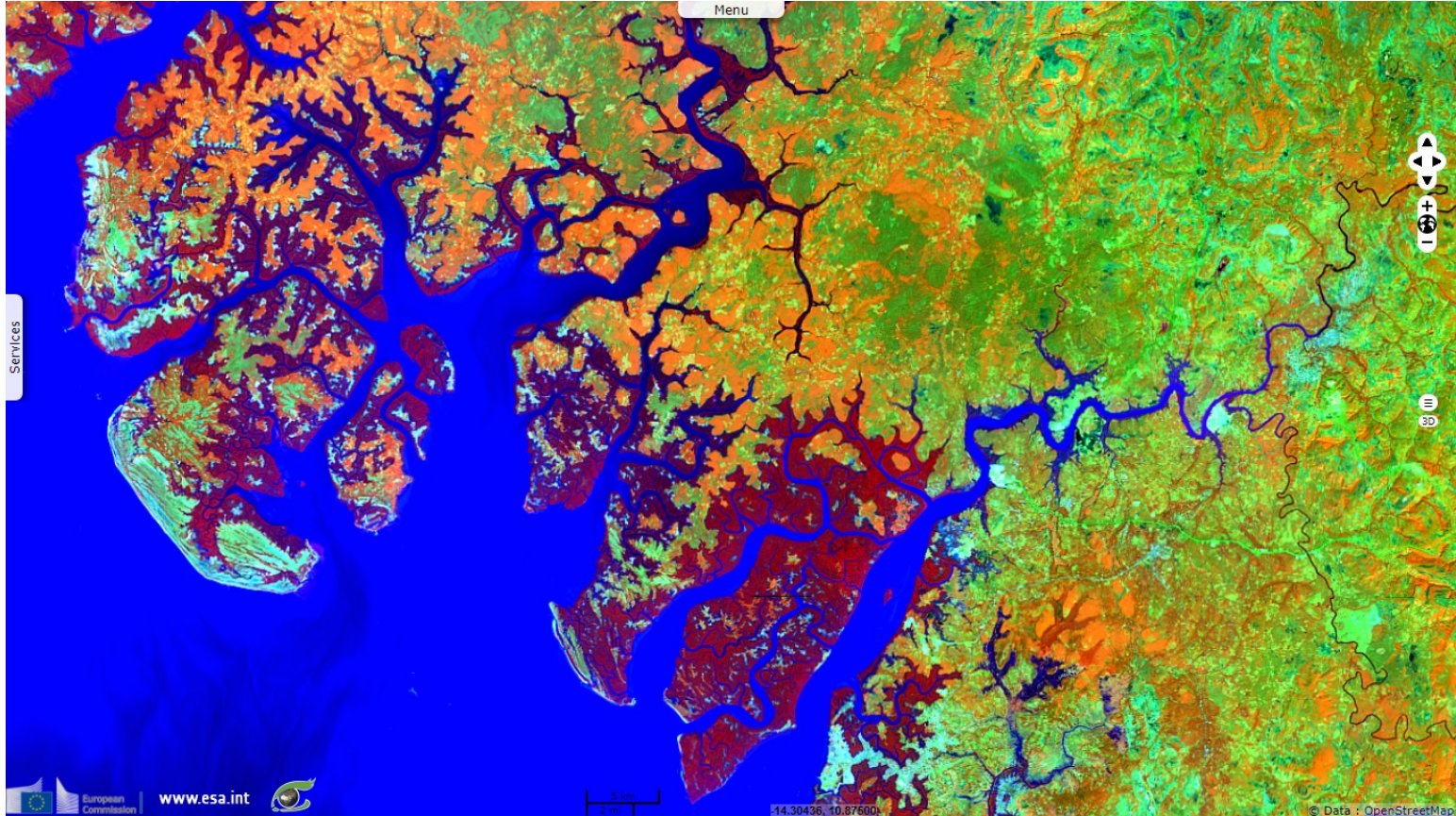


Fig. 2 - Satellite imagery could serve for land cover mapping in Boké's mangroves.

