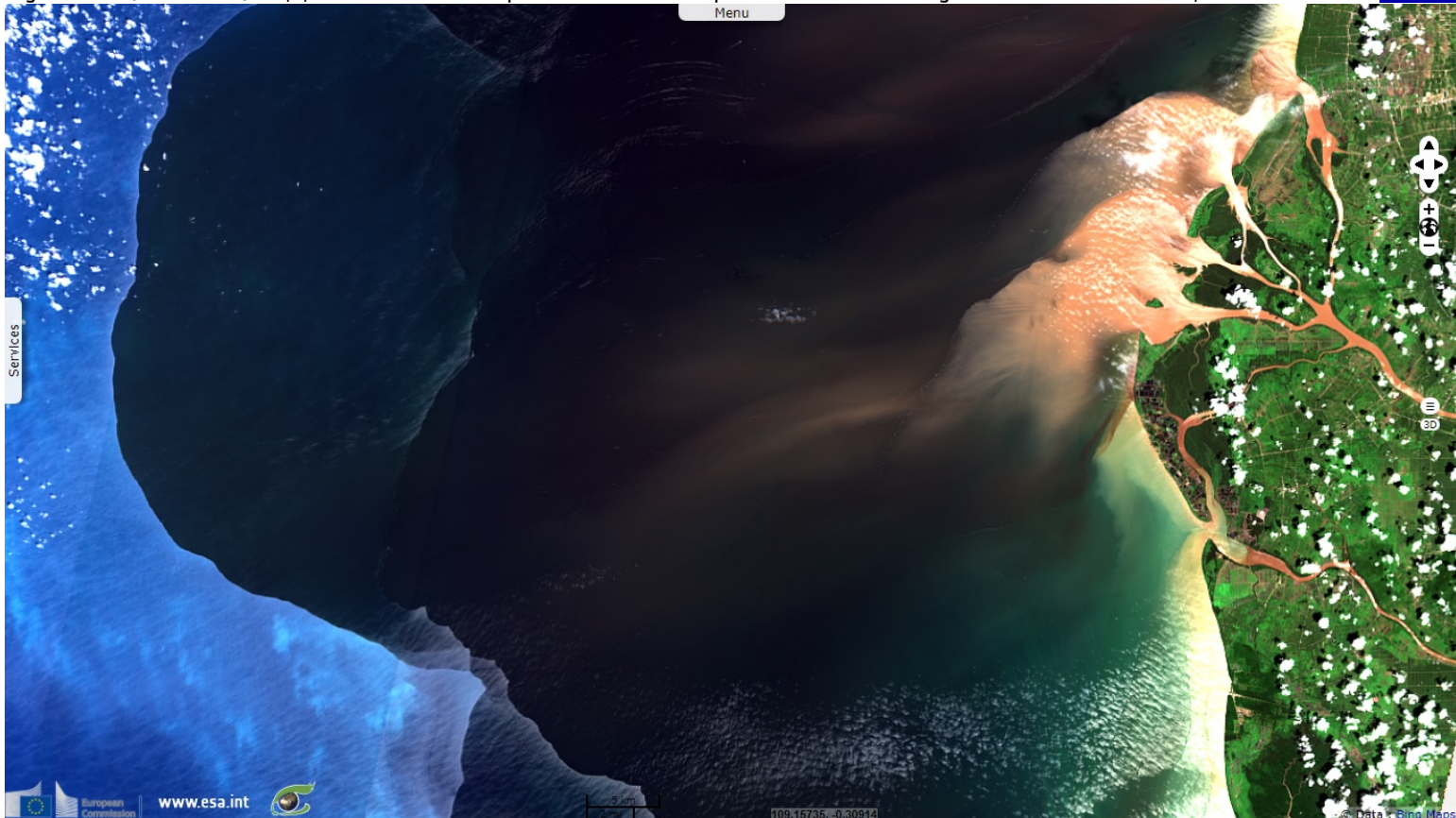


Fig. 2 - Sentinel 1A (07.12.2017) - vv,vh, ndi (vh, vv) orthorectified - Oil palm plantations in southern Borneo, Indonesia.

