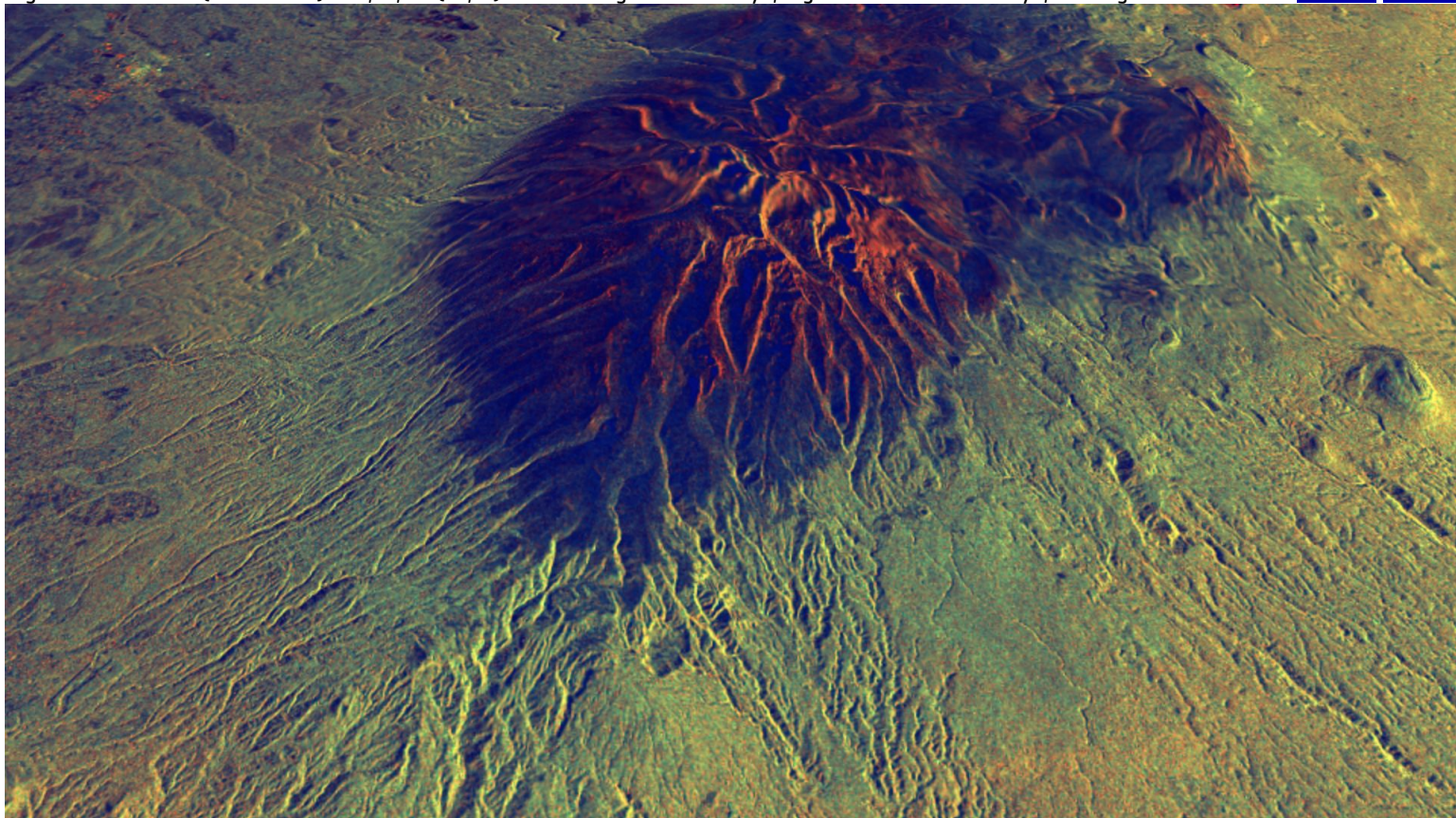
Fig. 1 - Sentinel 2A (20.11.2017) - 11,8,2 colour composite - Turbi Forest, Northern Kenya's border.

