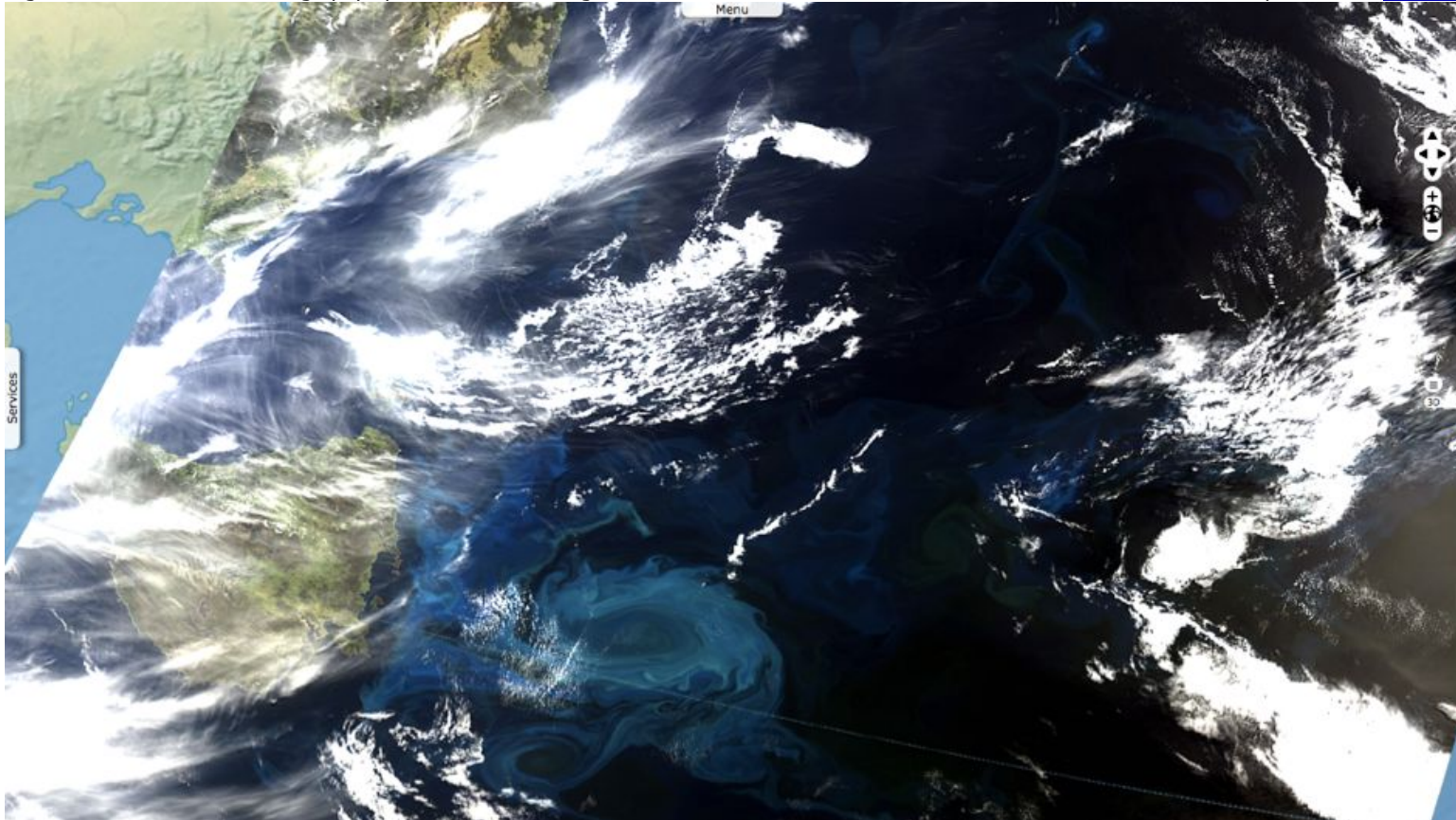


Fig. 2 - Surface ocean circulation highlighted by algal bloom.

