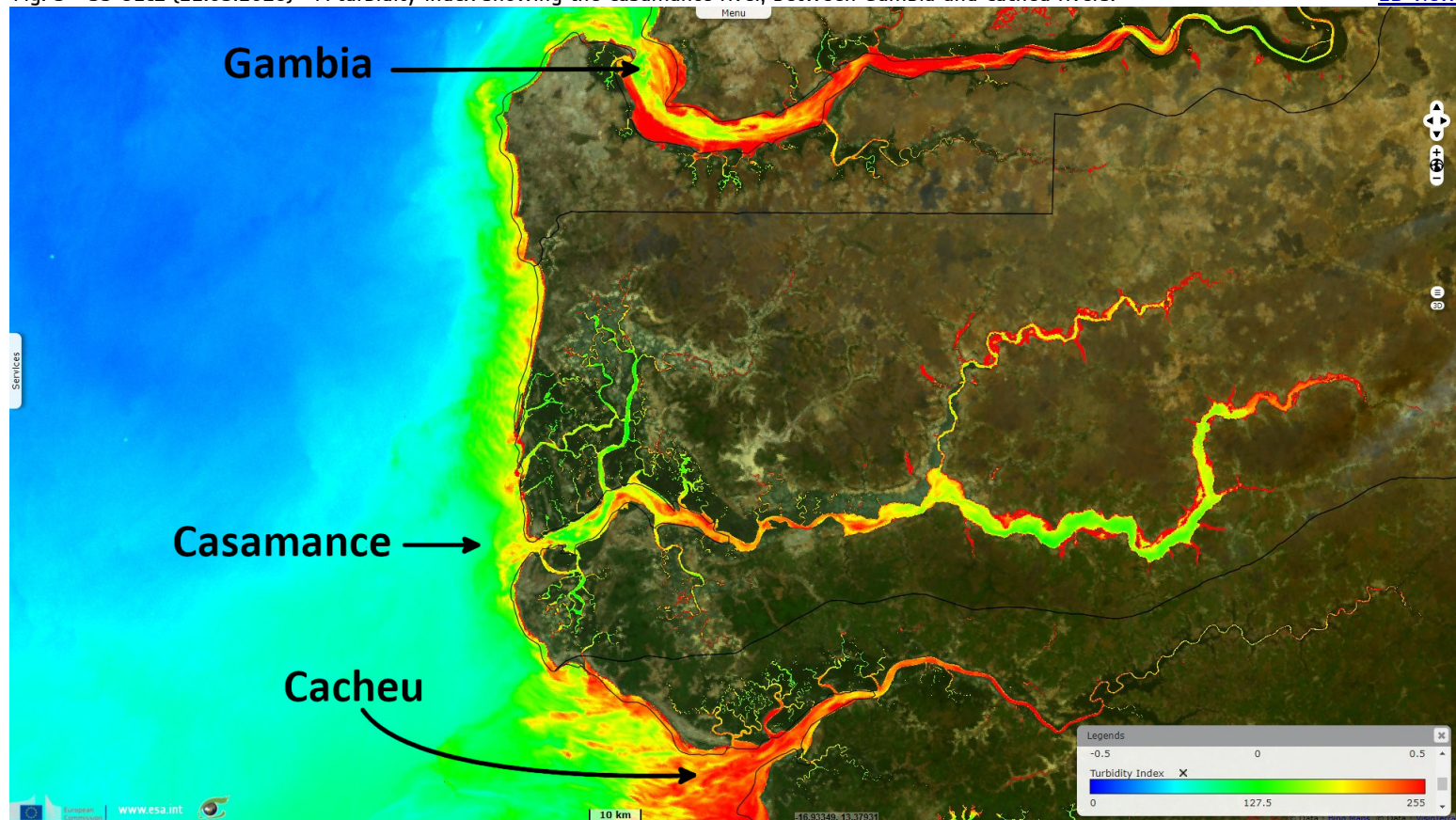


Fig. 4 - S2 (18.03.2022) - Soil moisture index (land) & Chlorophyll index (water) shown on a crop intensive area at the mouth of the Sénégal. [2D view](#)

