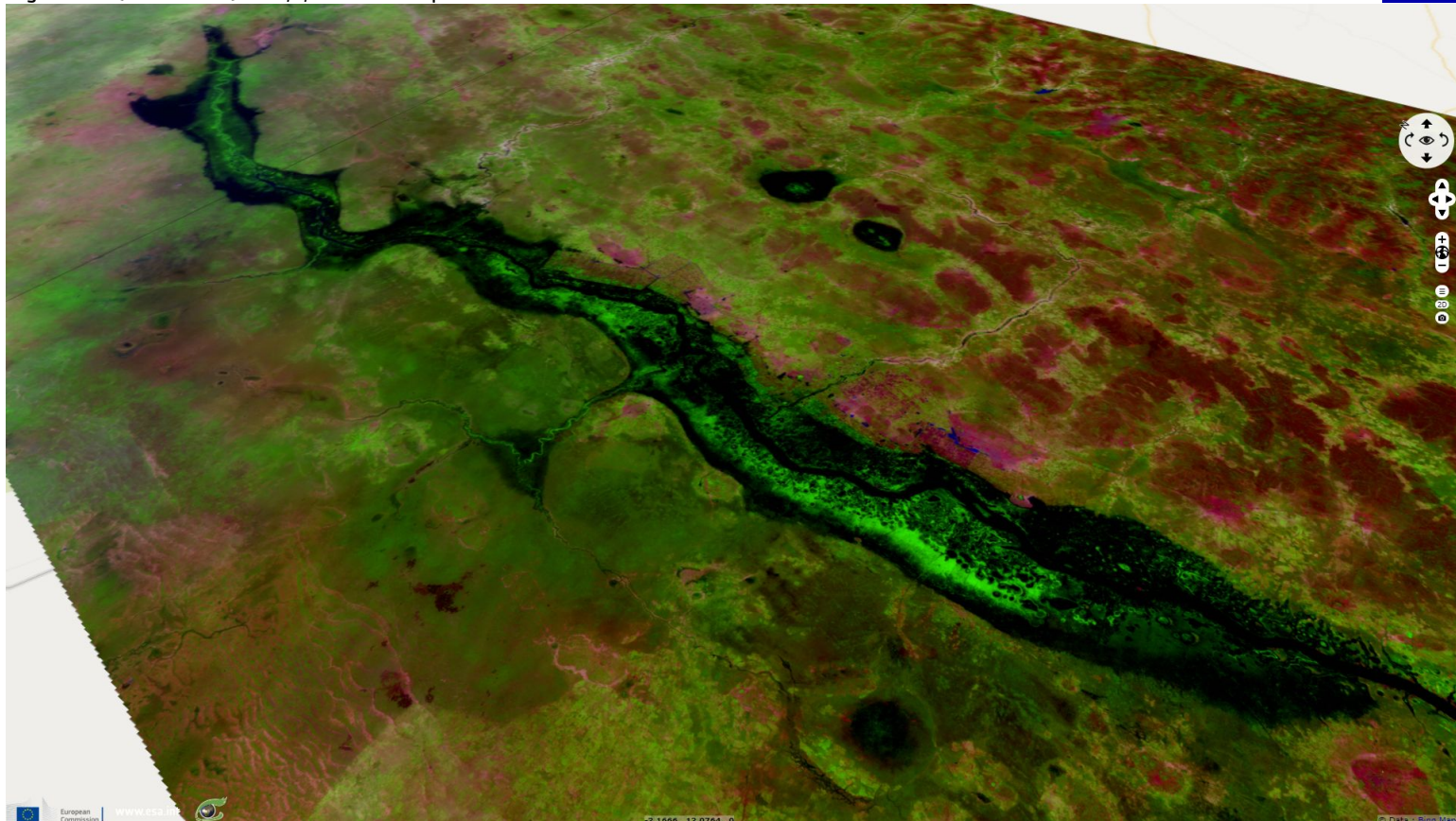


Fig. 2 - S1 (11.10.2018) - vv,vh,ndi(vh,vv) colour composite - Usually a tributary of the Black Volta, it becomes a distributary at this period.

