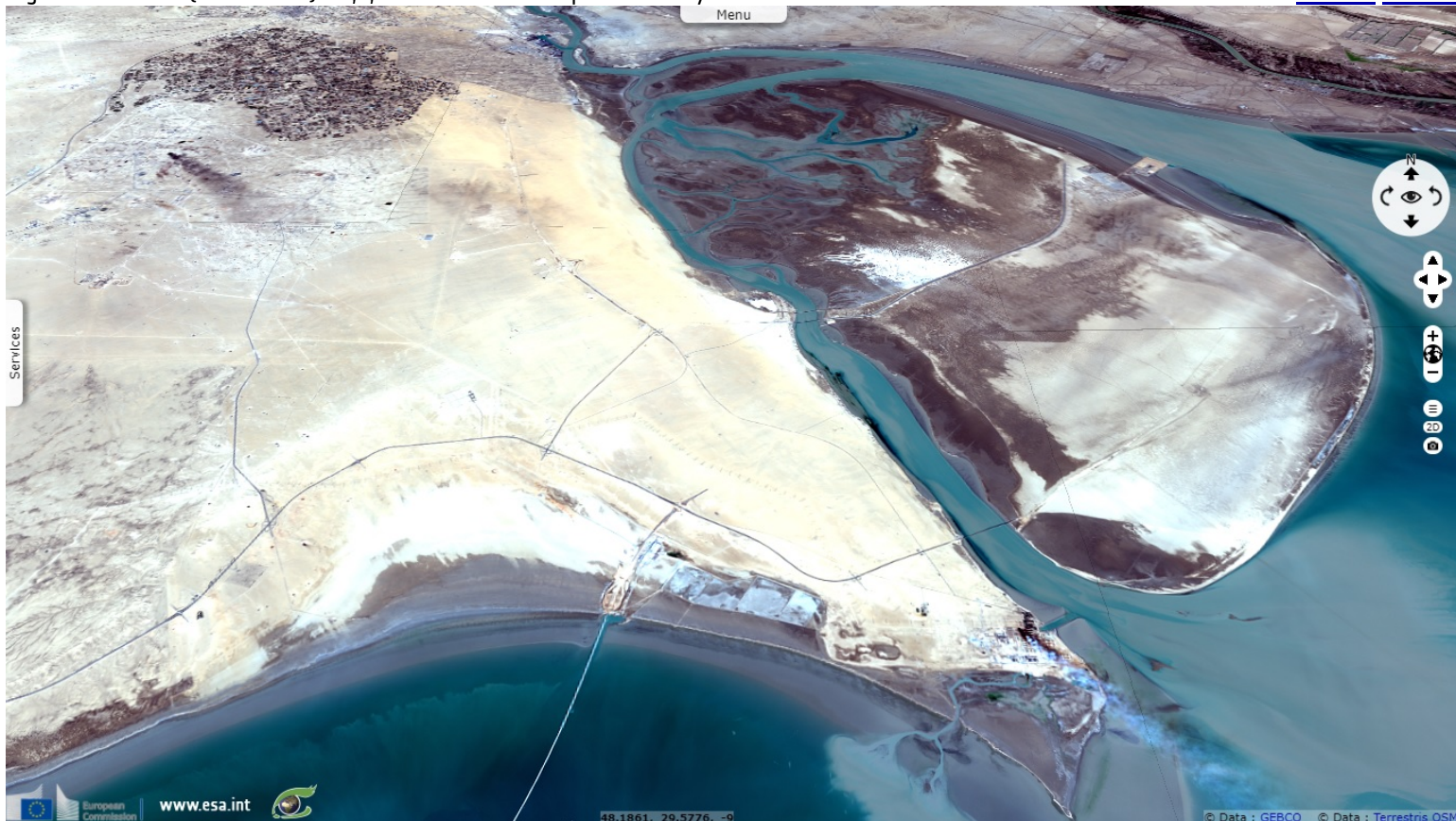

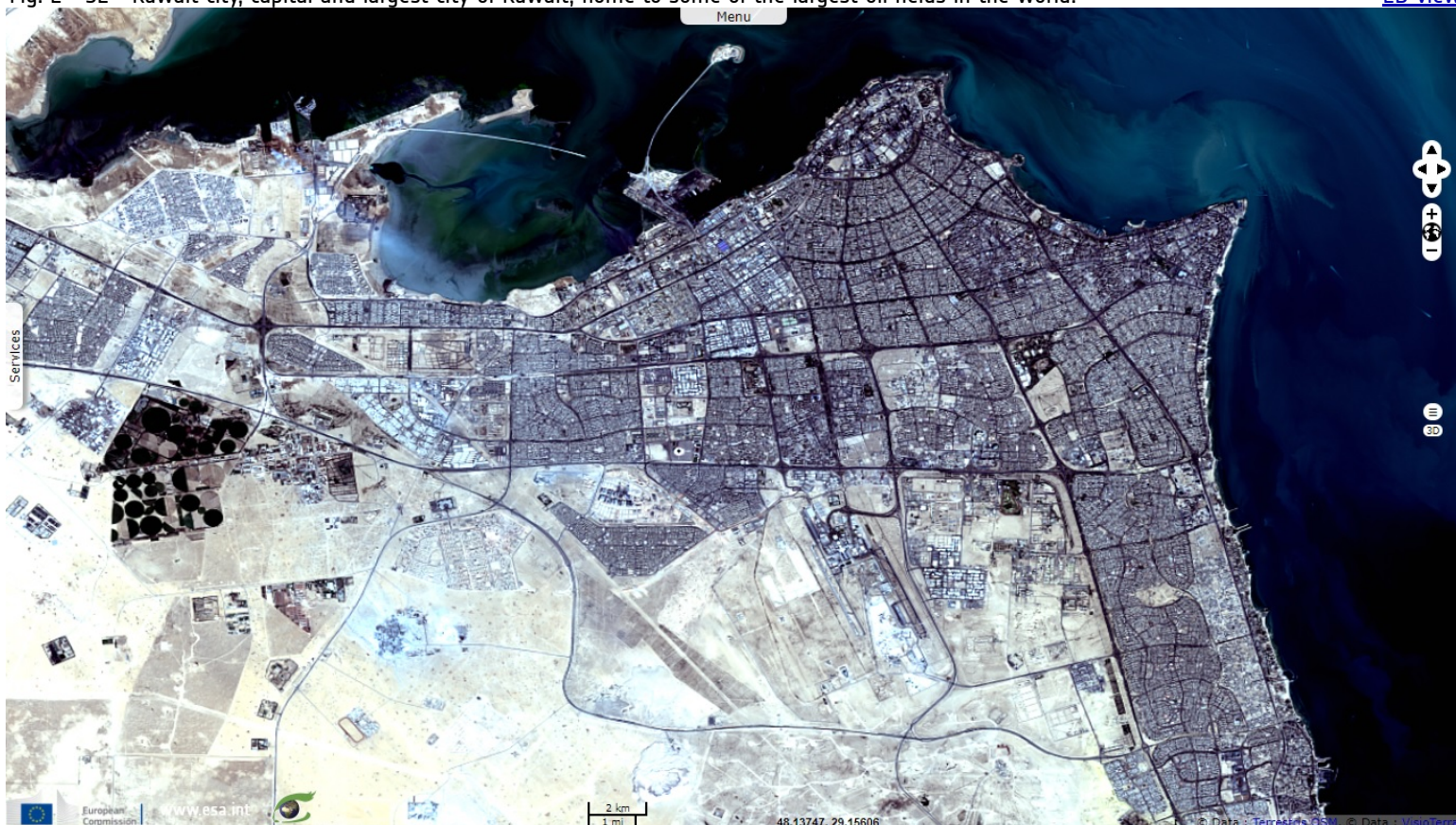


