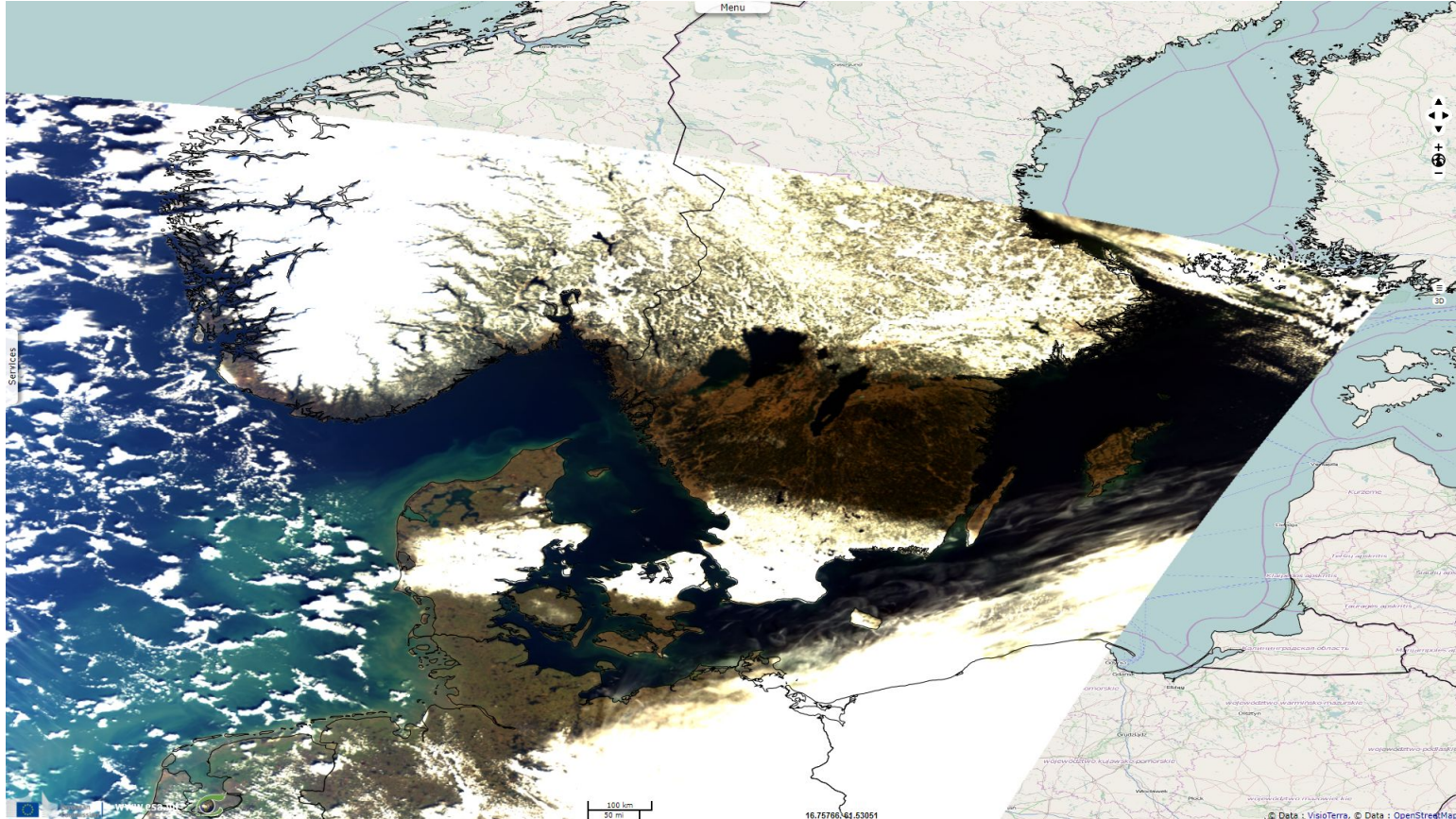


Fig. 2 - (27.11.2016) - Blooms of plankton are frequent close to the Danish coasts - 7-6-4 colour composite. [2D view](#)

