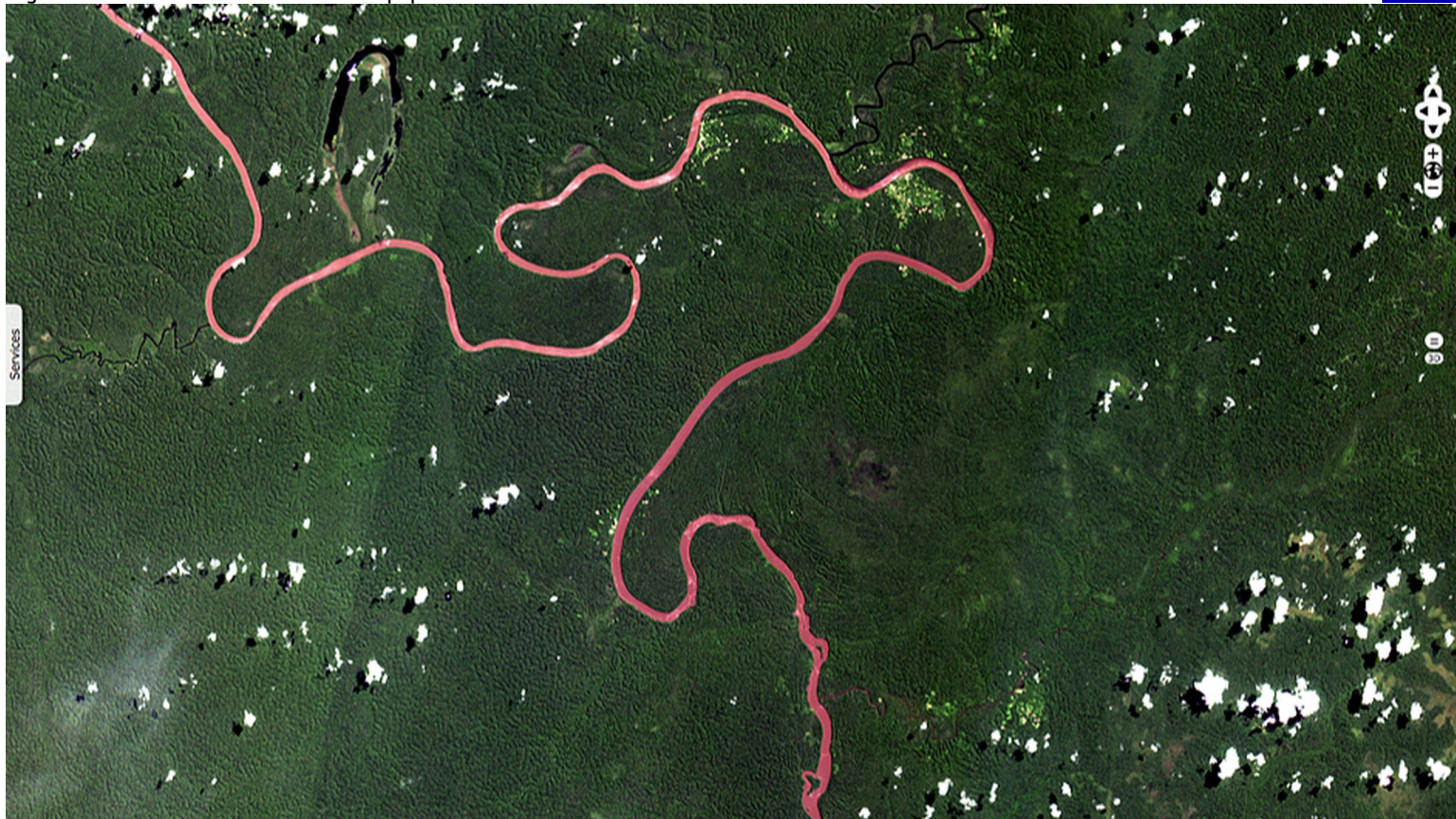


Fig. 3 - S2A MSI - Junction of Guayas (west) and Rio Caguan (center).
