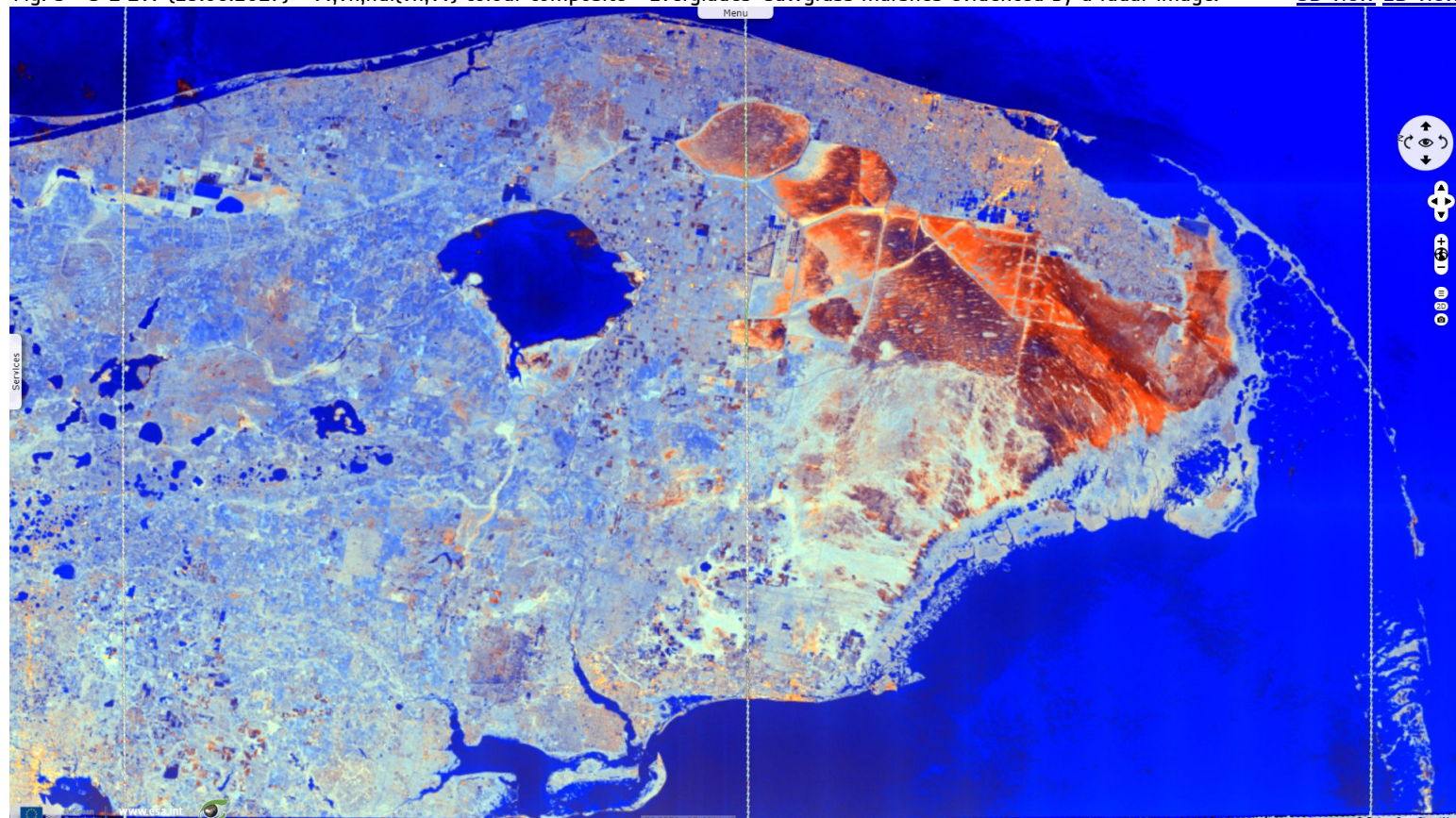
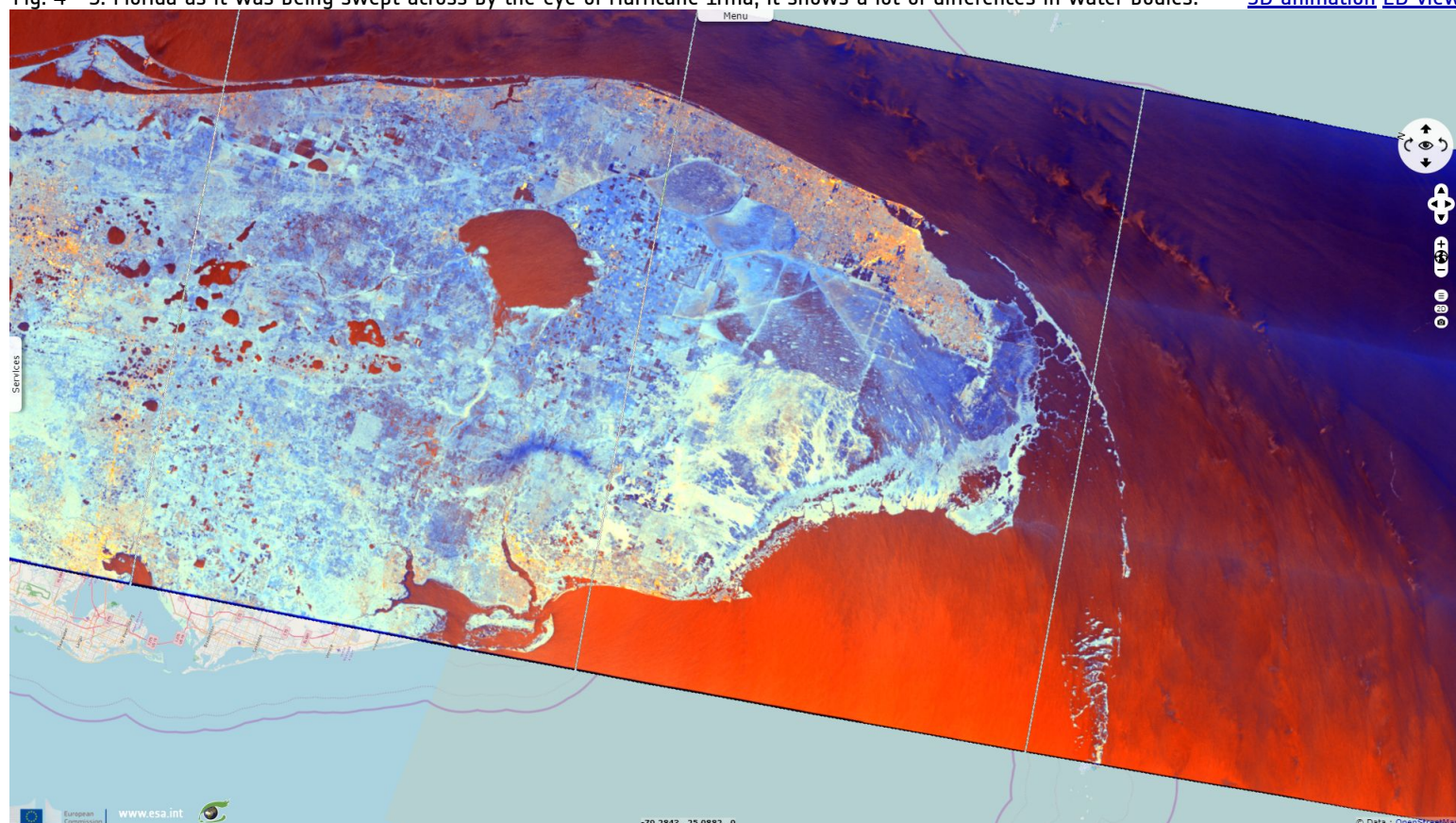


Fig. 4 - S. Florida as it was being swept across by the eye of Hurricane Irma, it shows a lot of differences in water bodies.