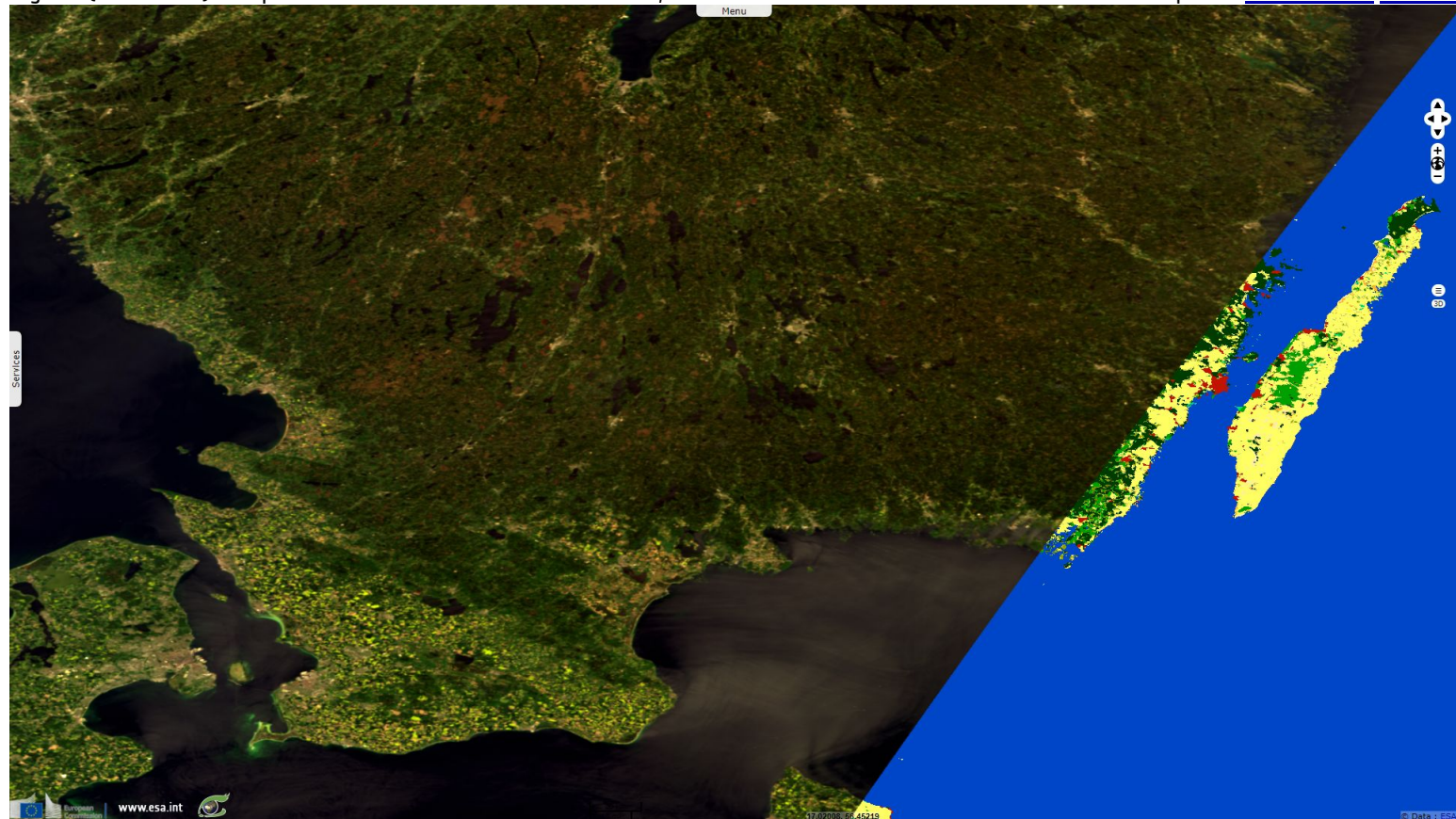
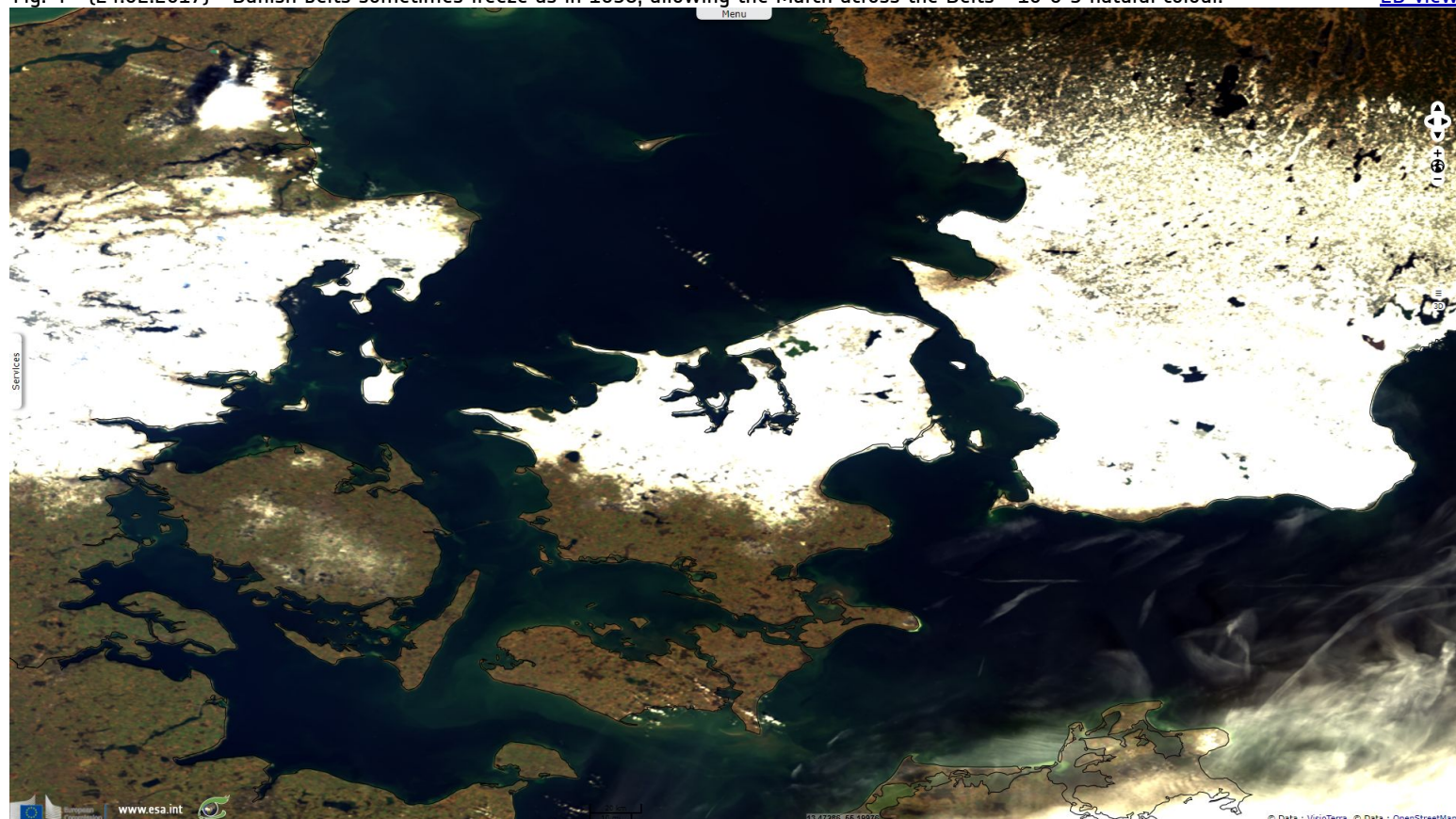


Fig. 4 - (24.02.2017) - Danish belts sometimes freeze as in 1658, allowing the March across the Belts - 10-6-3 natural colour. [2D view](#)



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
