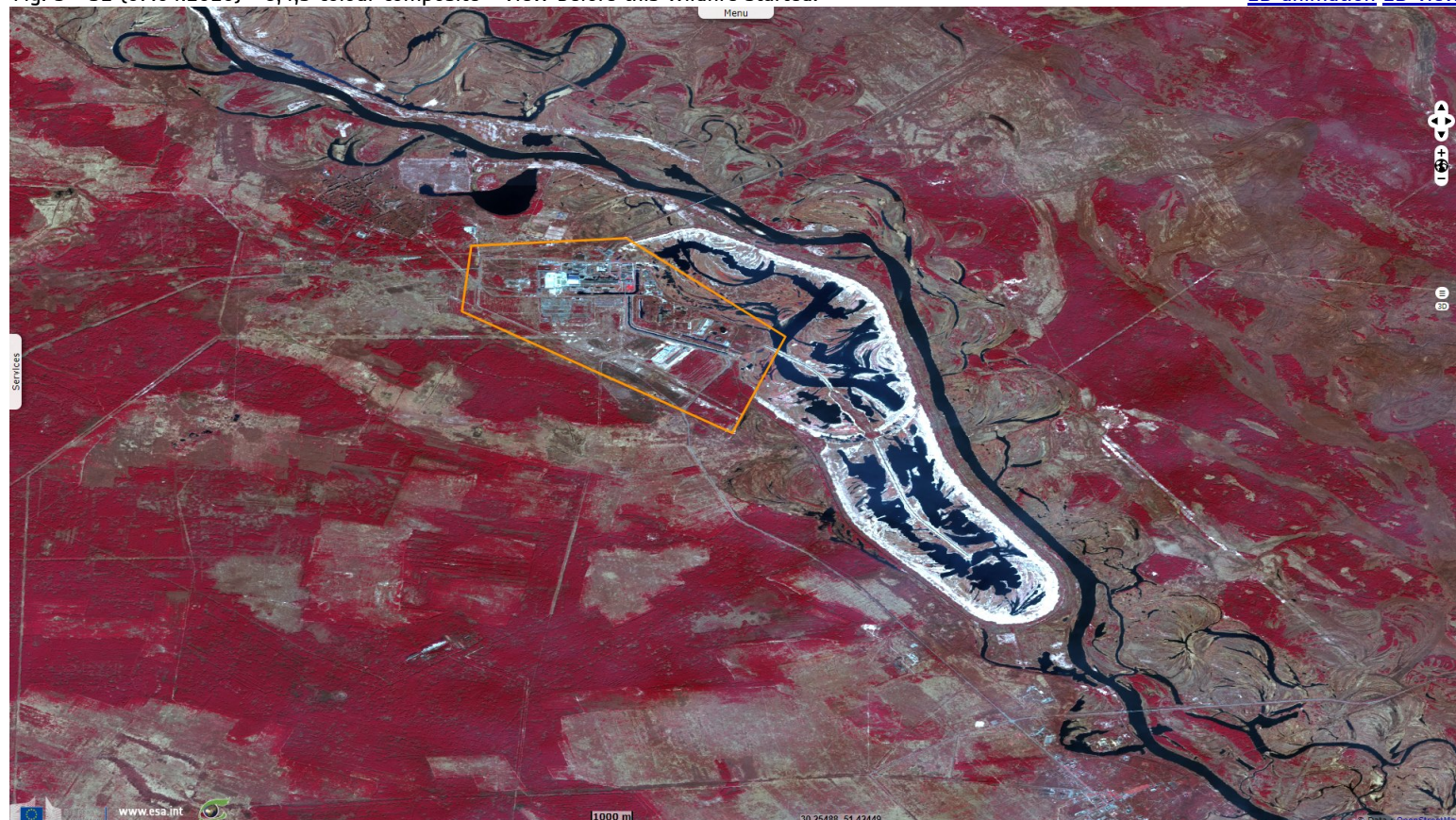
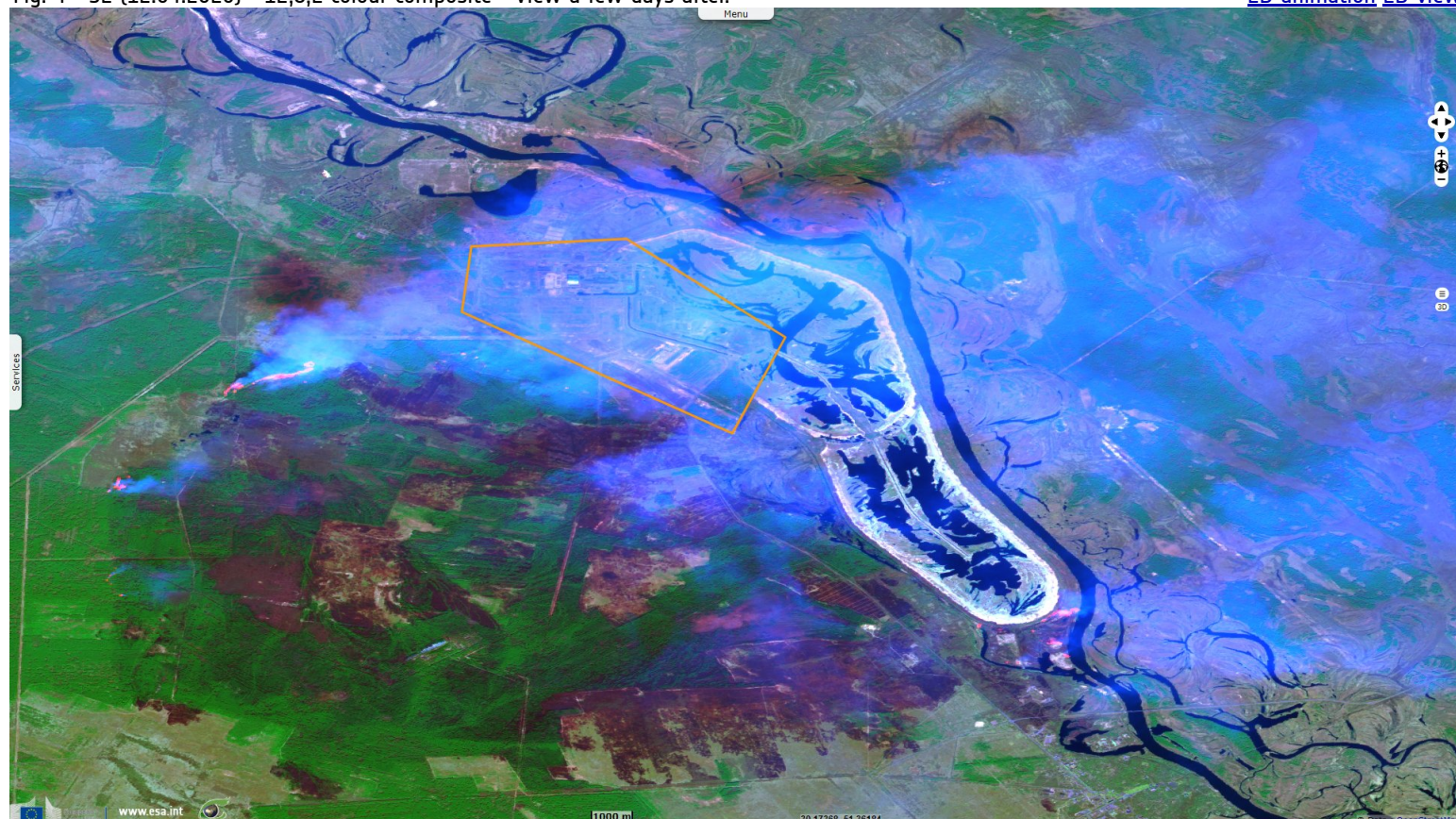


Fig. 4 - S2 (12.04.2020) - 12,8,2 colour composite - View a few days after.