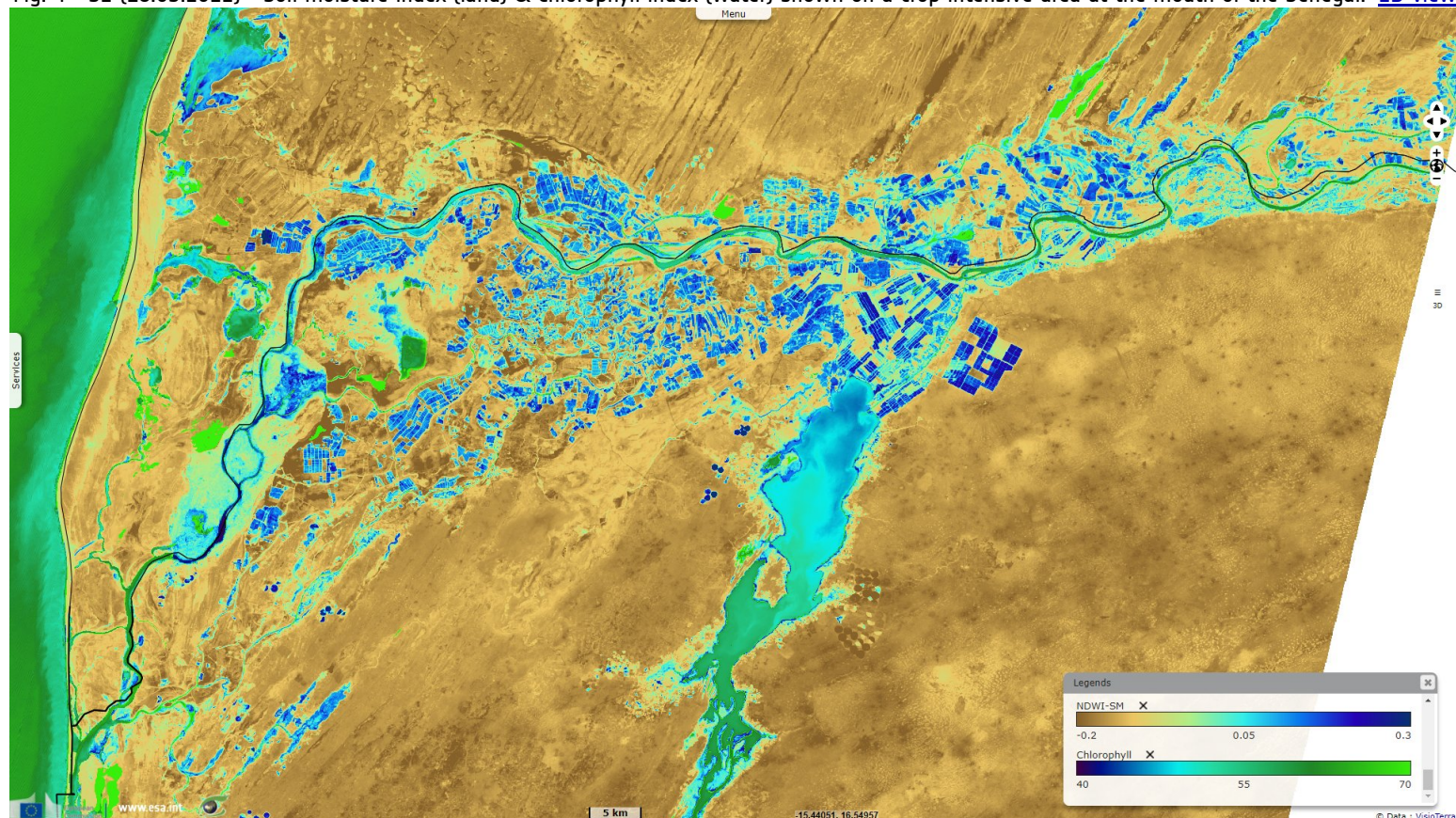


Fig. 5 - S2 - (16.10.2020, 15.11.2020 & 04.01.2021.01.04) - Multidate composite of the open water index showing the Sénégal yearly flood. [2D view](#)

