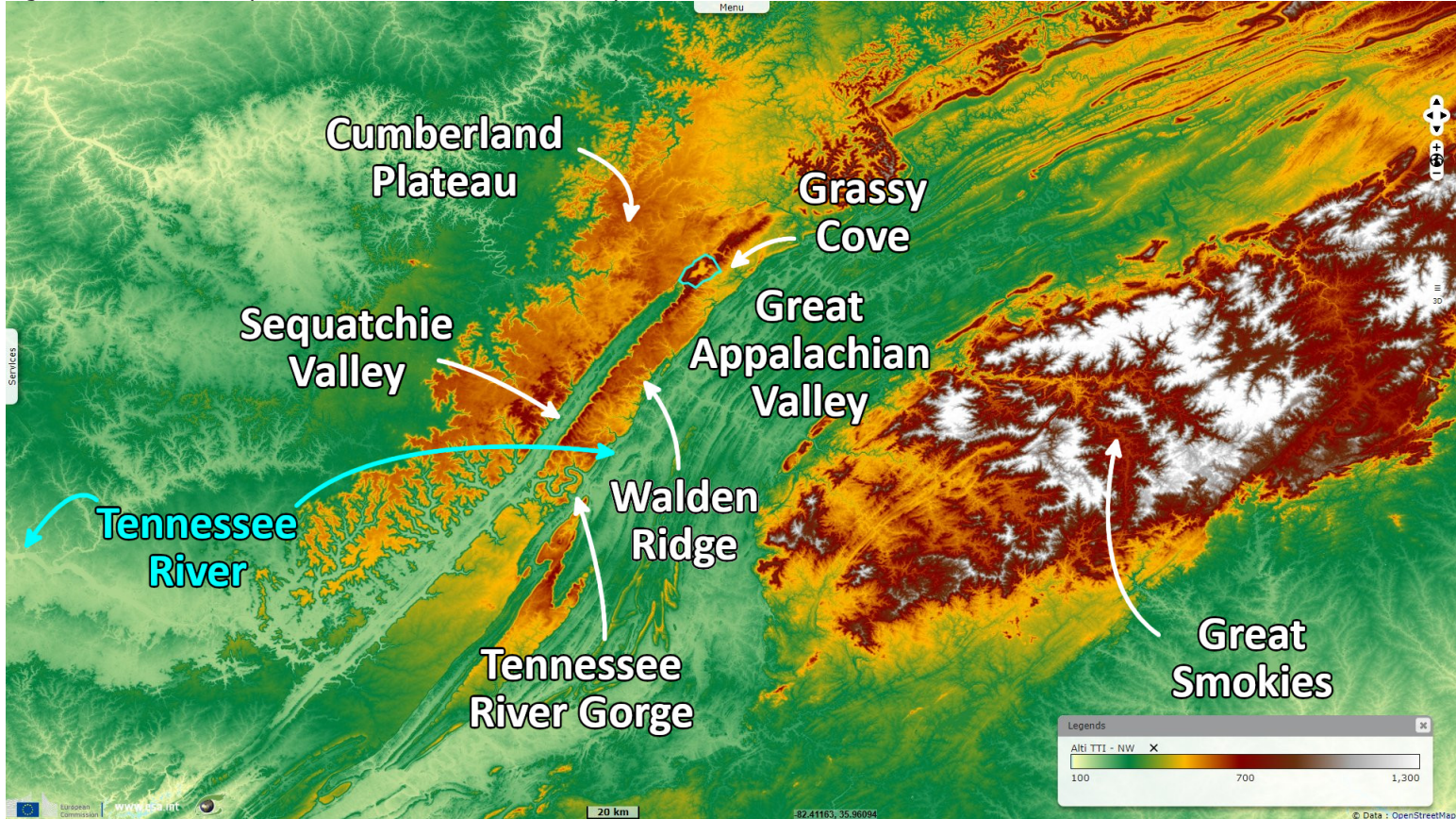


Fig. 2 - S1 (2016.11.19->2016.12.13) / COP-DEM - Grassy Cove is an enclosed valley notable for its karst formations.

