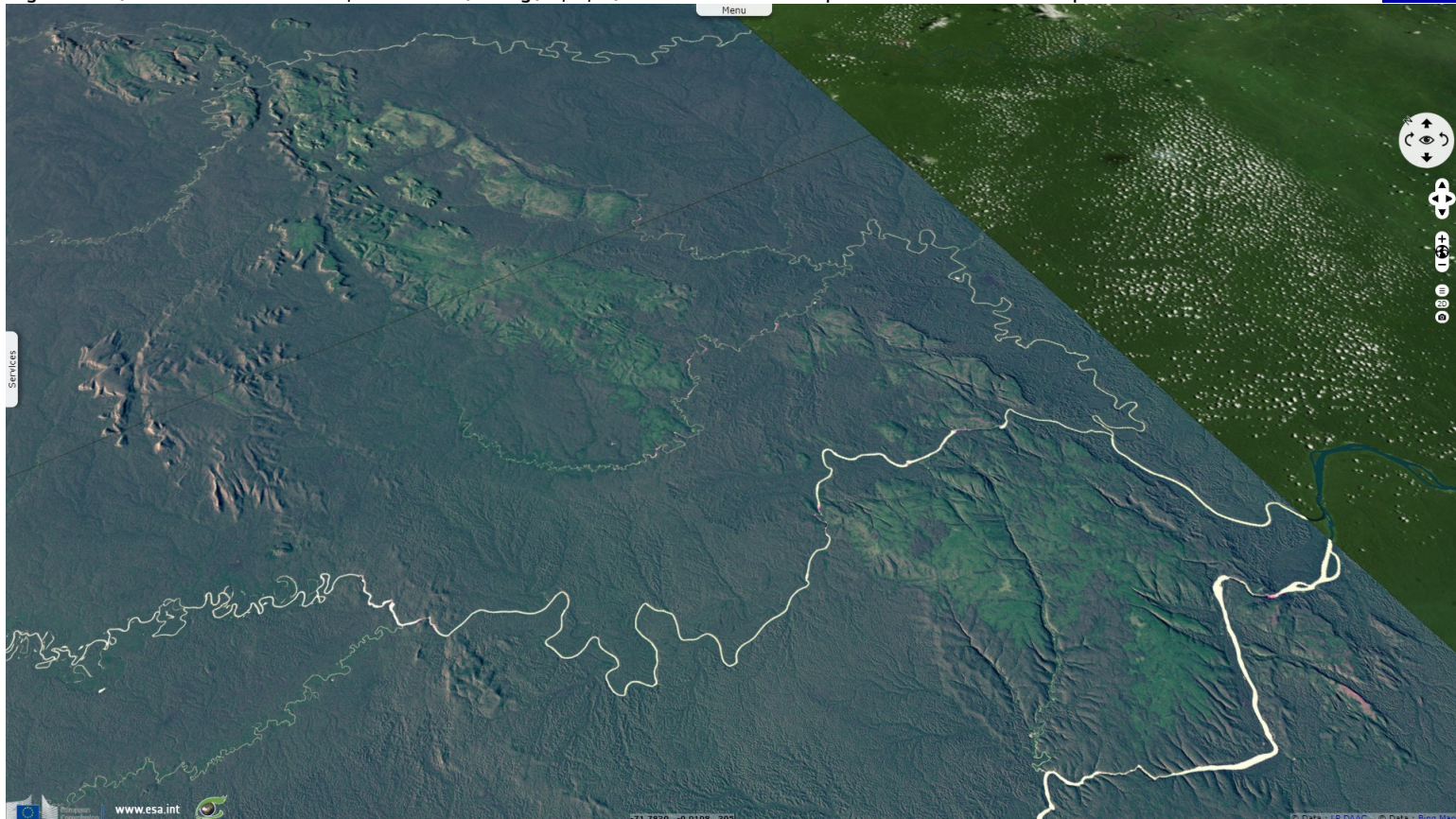


Fig. 2 - S2 (17.01.2016) - 4,3,2 natural colour - This 1.7 billion-year-old craton hosts table-like mountains called tepuis.

