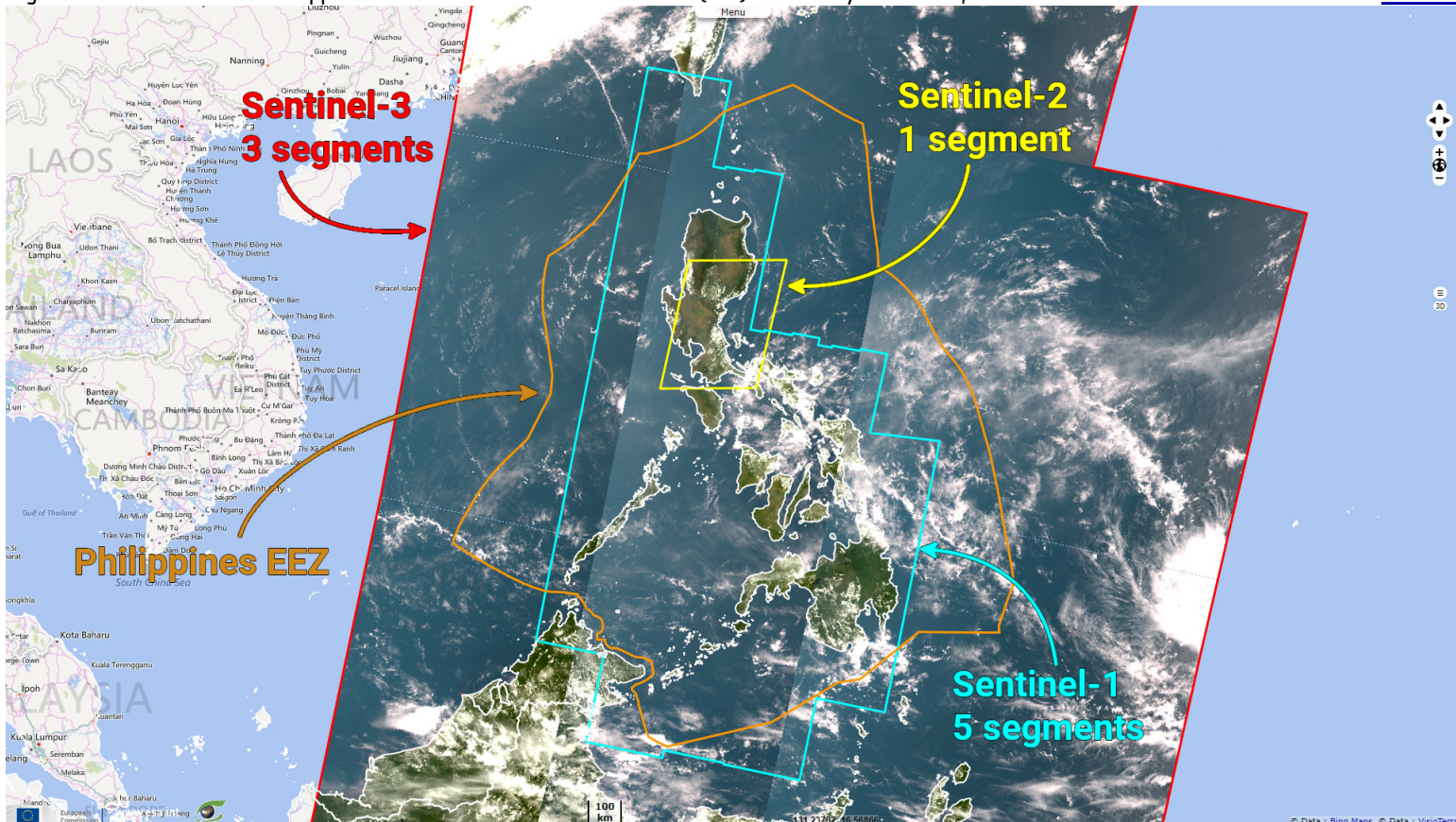


Fig. 2 - S1 (25.03.2023 to 11.04.2023) - Radar view of the Philippines composed of 5 segments with RCSE equalisation over the sea.