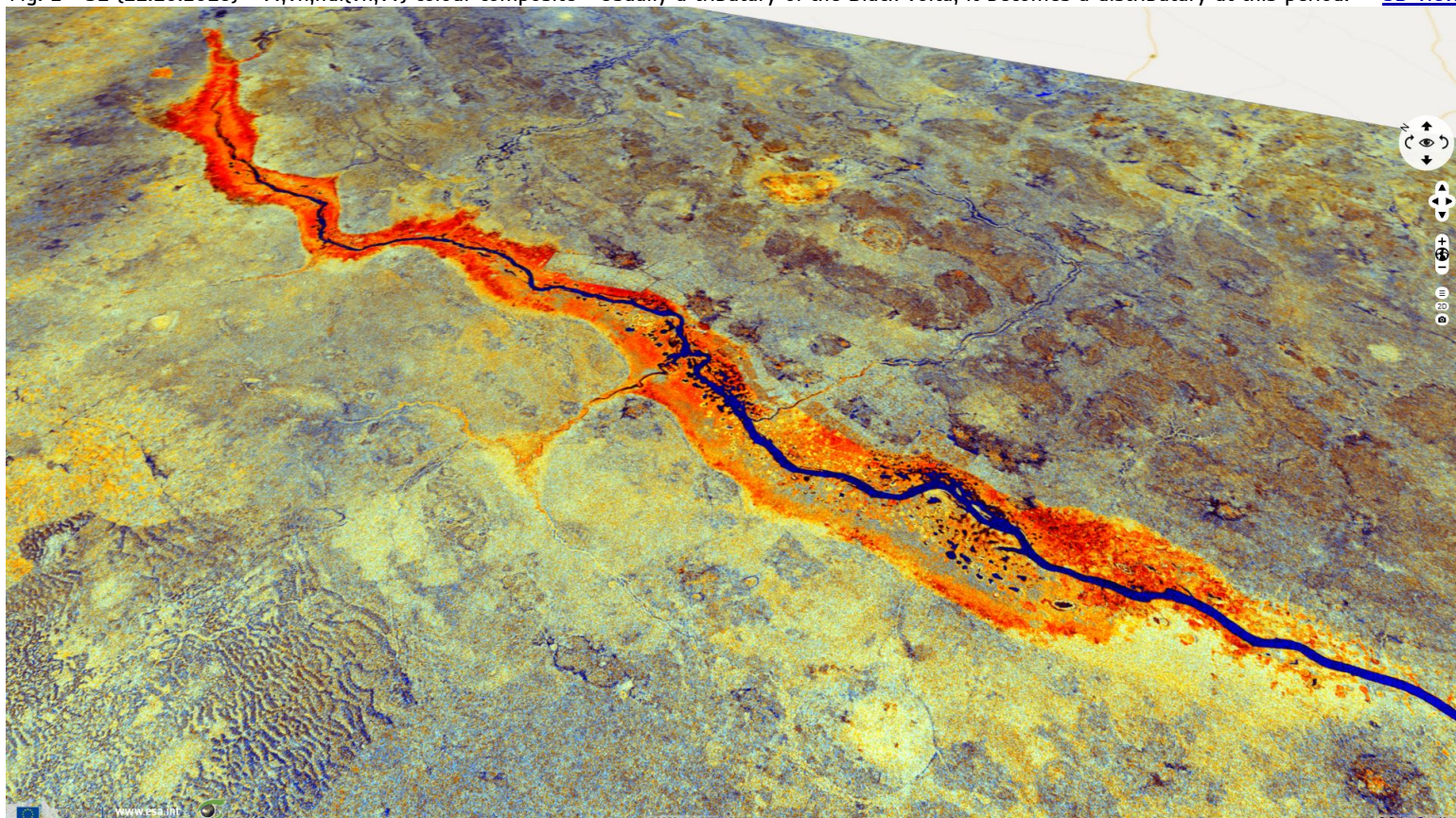


Fig. 3 - S2 (15.01.2019) - 11,8,2 colour composite - The landscape of this tropical land changes dramatically during the dry season.