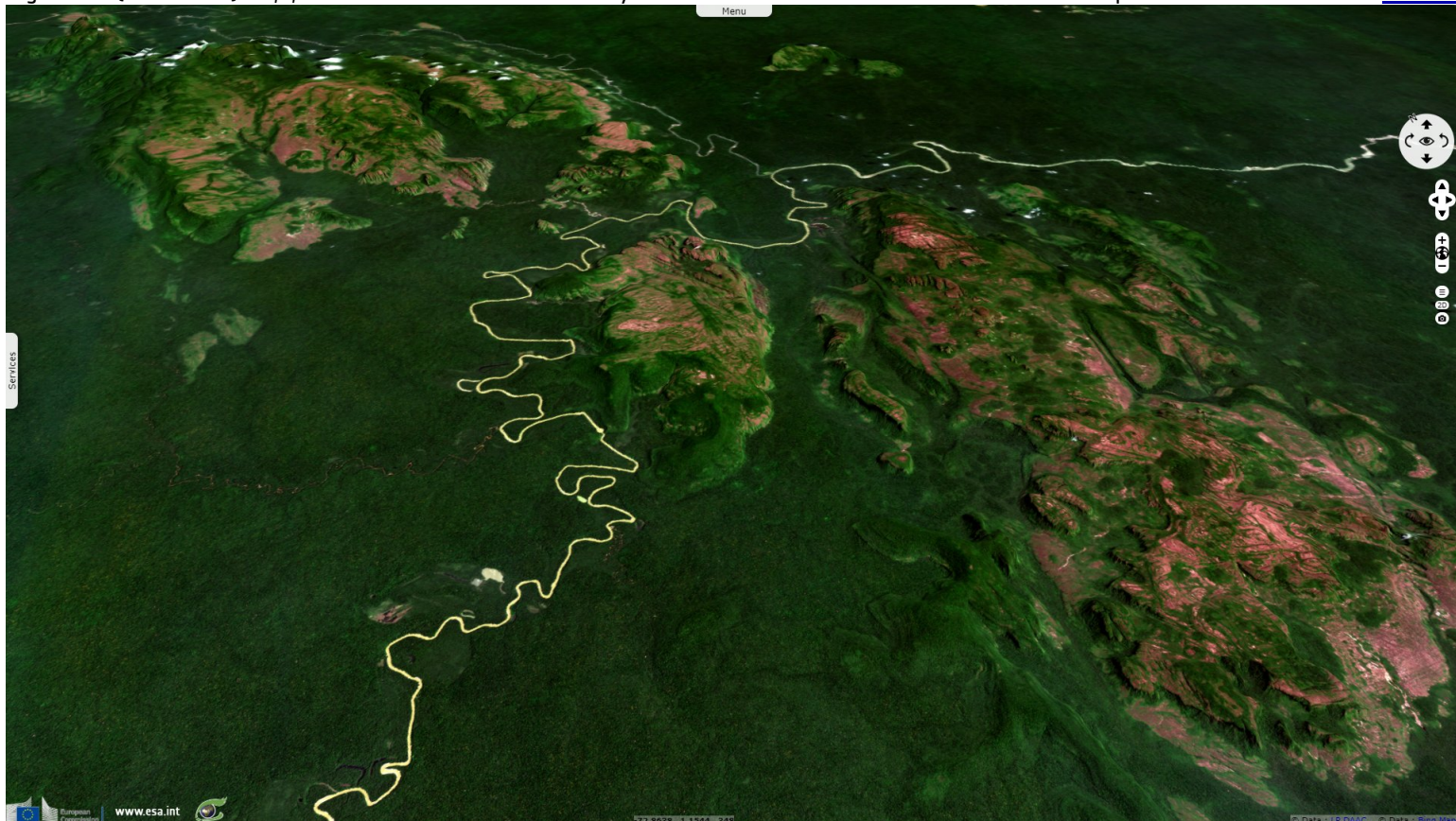


Fig. 3 - neg(vh,vv,vh) colour composite - Tepuis of the Guiana Highlands remind of the Monument Valley mesas.