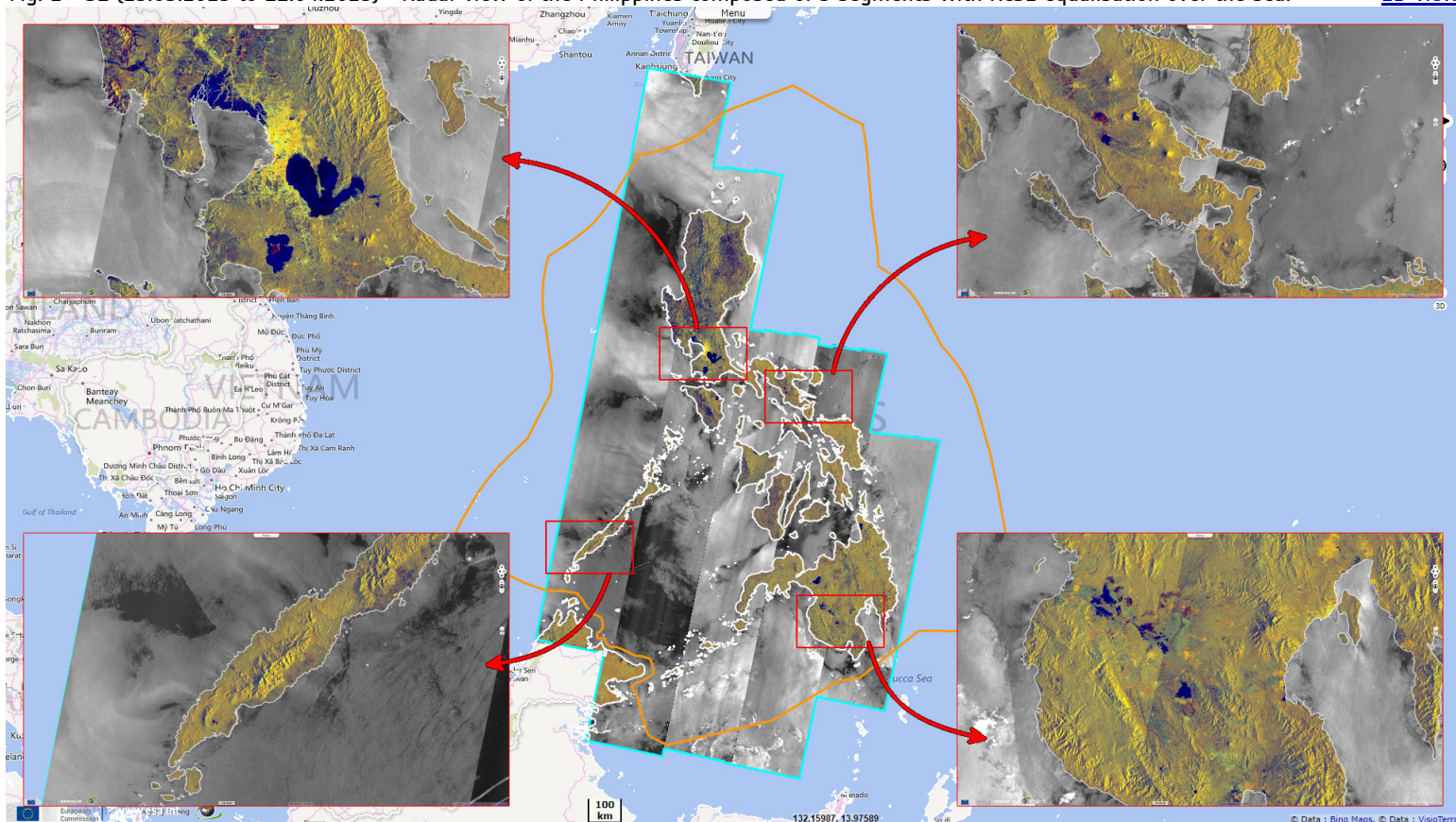


Fig. 3 - S2 (02.04.2021) - Optical view of the northern island. Philippines are often hidden by clouds, fortunately