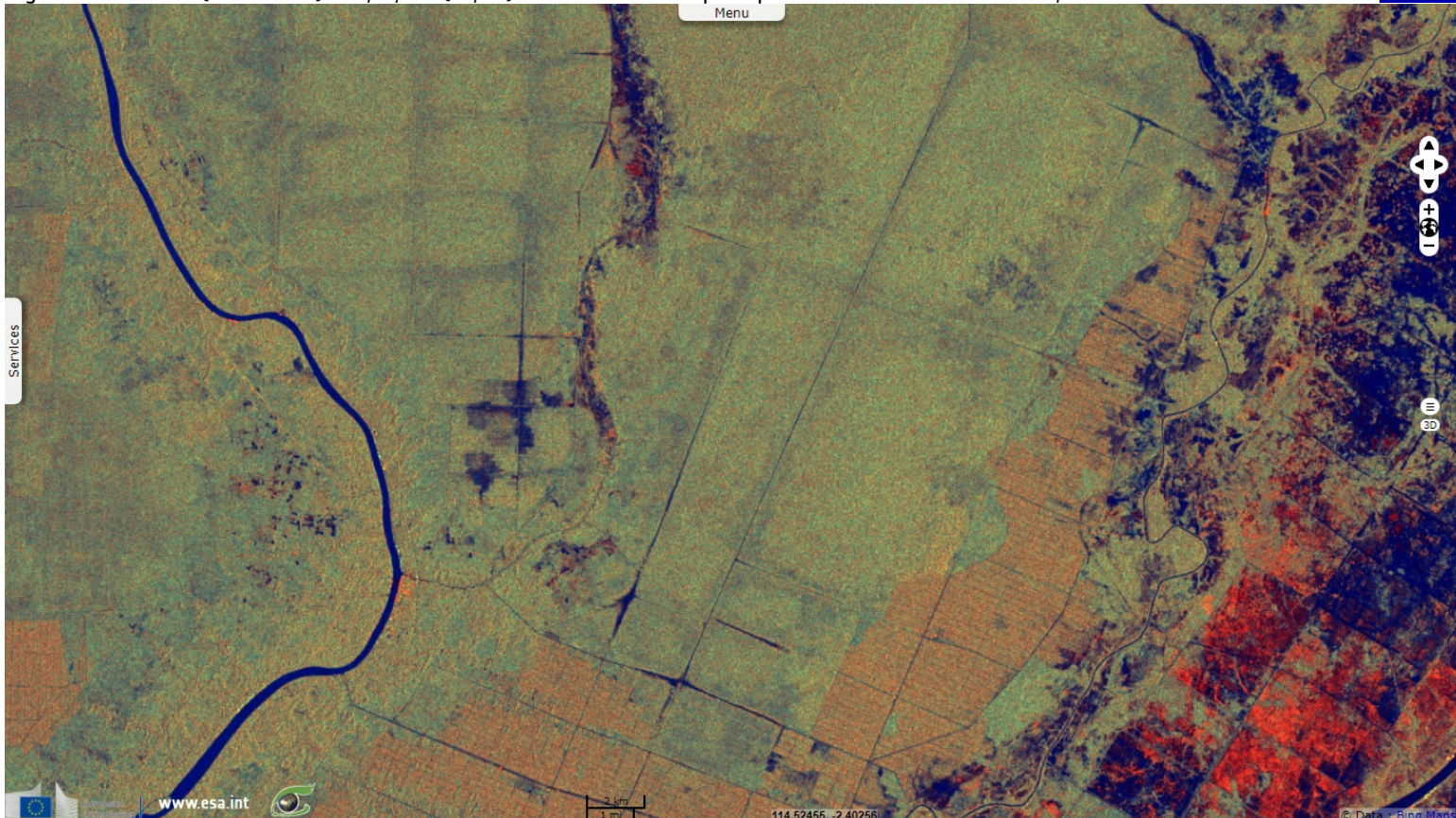


Fig. 3 - S1 (05.12.2017) - Meanders of the Kapuas river, north western Borneo, Indonesia.