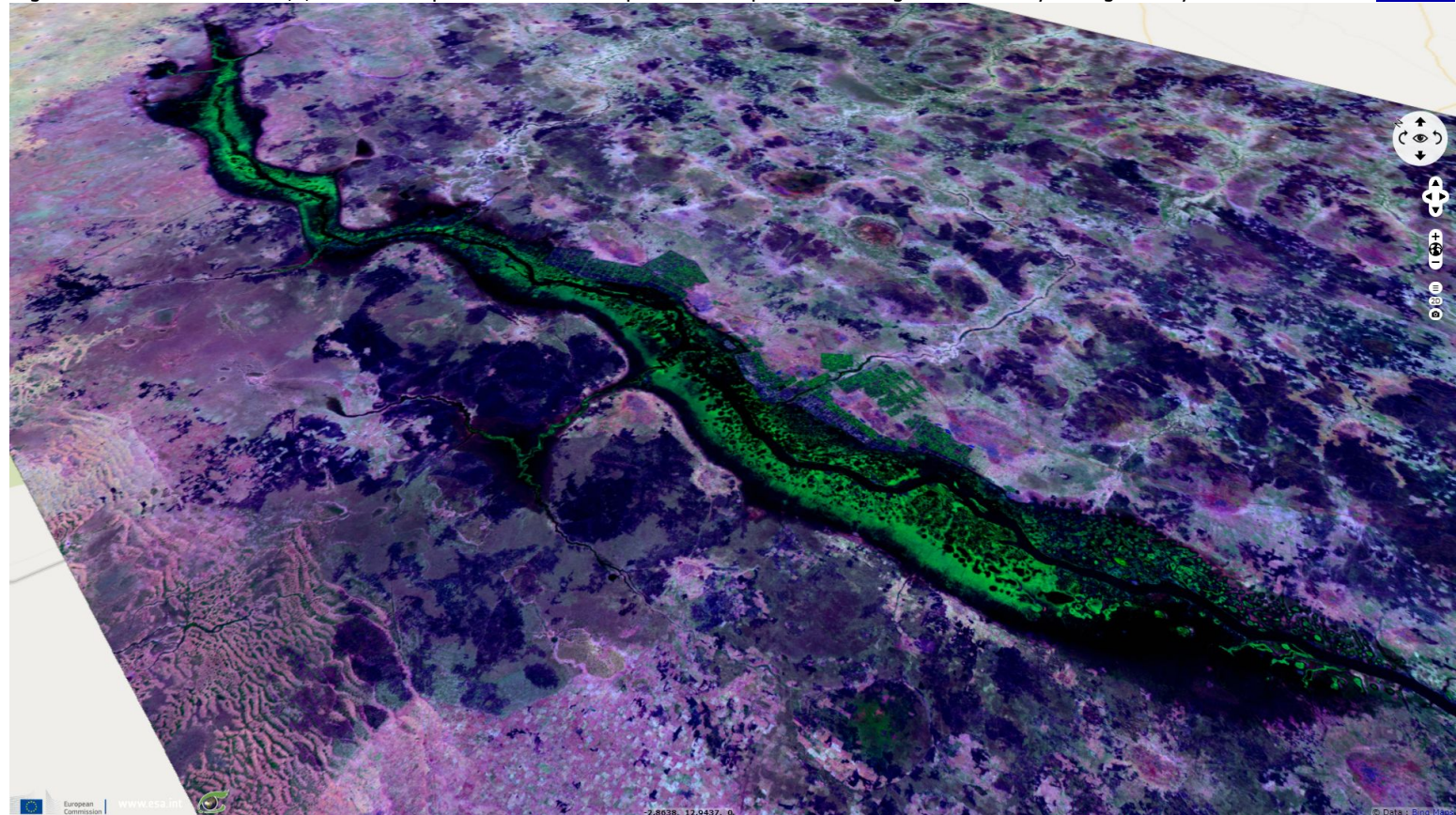
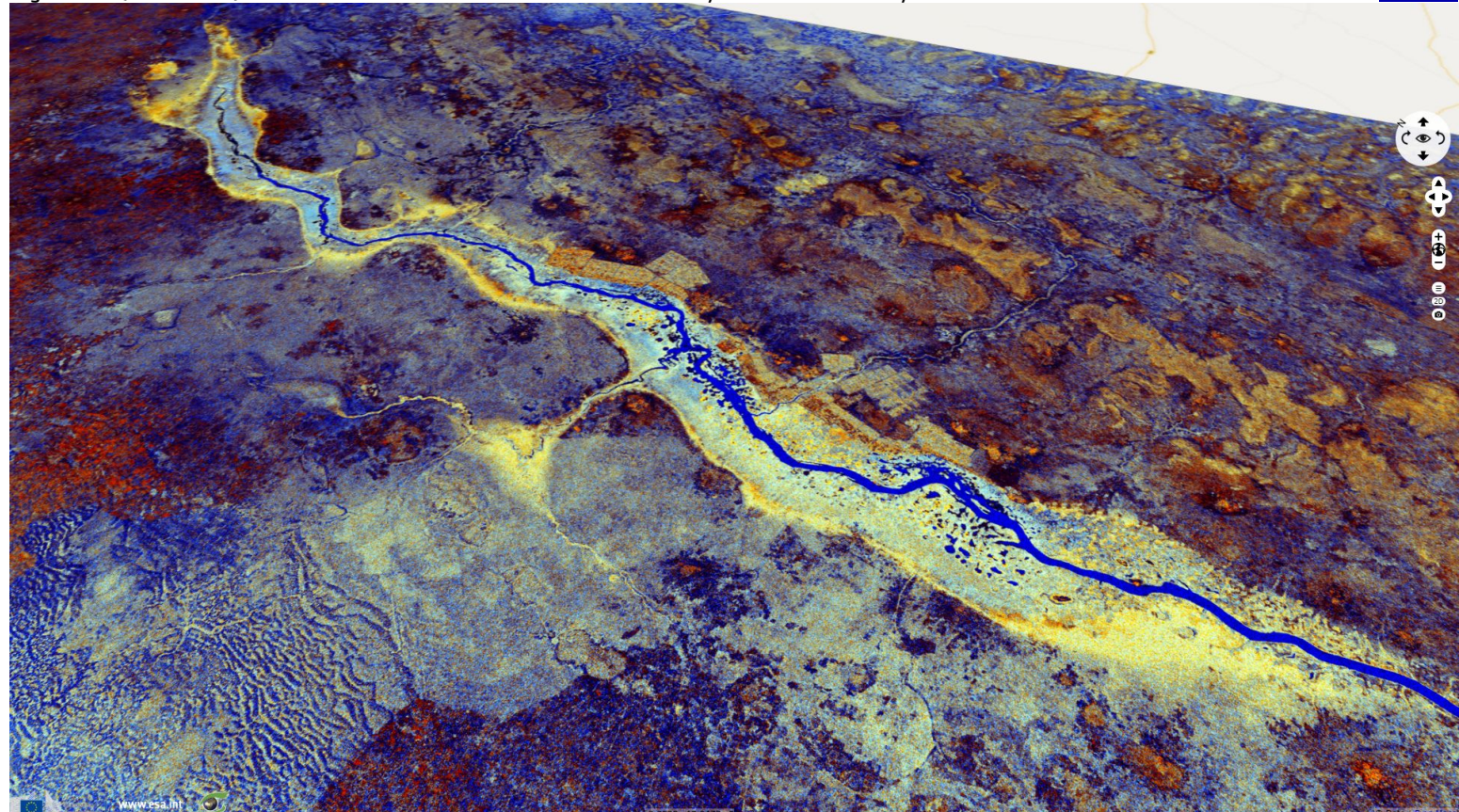


Fig. 4 - S1 (15.01.2019) - Burkina Faso & Mali declared the Sourou Valley as a Transboundary Ramsar Site the 22.01.2019.
