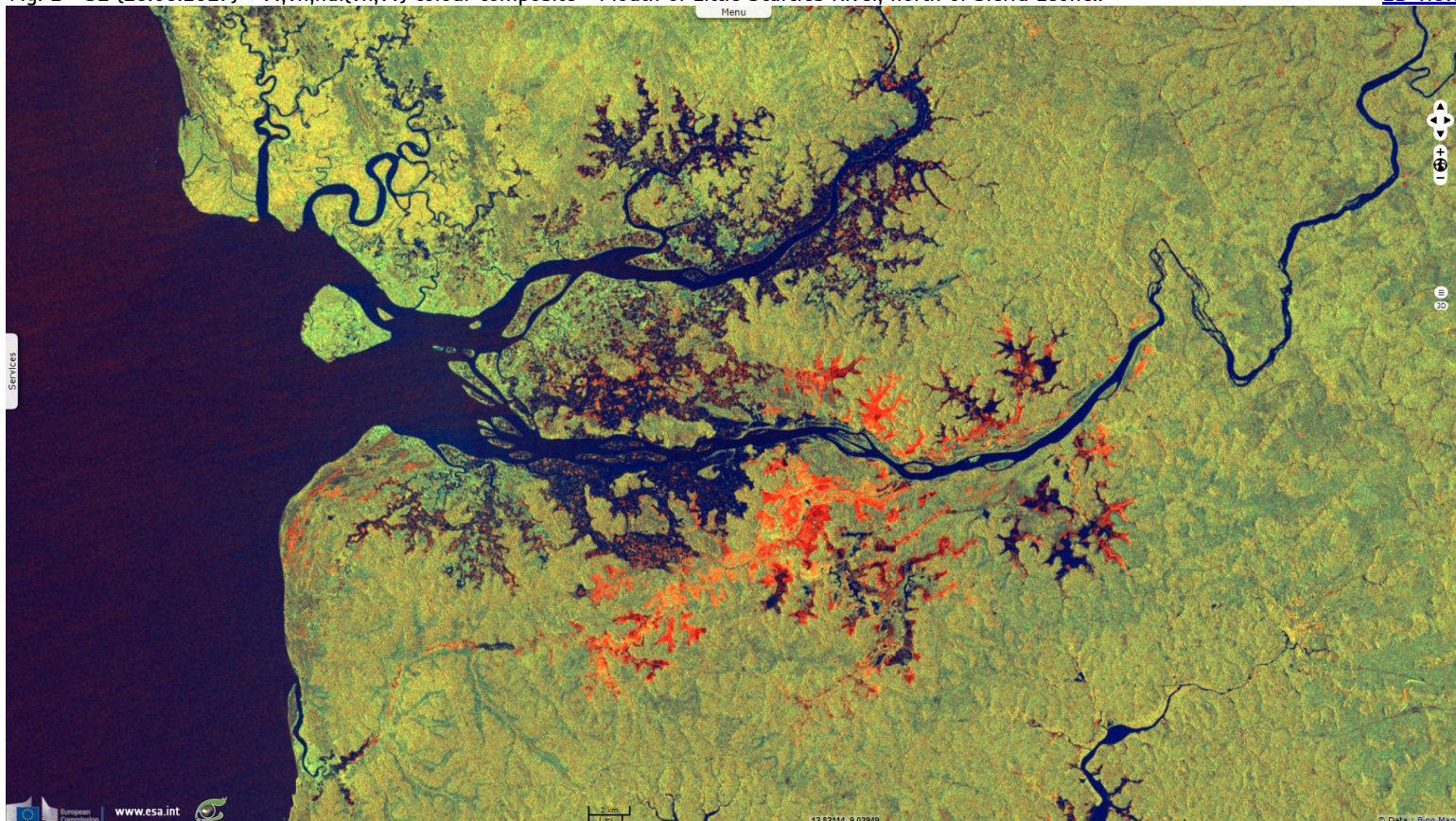


Fig. 3 - S2 - 12,11,2 colour composite - Mangrove forest and marshes make up most of this estuary.