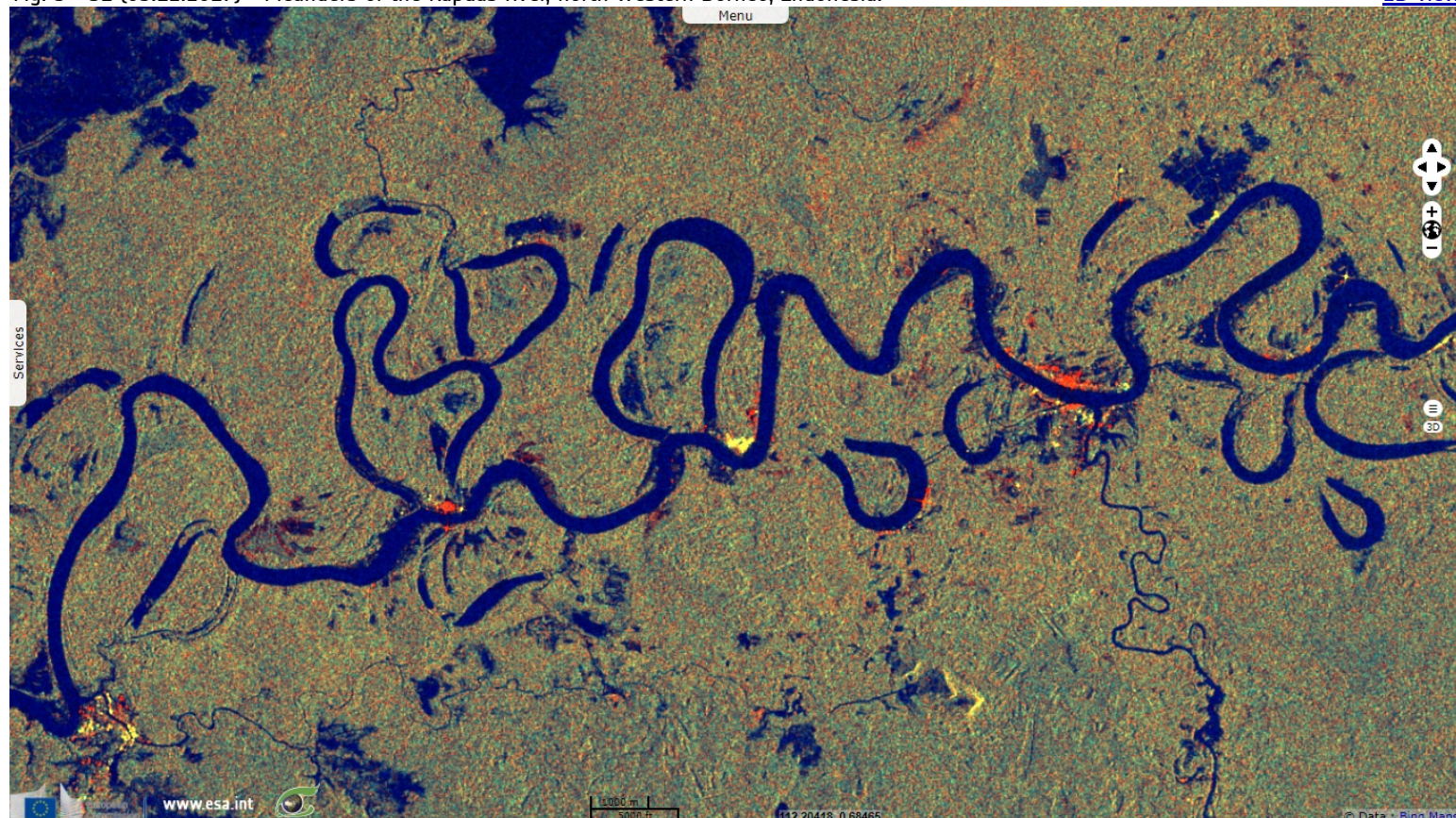


Fig. 4 - S2 (20.07.2017) - 8,4,3 Vegetation colour composite - Mangroves and crops, north eastern Borneo, Indonesia.
