Fig. 1 - S2 (28.12.2021) - During the dry season, herds transhume from north to south. Here, transhumance paths converge towards a well. [2D view](#)

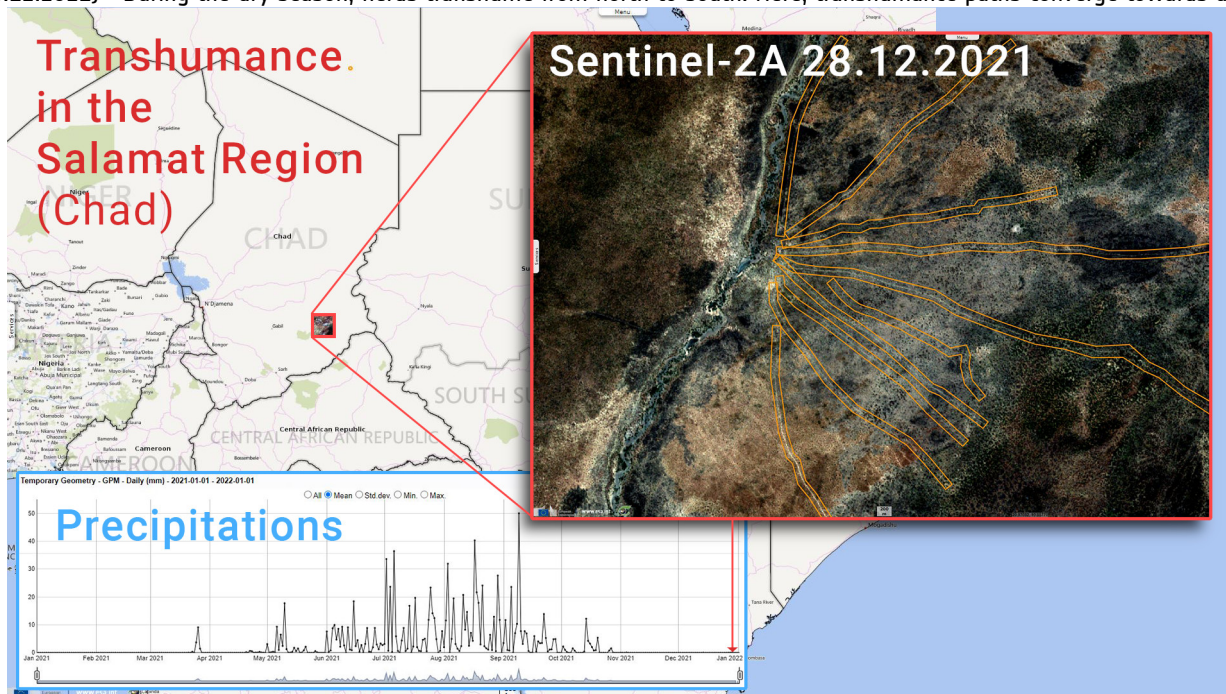
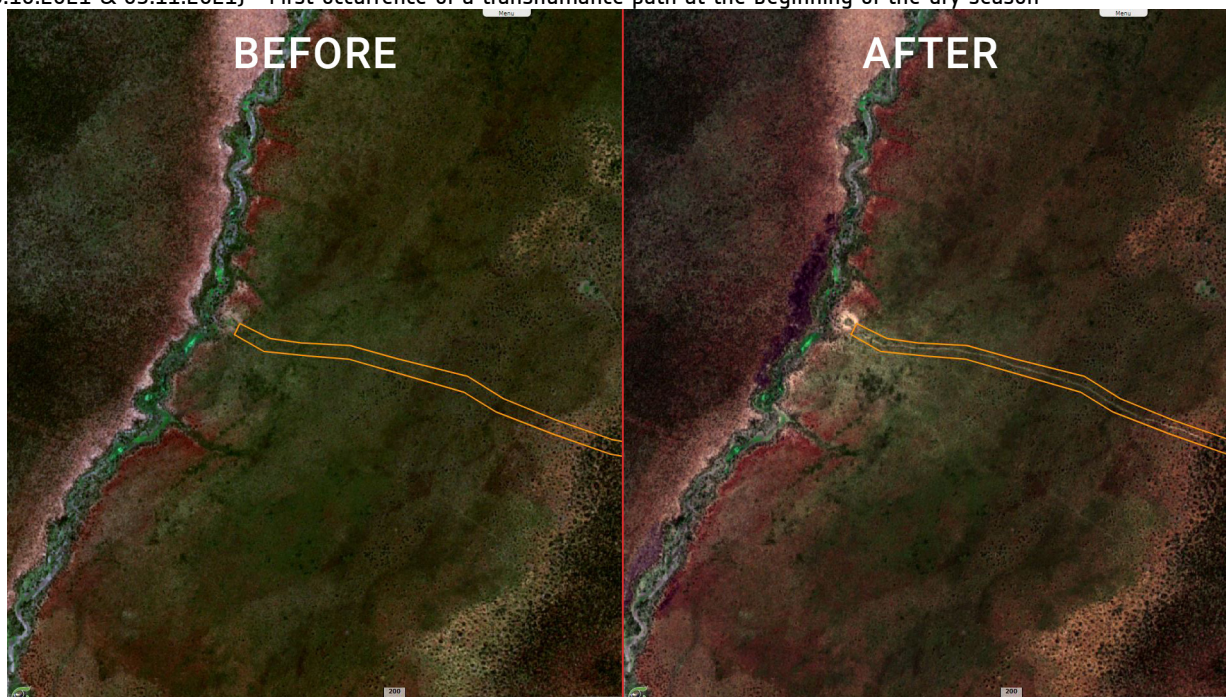


Fig. 2 - S2 (29.10.2021 & 03.11.2021) - First occurrence of a transhumance path at the beginning of the dry season [2D view](#)



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
