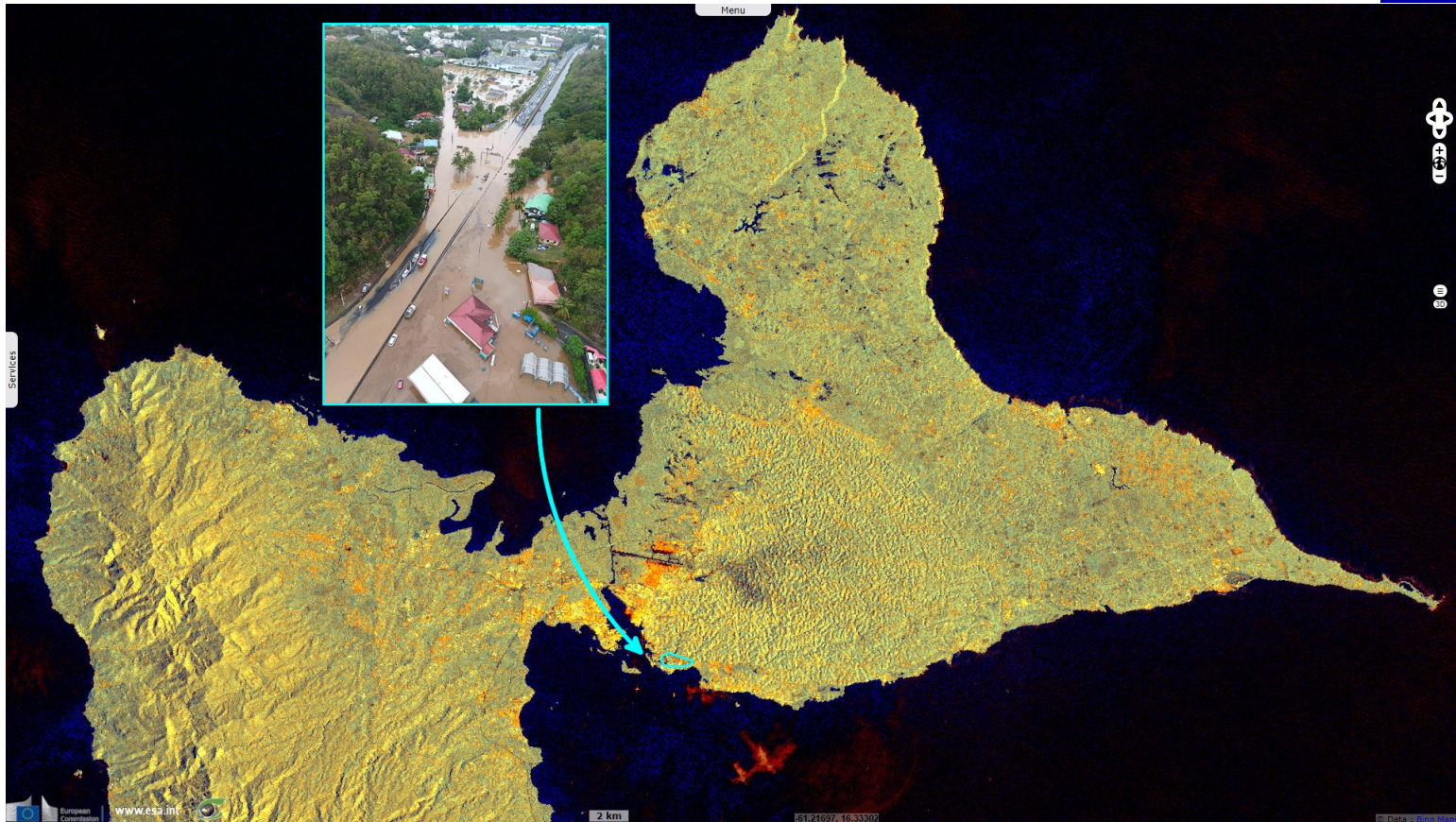
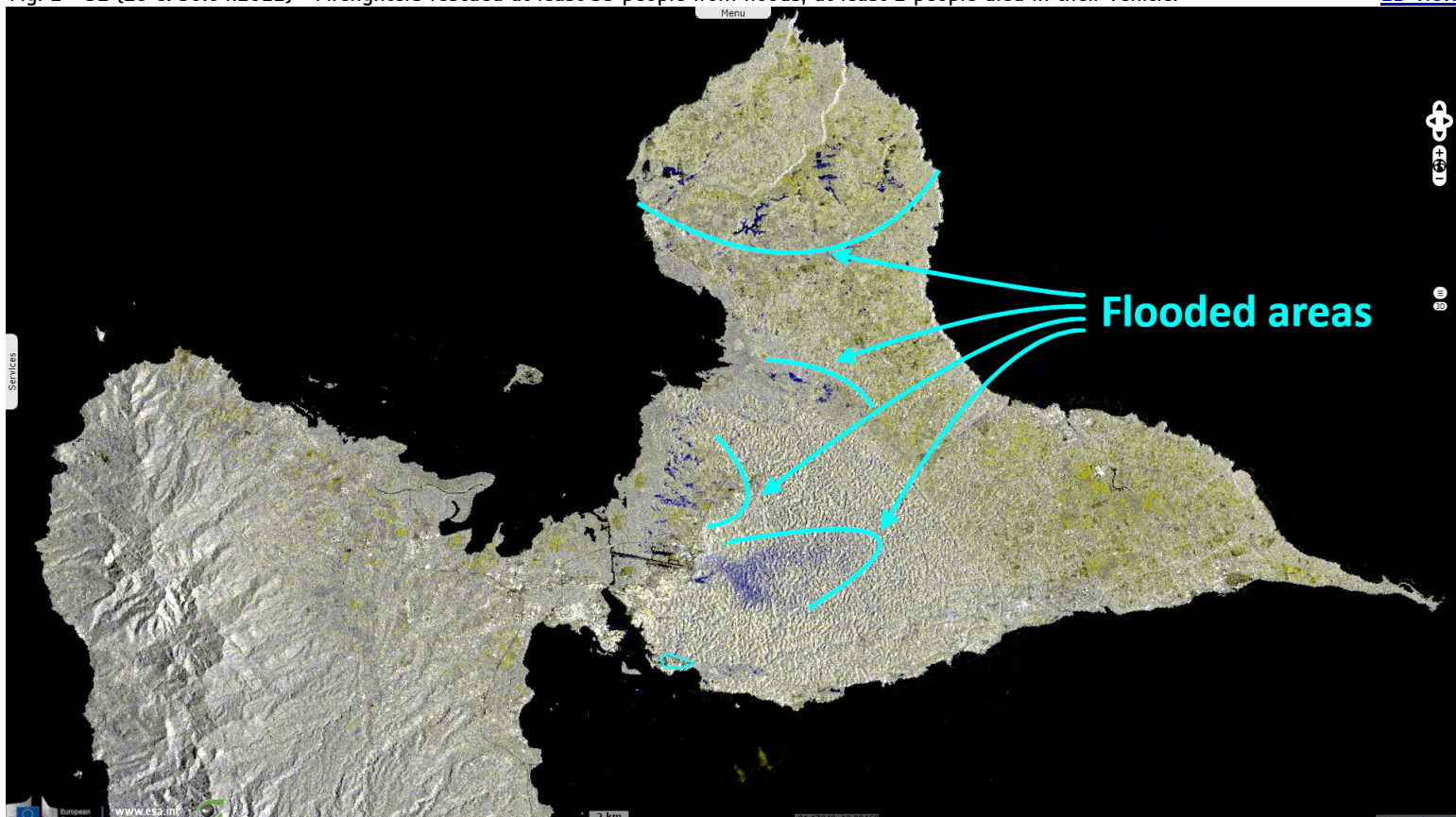


Fig. 2 - S1 (18 & 30.04.2022) - Firefighters rescued at least 35 people from floods, at least 2 people died in their vehicle.