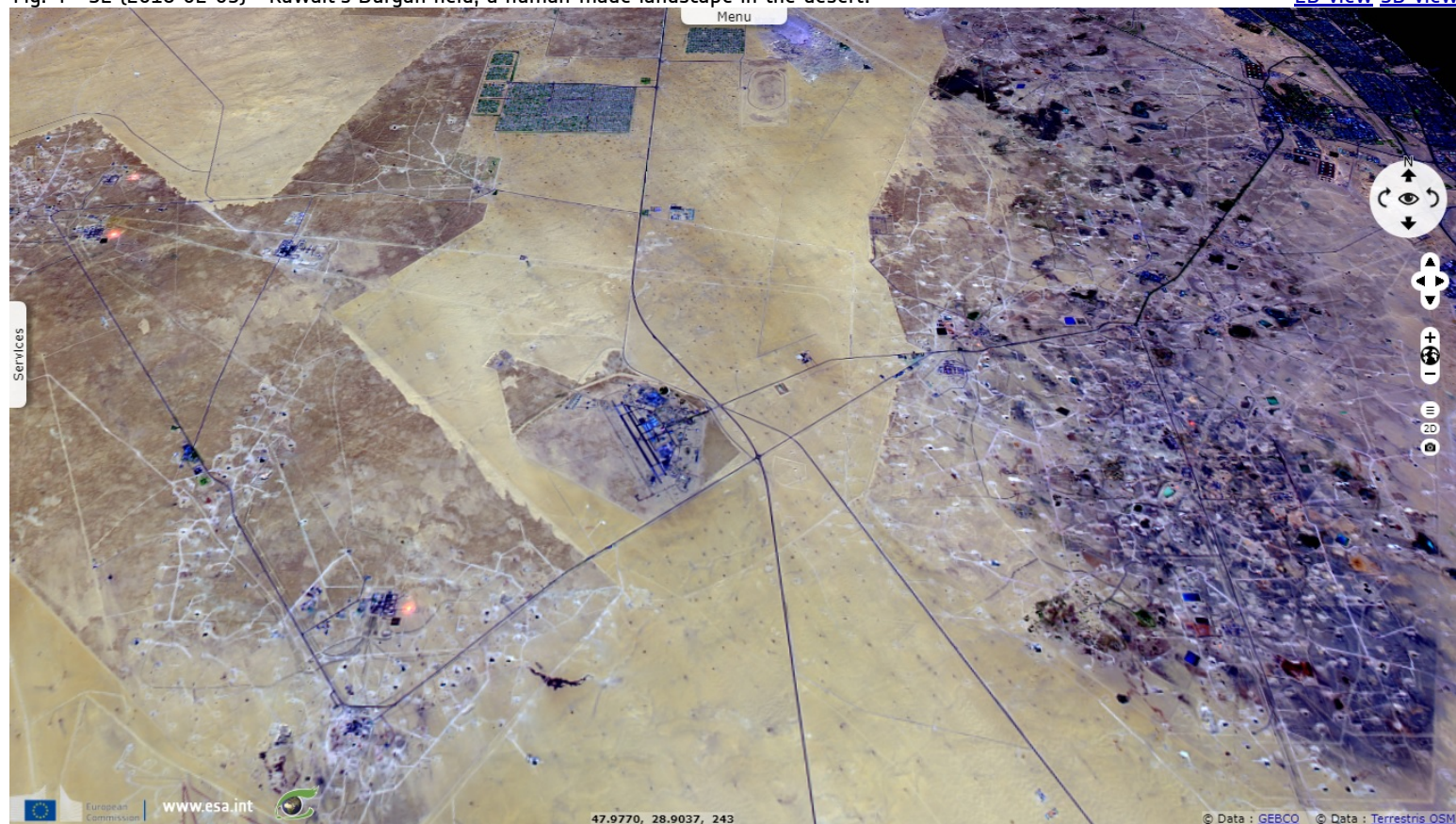
Fig. 3 - S2 (2018-01-31) - 11,8,2 colour composite - Abdali city and Raudhathan oil field in the north.