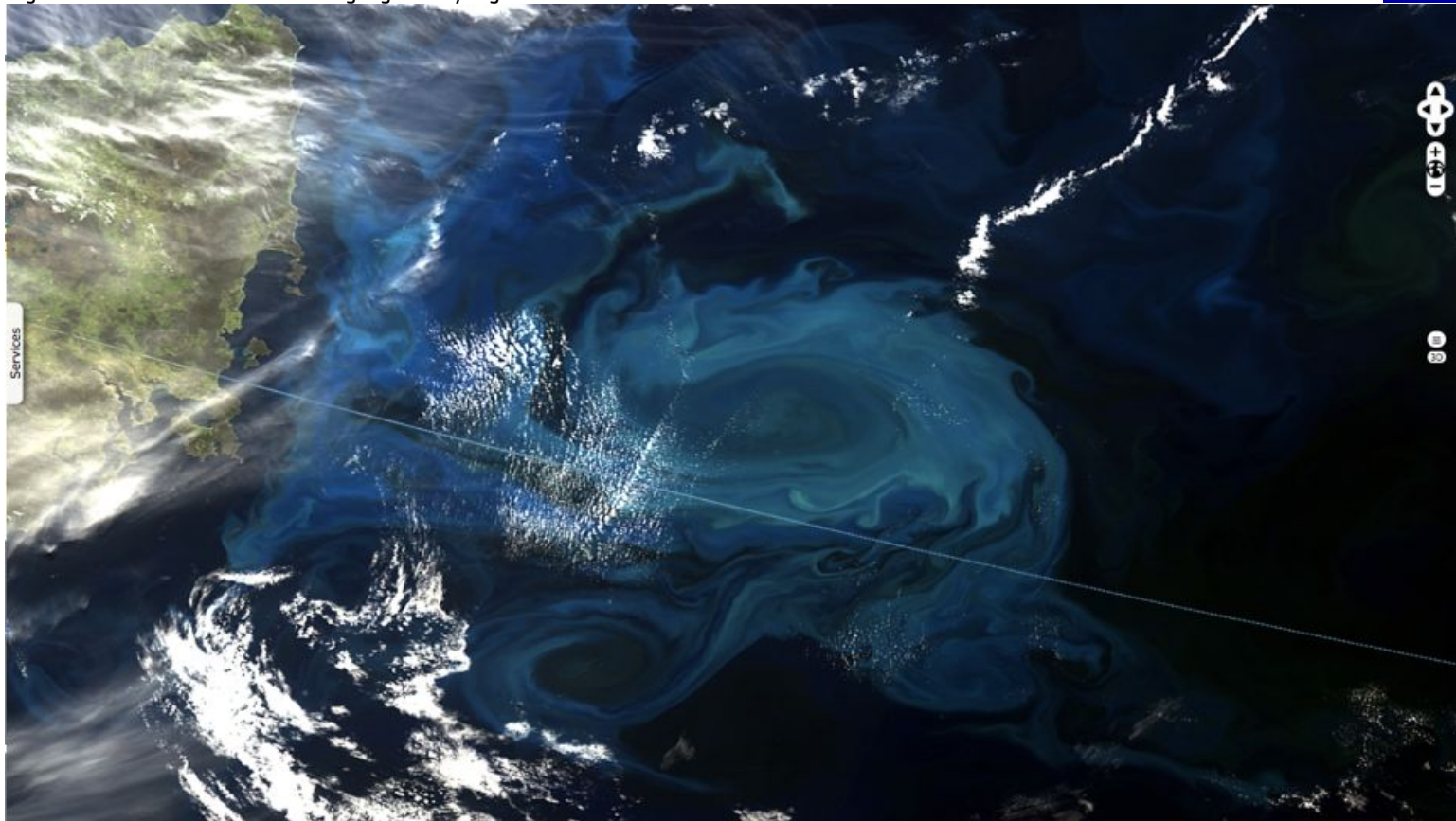


Fig. 3 - Sentinel 3 OLCI - NDVI composition with rainbow LUT, 0a20-0a07 bands.