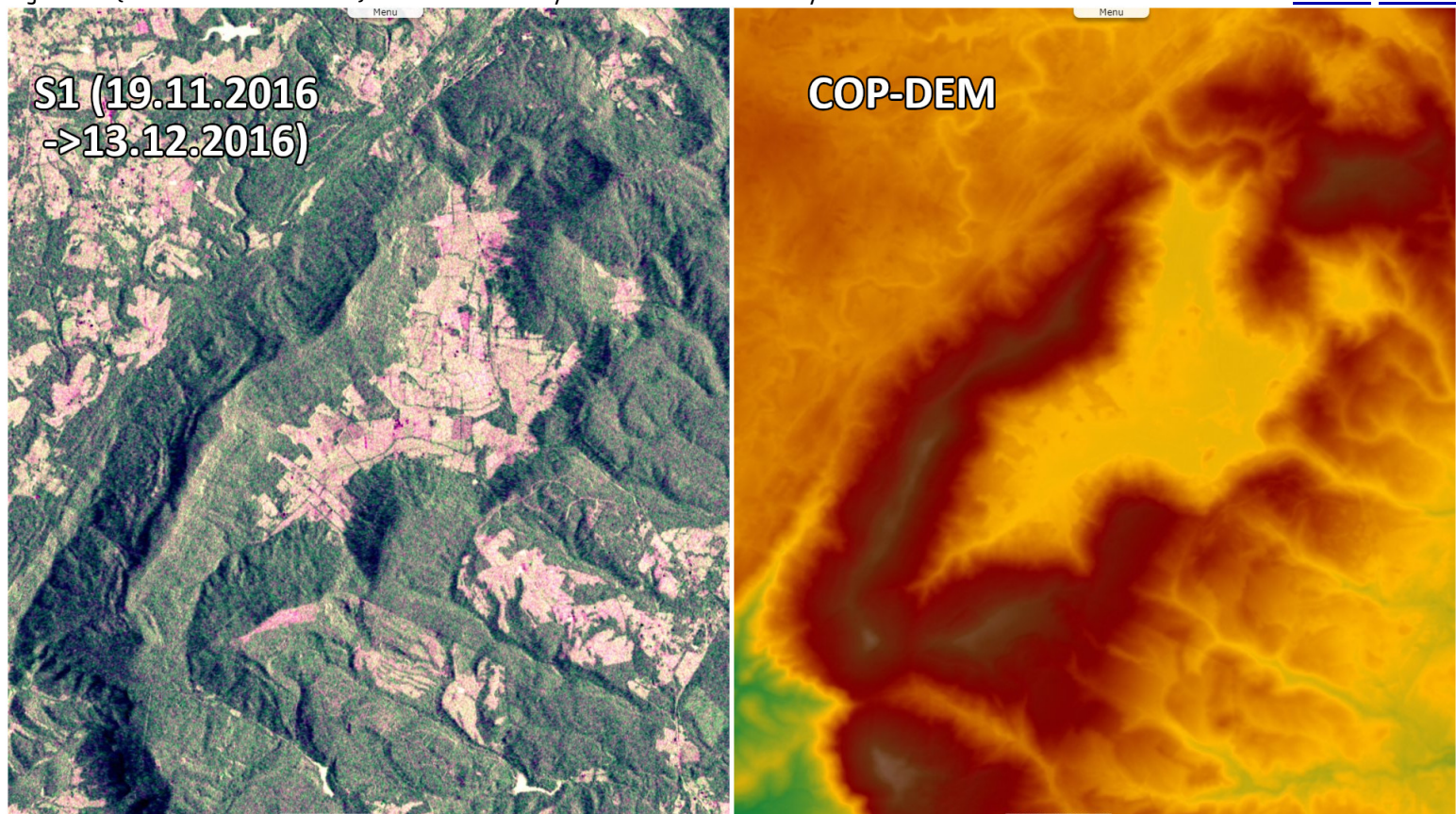
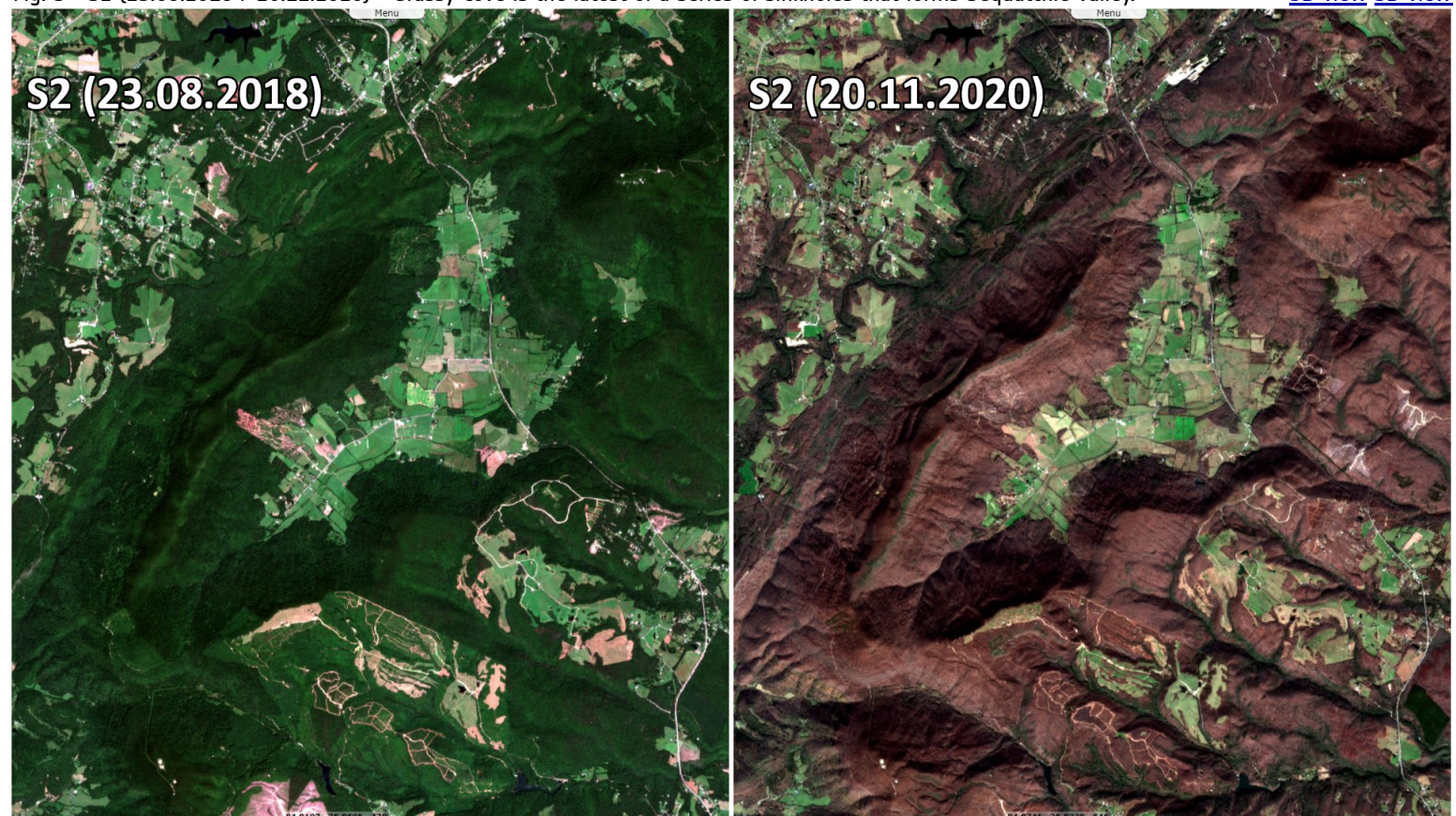


Fig. 3 - S2 (23.08.2018 / 20.11.2020) - Grassy Cove is the latest of a series of sinkholes that forms Sequatchie Valley.