this view is almost cloudless. [2D view](#)

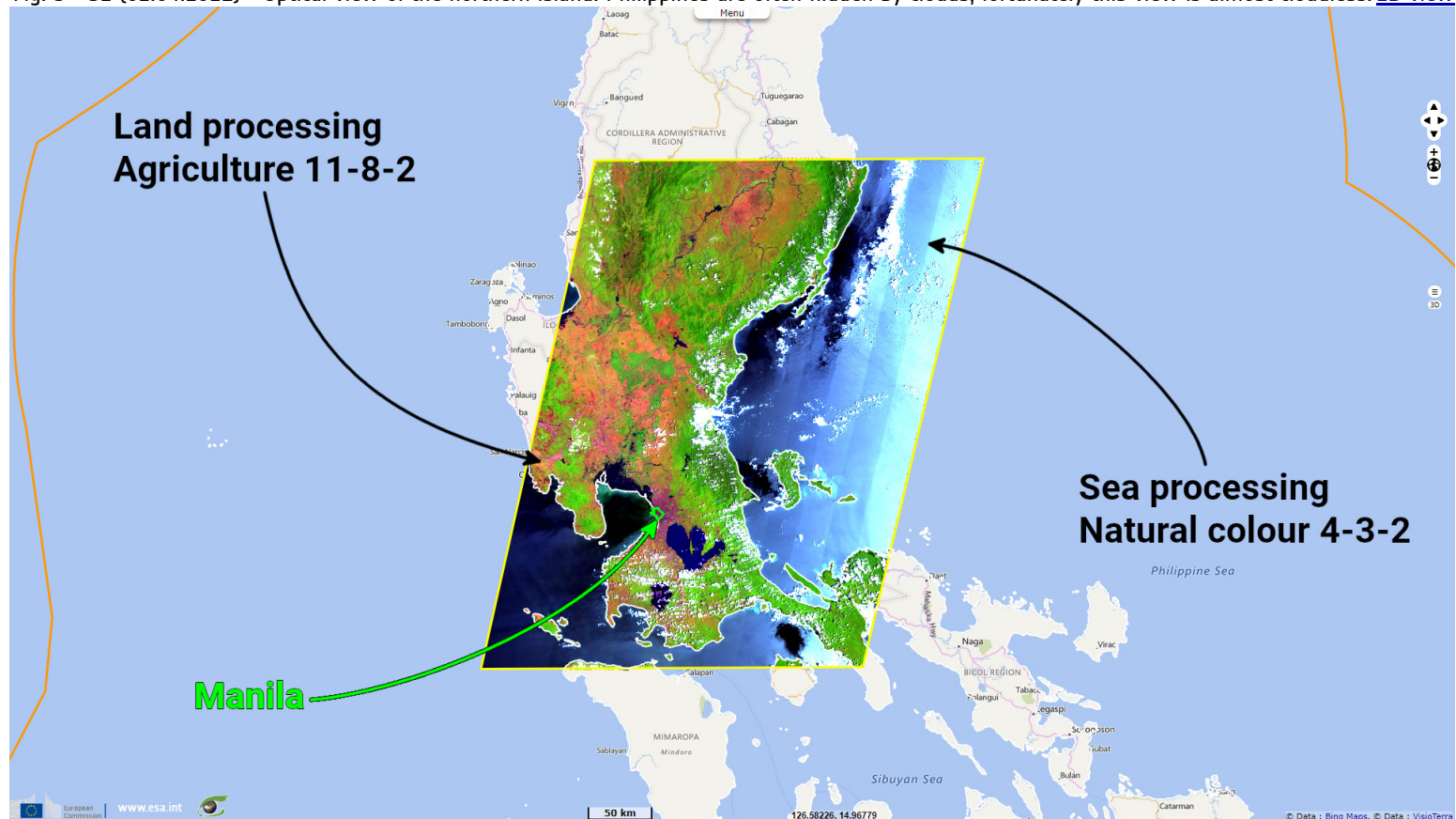
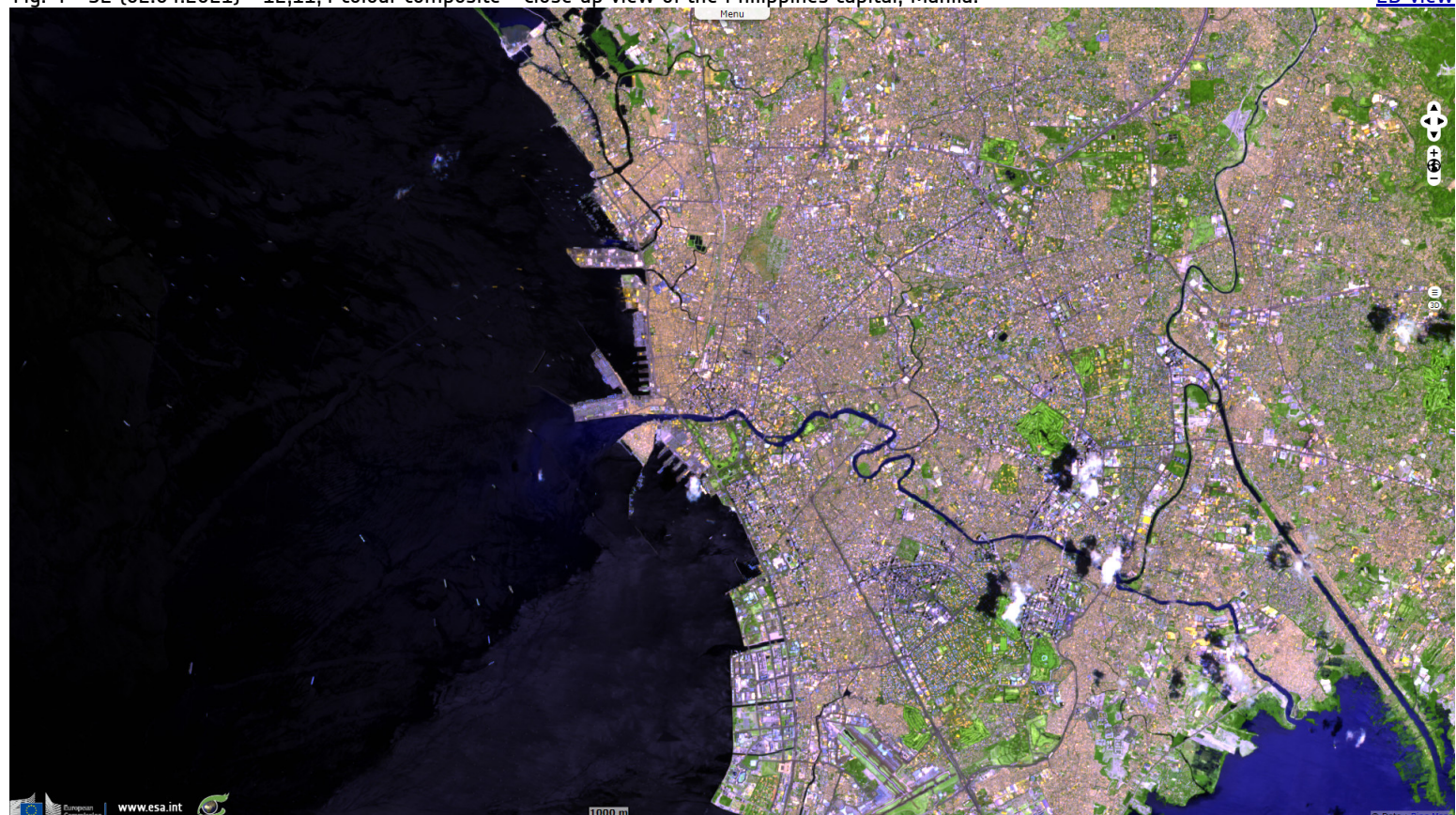


Fig. 4 - S2 (02.04.2021) - 12,11,4 colour composite - Close up view of the Philippines capital, Manila. [2D view](#)



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
