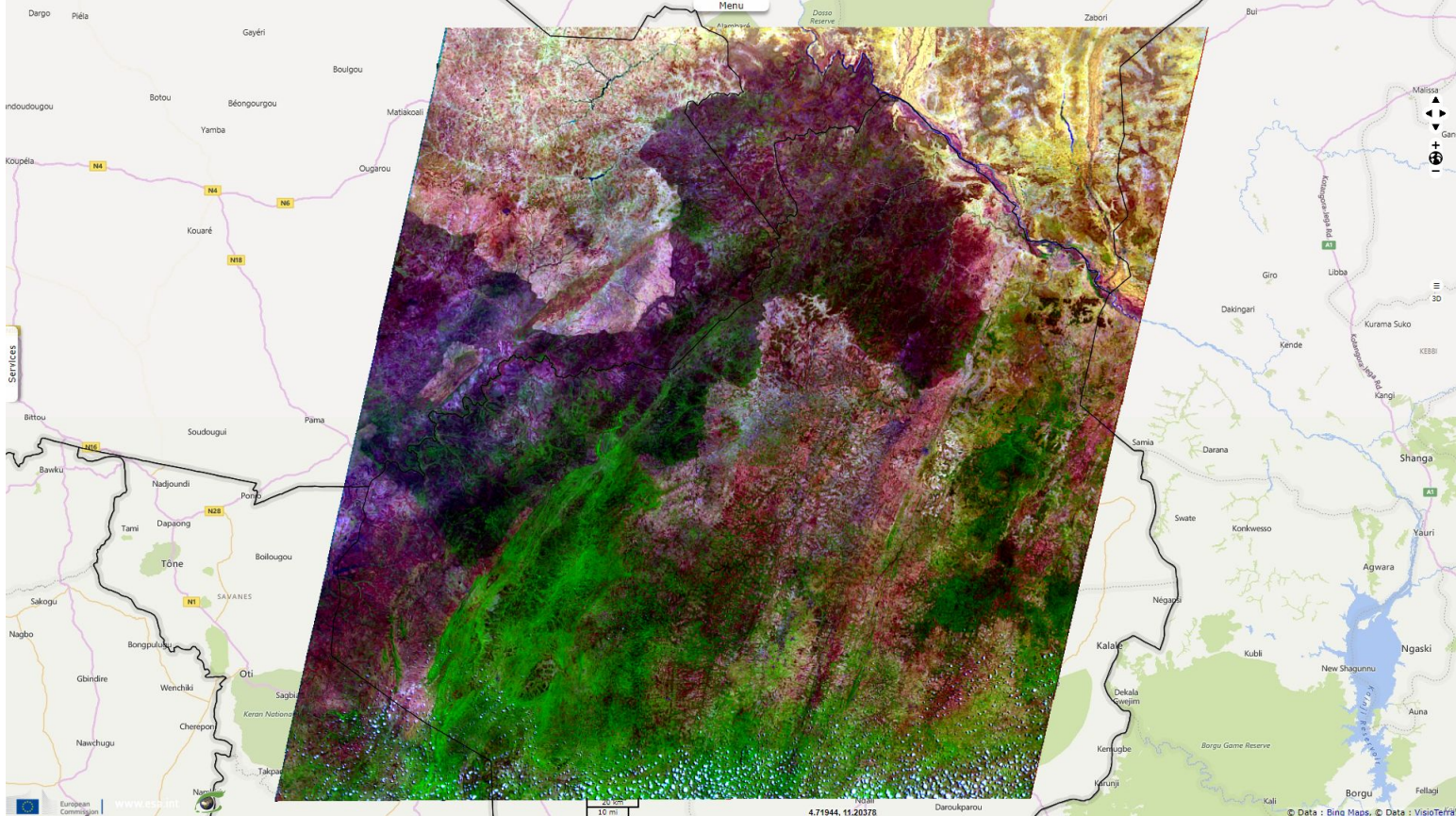
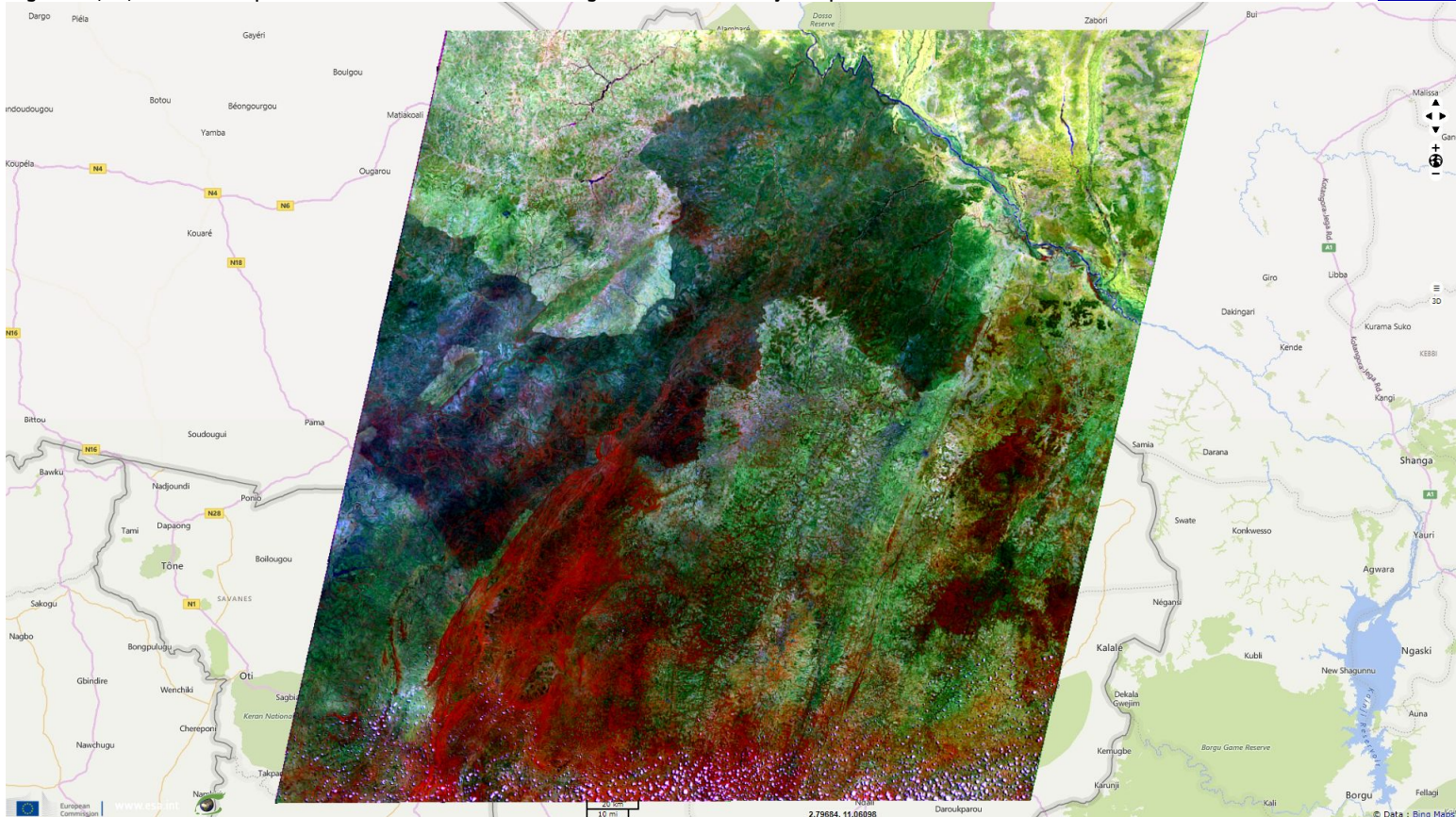


Fig. 2 - 8,11,2 colour composite - This UNESCO World Heritage Site covers a major expanse of intact Sudano-Sahelian savannah. [2D view](#)

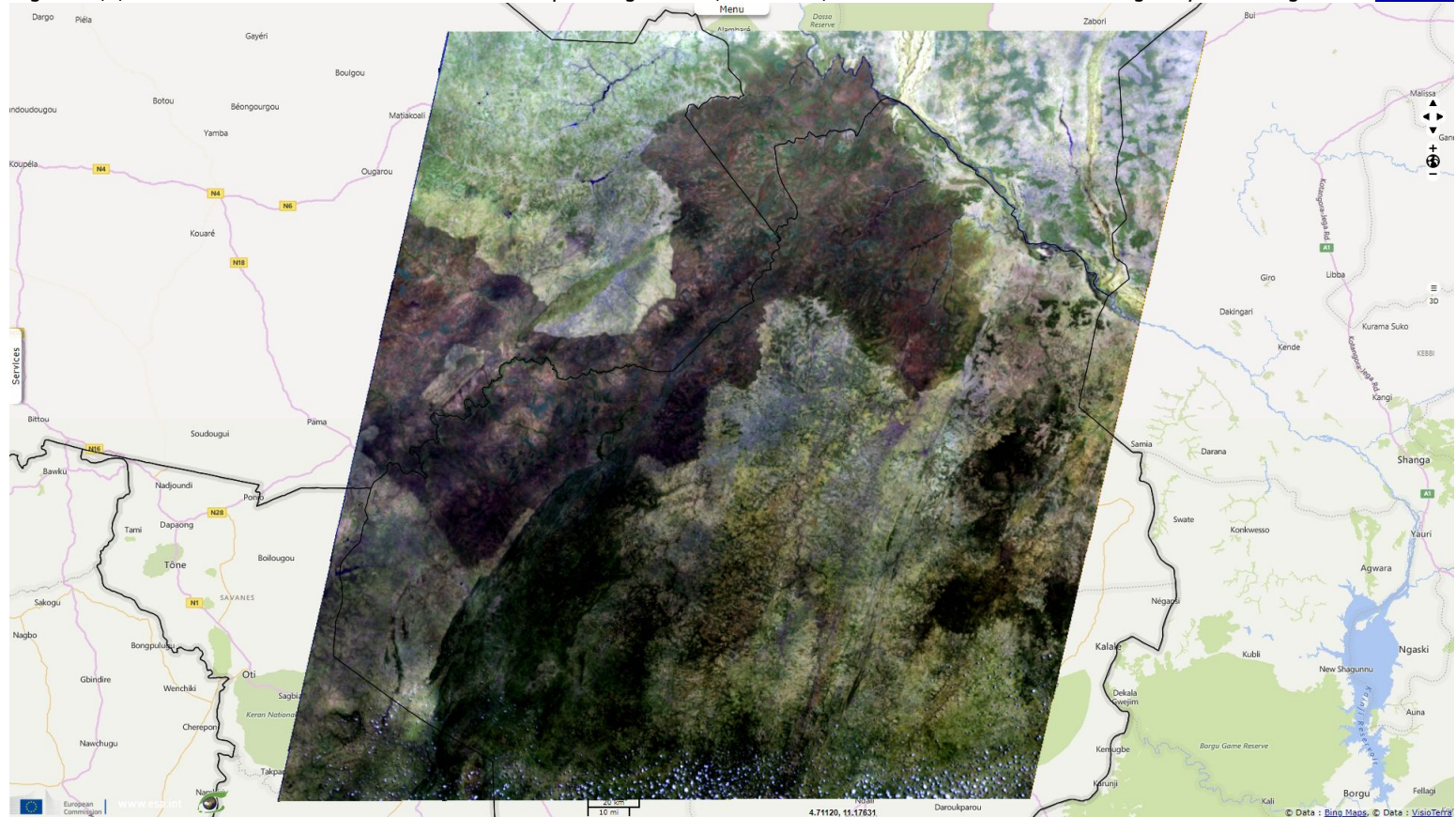
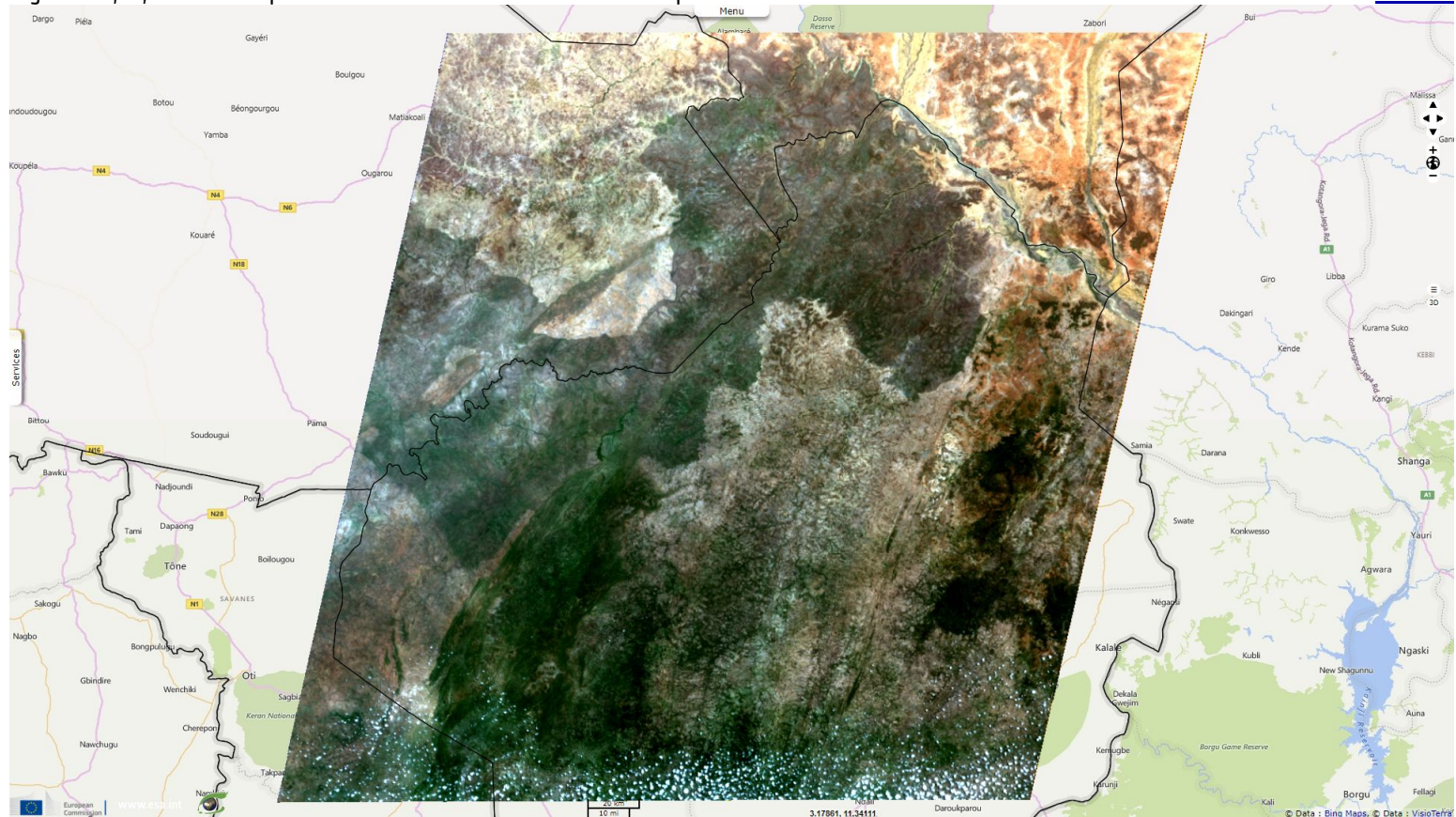


Fig. 4 - 12,11,4 colour composite - It also contains several wetlands protected as Ramsar sites. [2D view](#)



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
