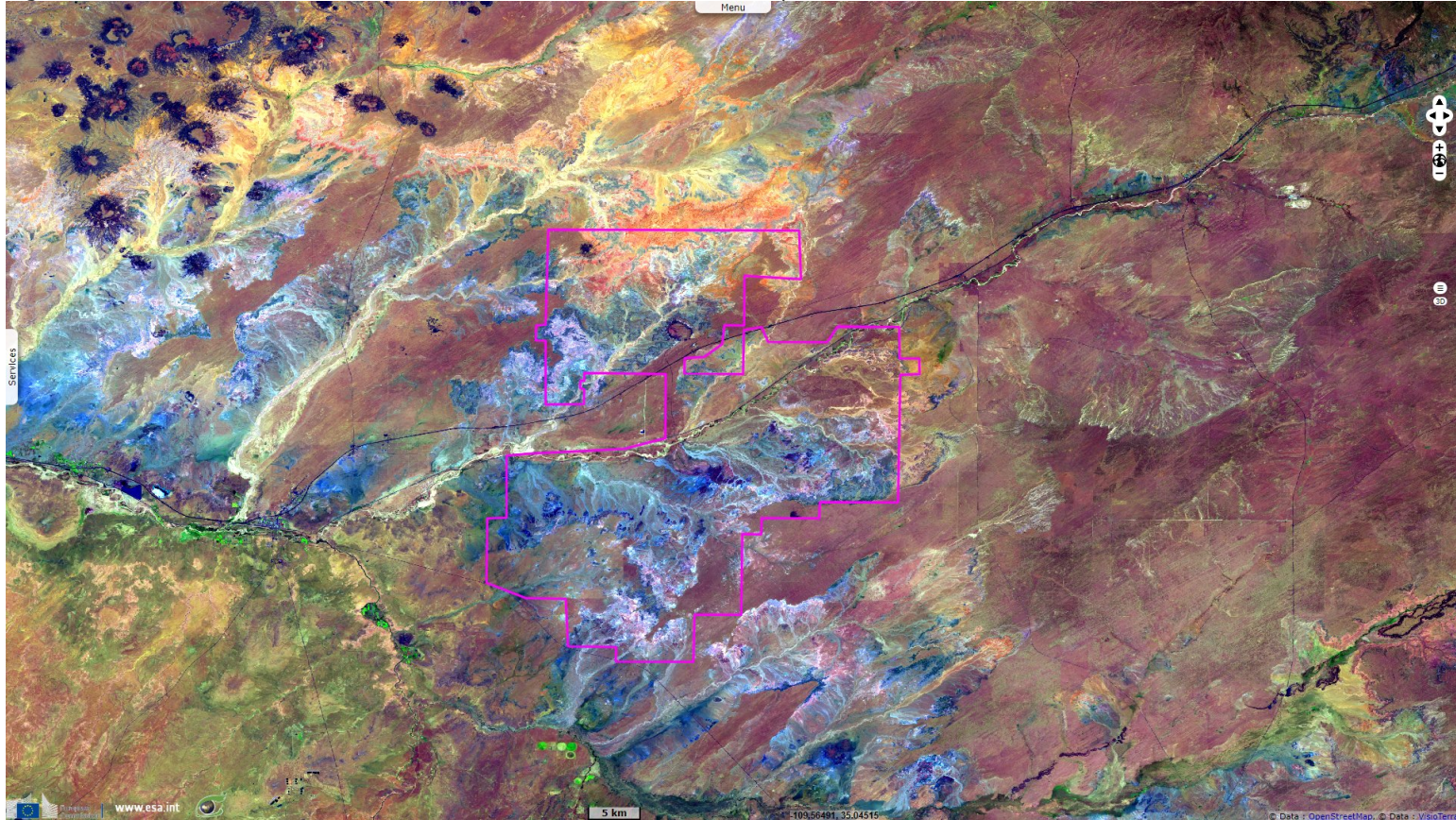


Fig. 2 - S1 (09.06.2021) - It encompasses semi-desert shrub steppe as well as highly eroded and colorful badlands.