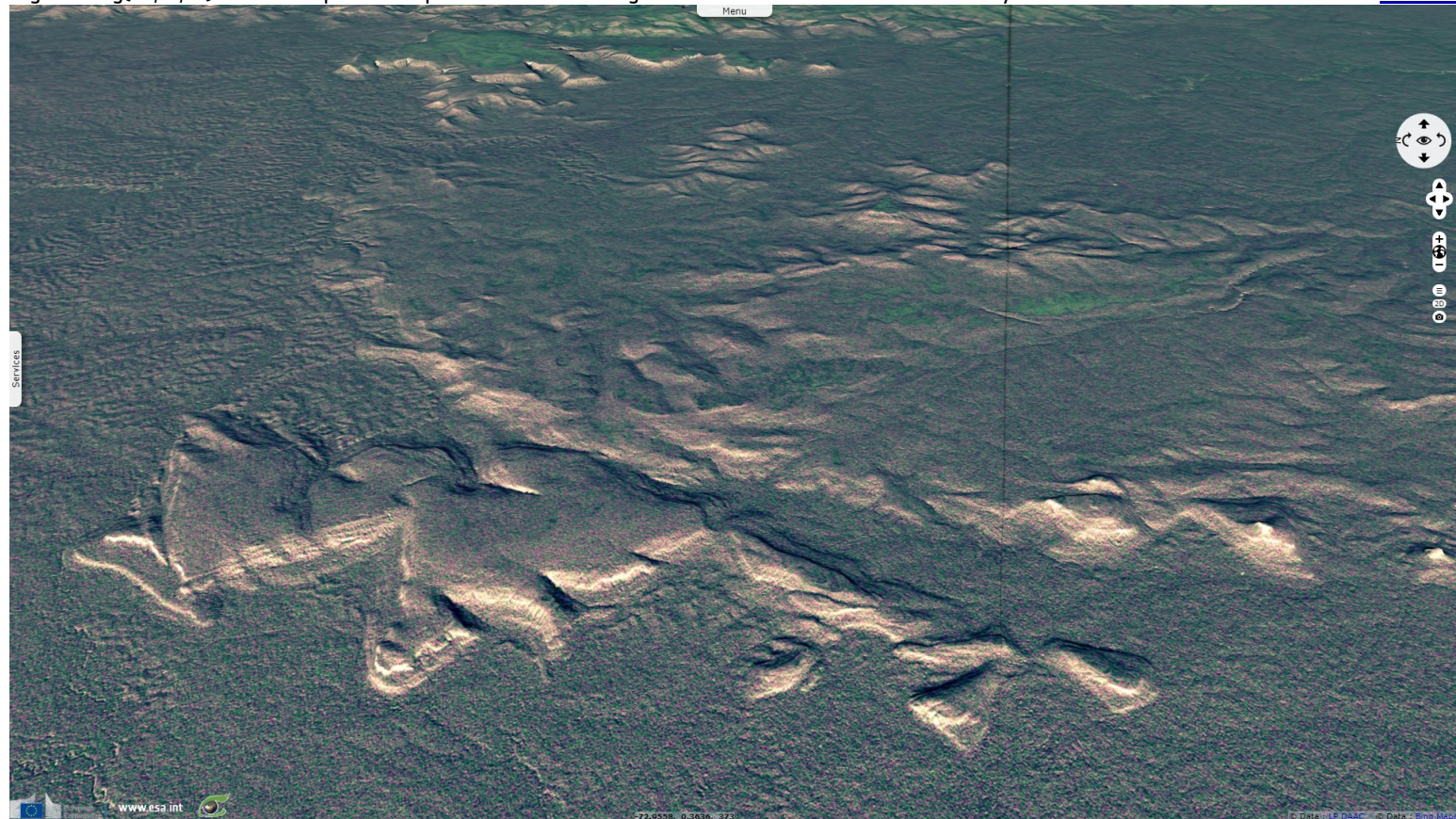
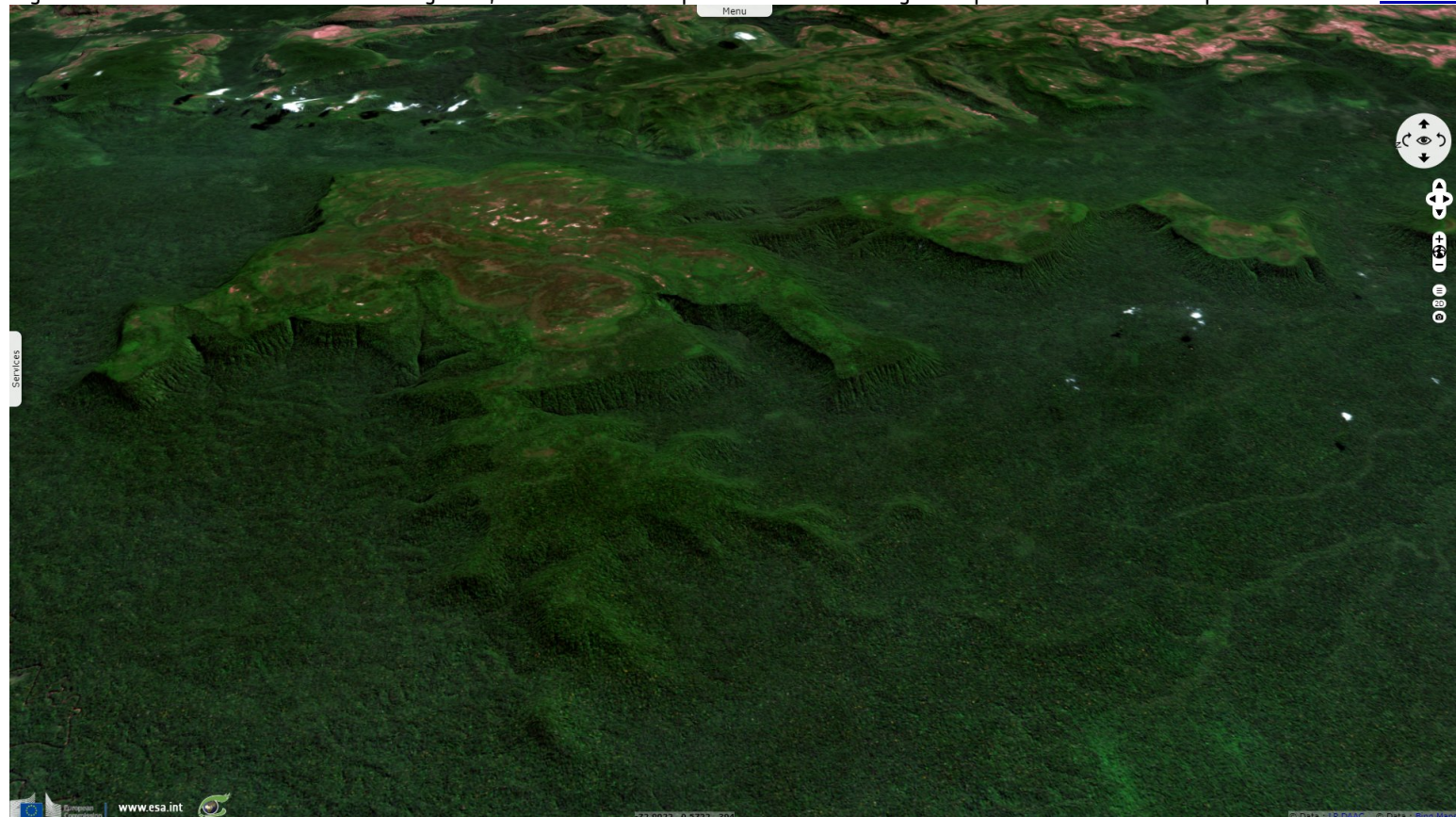


Fig. 4 - A 43000 km² UNESCO World Heritage site, Serrania de Chiriquete is the world's largest tropical rainforest national park.
