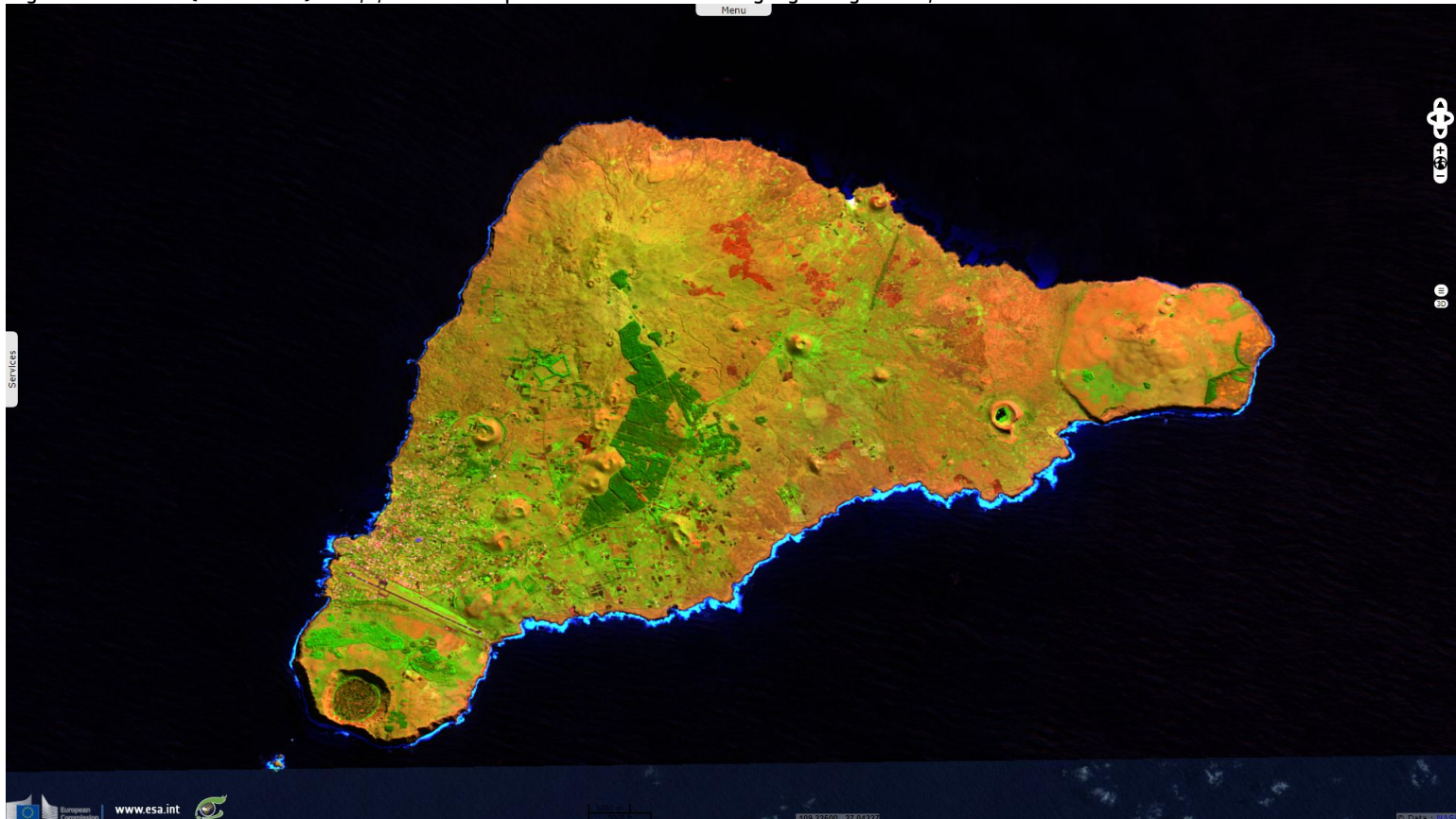


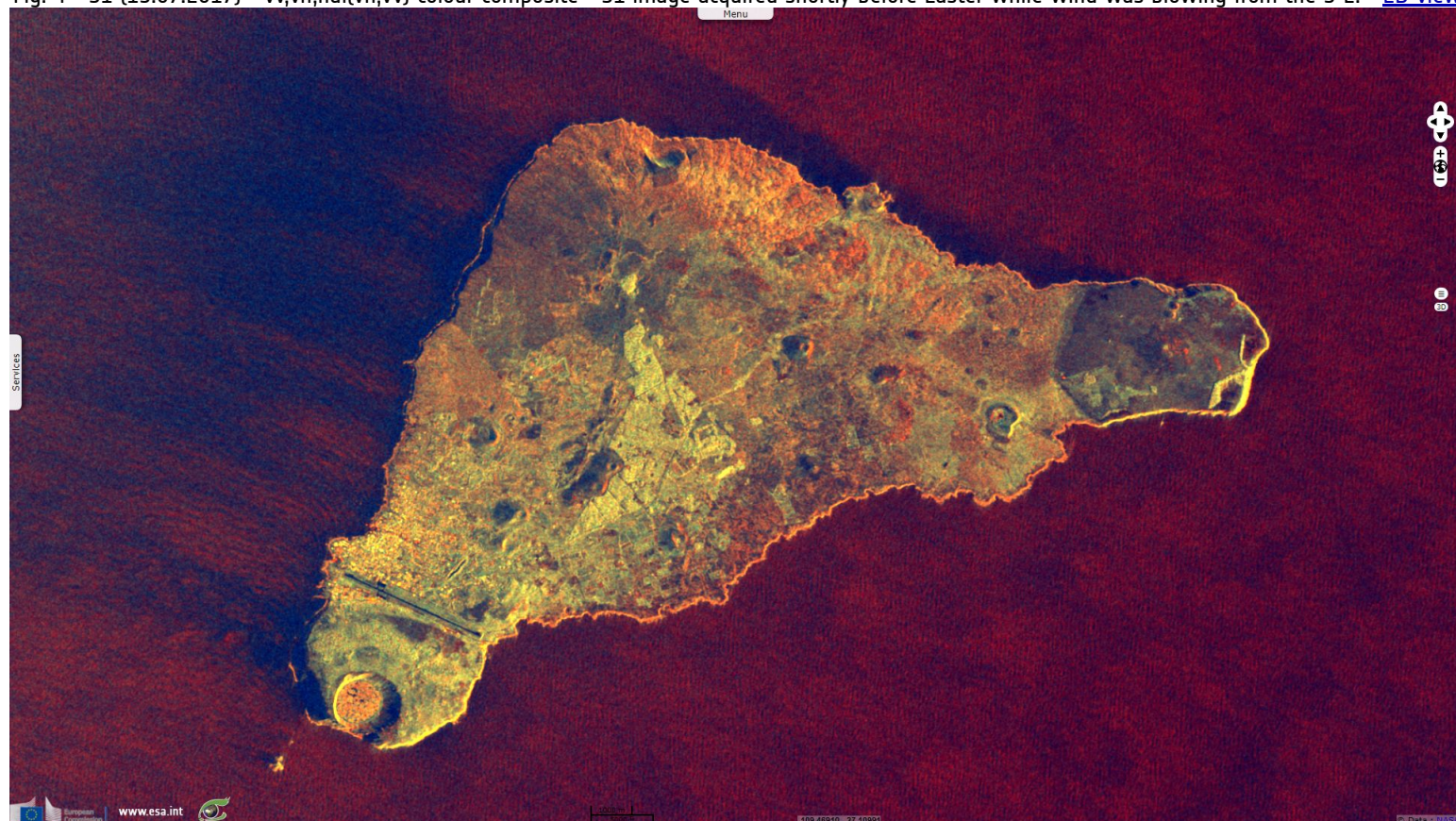
Fig. 3 - Sentinel-1 (13.07.2017) - vv,vh,ndi(vh,vv) colour composite - Structural details revealed by the radar image.