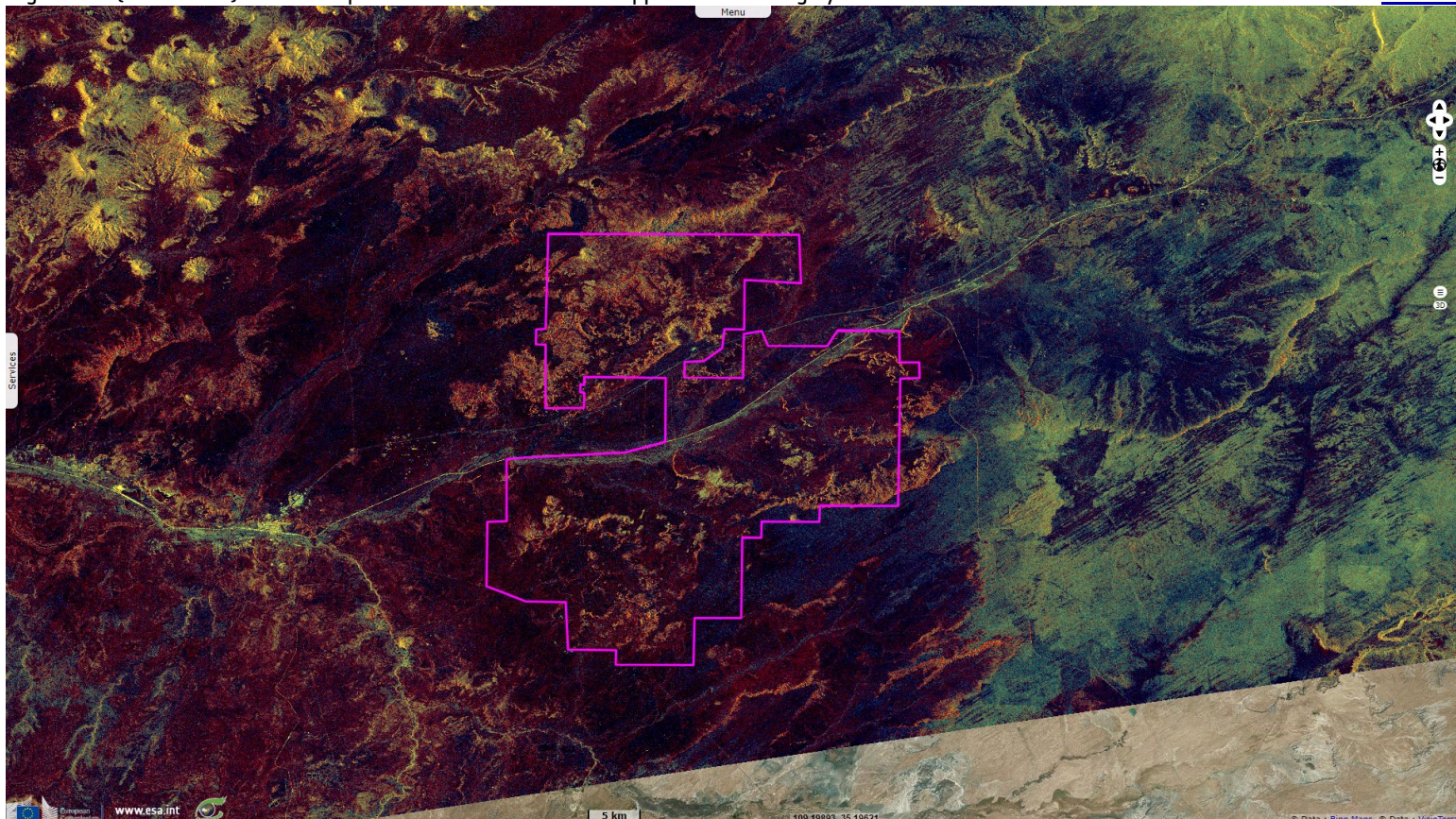


Fig. 3 - COP-DEM - Averaging 1600 m in elevation, the park covers about 900 km², [2D view](#)