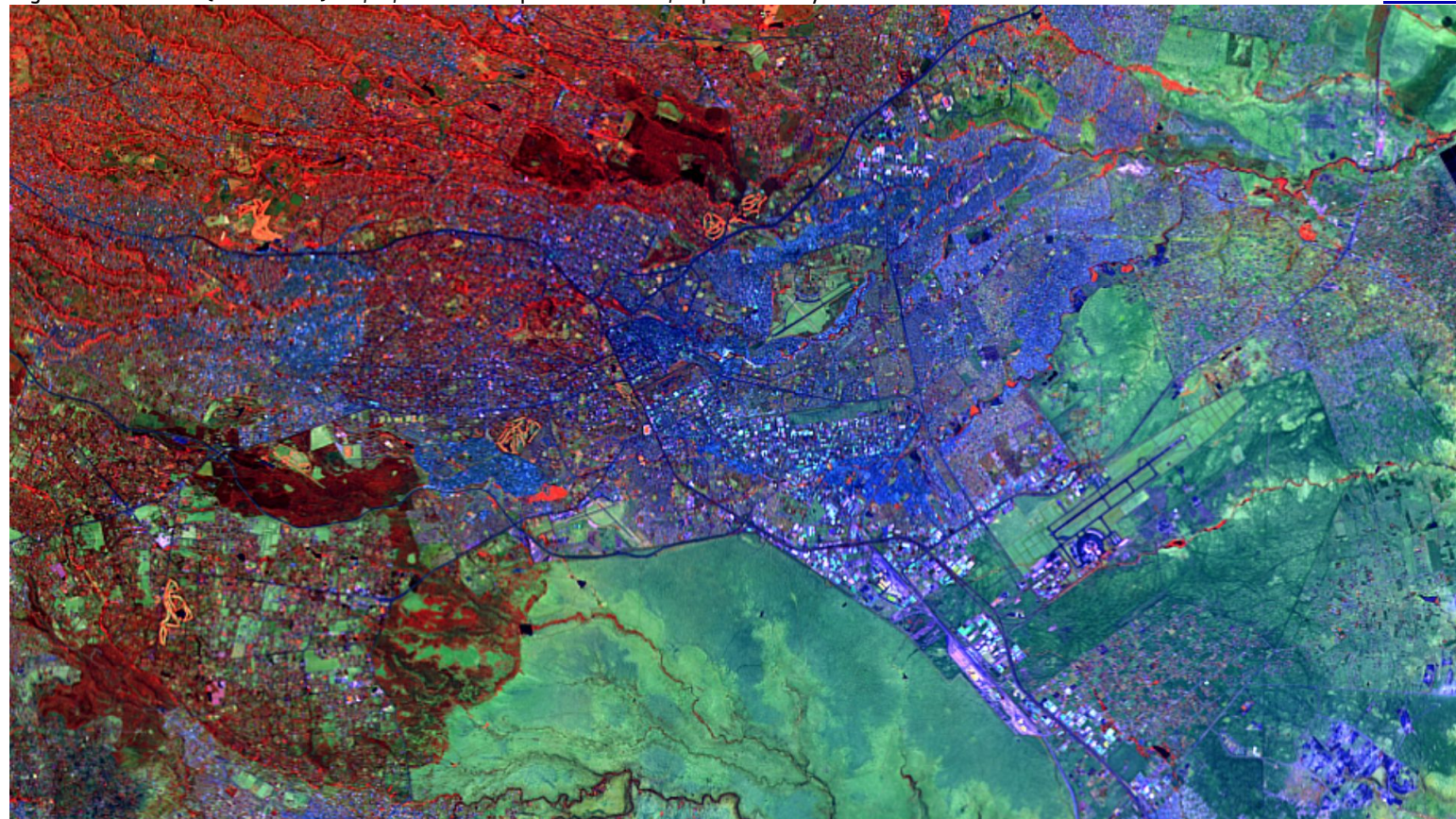


Fig. 4 - S2A (03.11.2017) - 4,3,2 Natural colour composite - Northeastern basin of the Lake Victoria.