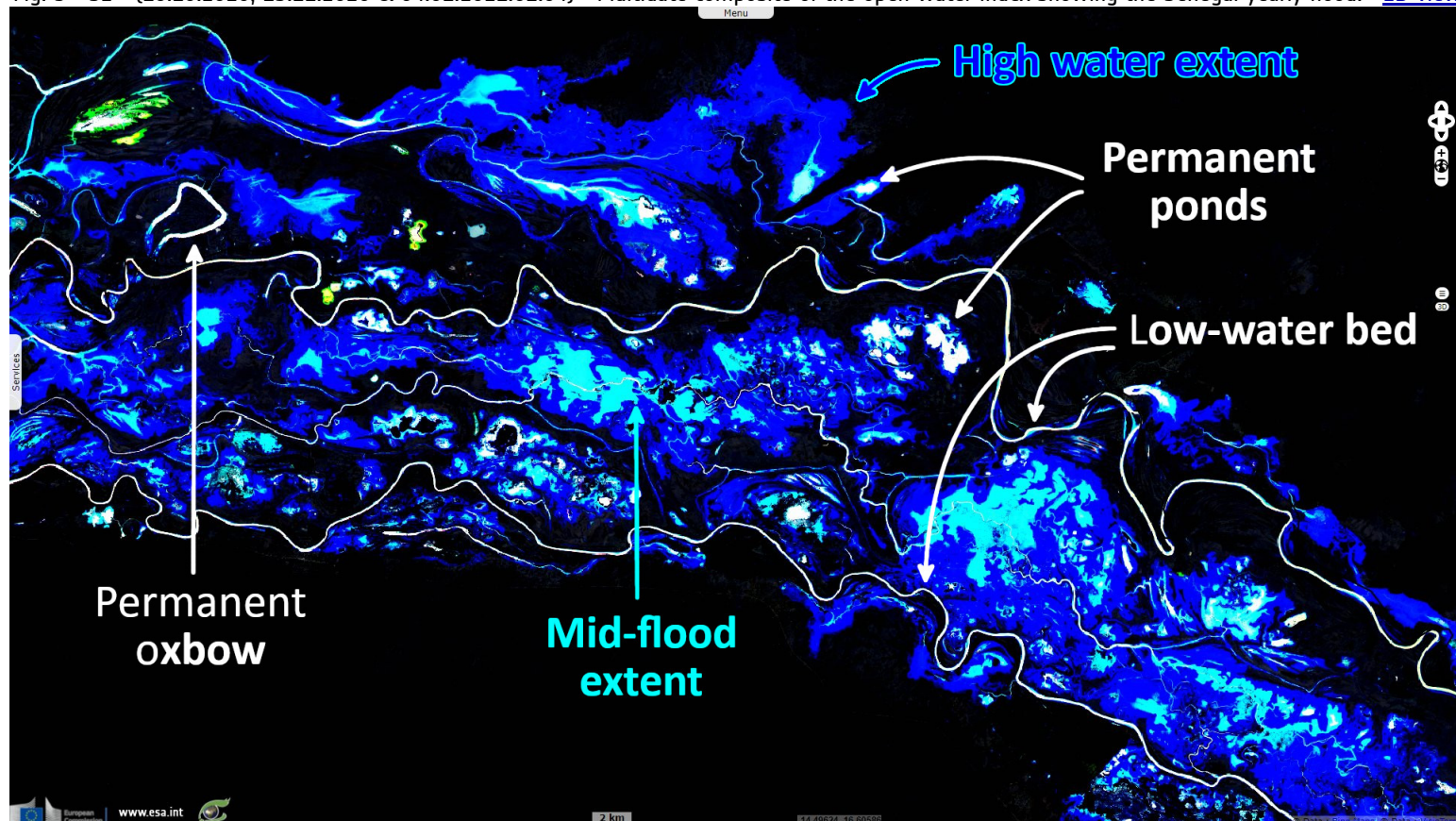
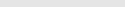


Fig. 6 - S2 (17.03.2022) - The meanders of Sénégal river evolve along time, leaving meander scars of the past path of the river. [2D view](#)



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