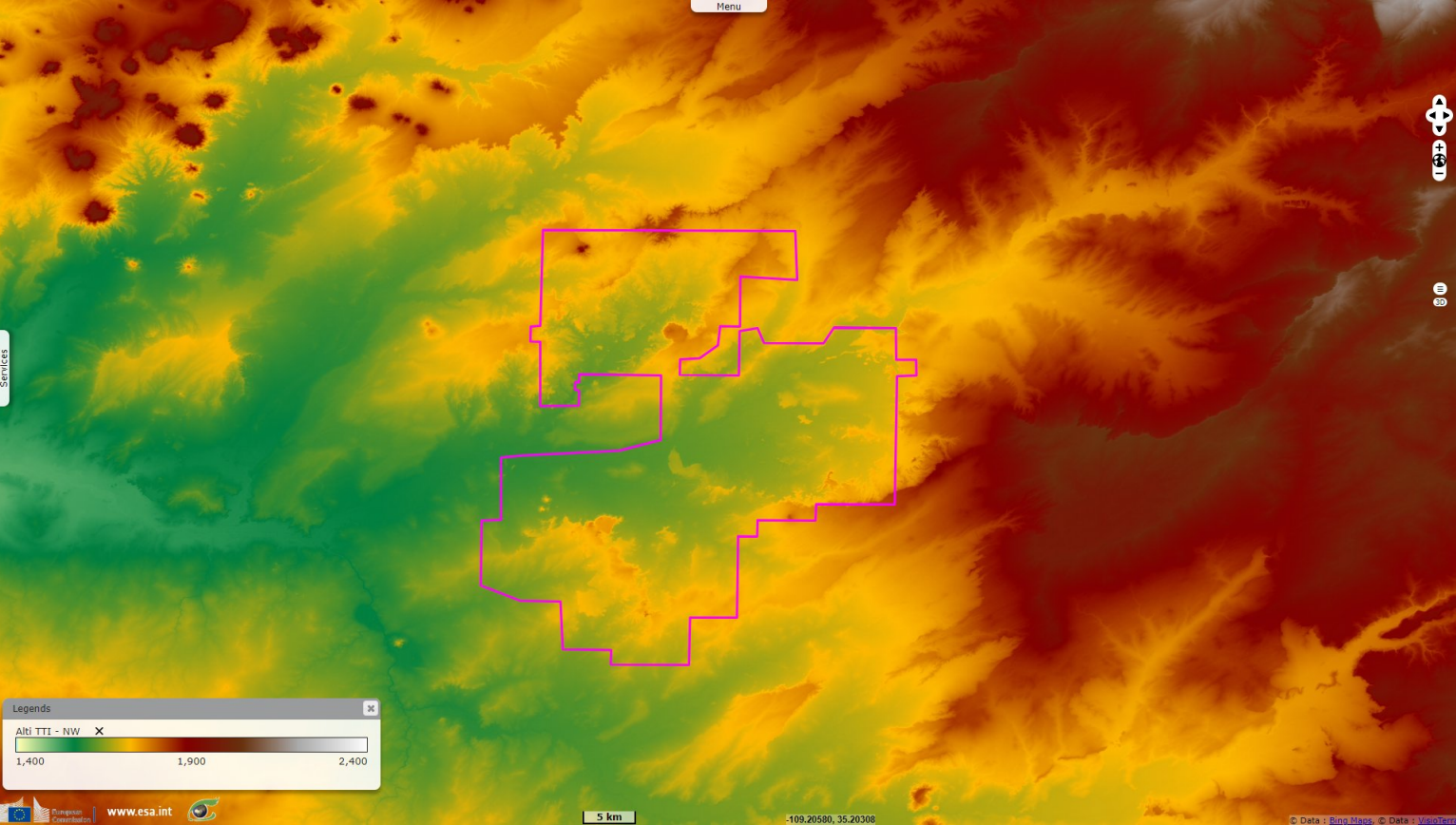
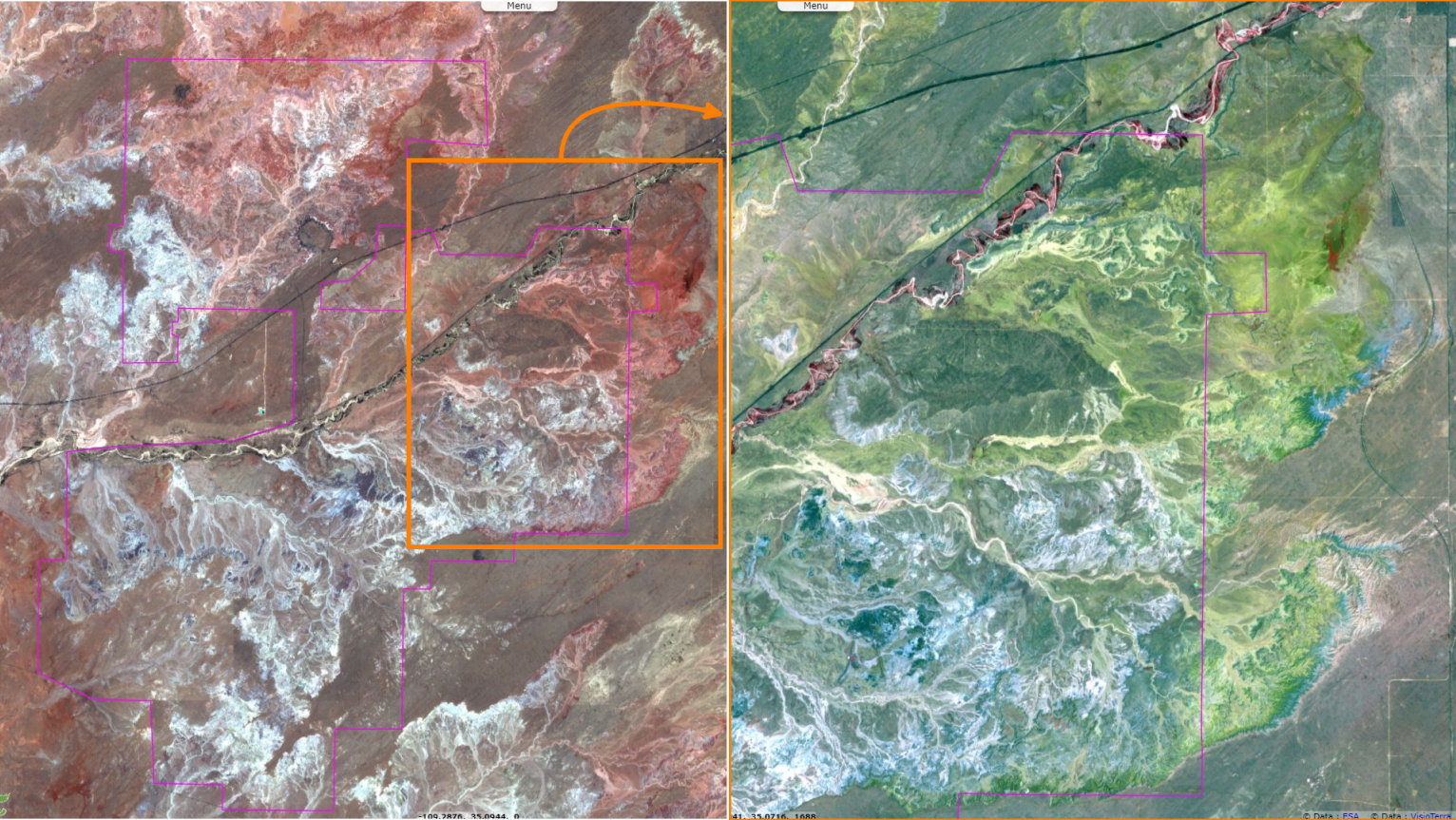


Fig. 4 - S2 (23.06.2023) - The Petrified Forest is named after its fossils, especially fallen trees that lived about 225 million years ago. [3D view](#) [3D view](#)



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