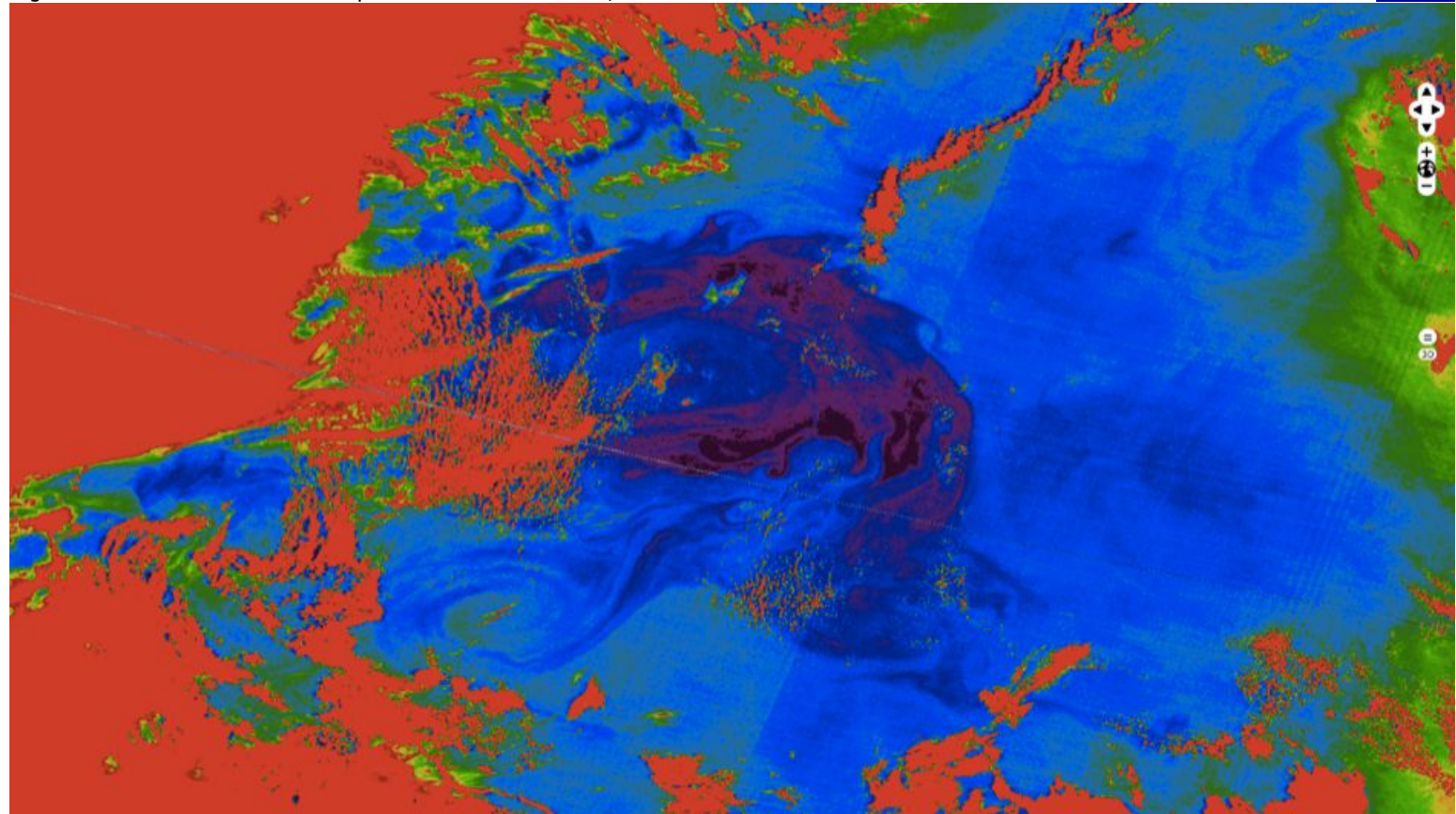
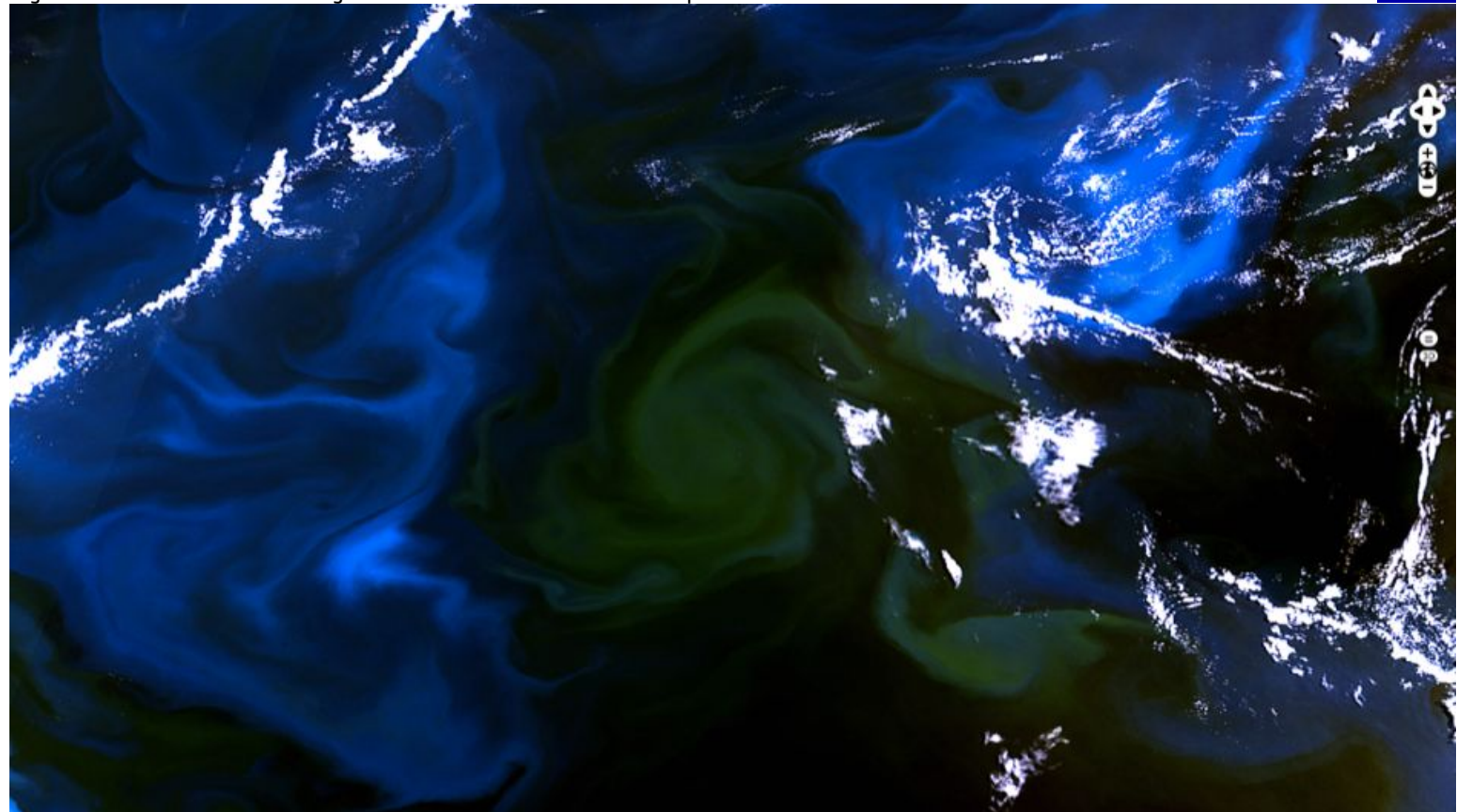


Fig. 4 - Different colours in the algal bloom - 8-6-4 Natural colour composition.