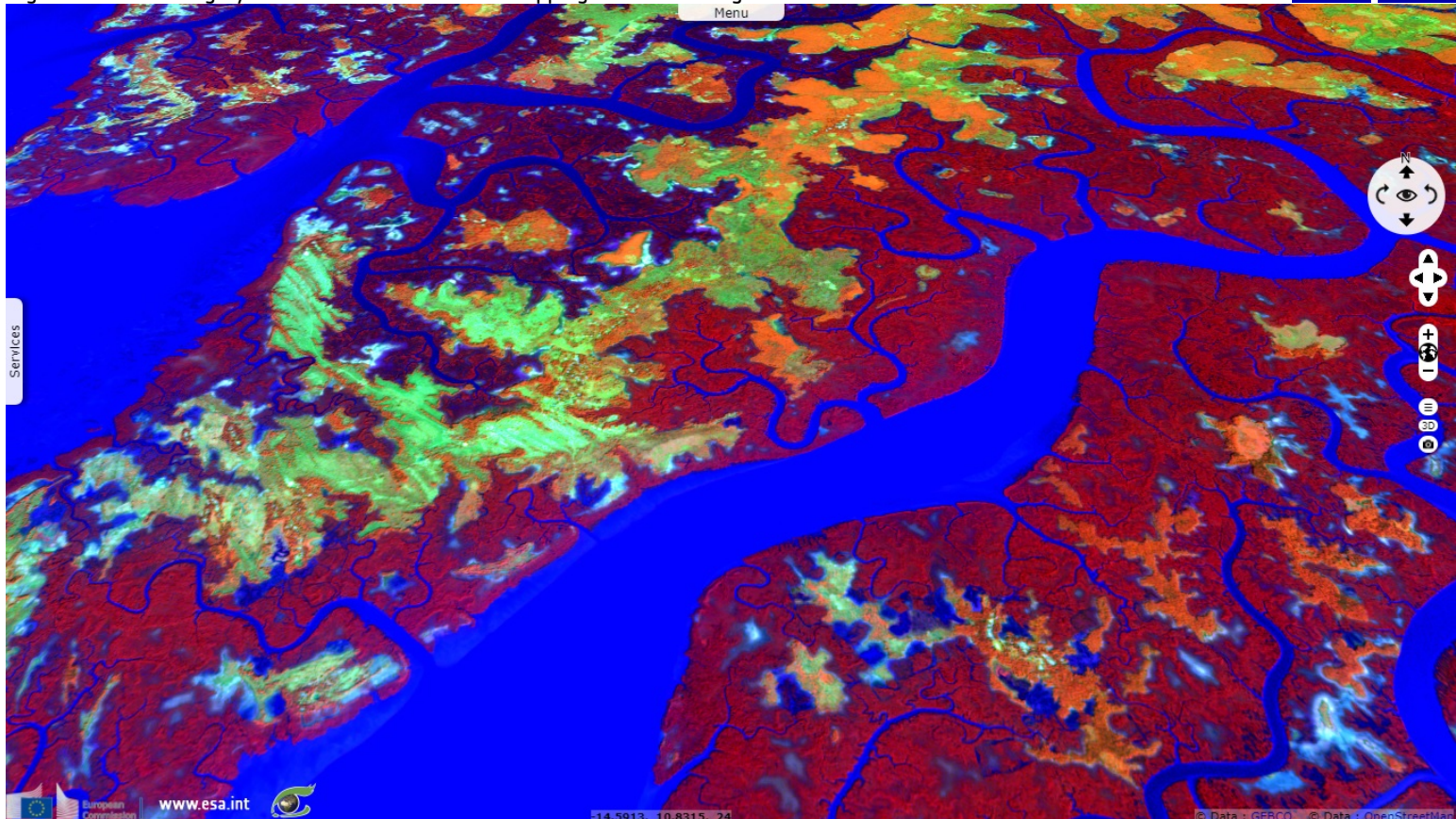


Fig. 3 - 11,8,4 Vegetation analysis colour composite - Intrusion of salt water in the lands through the mangroves.

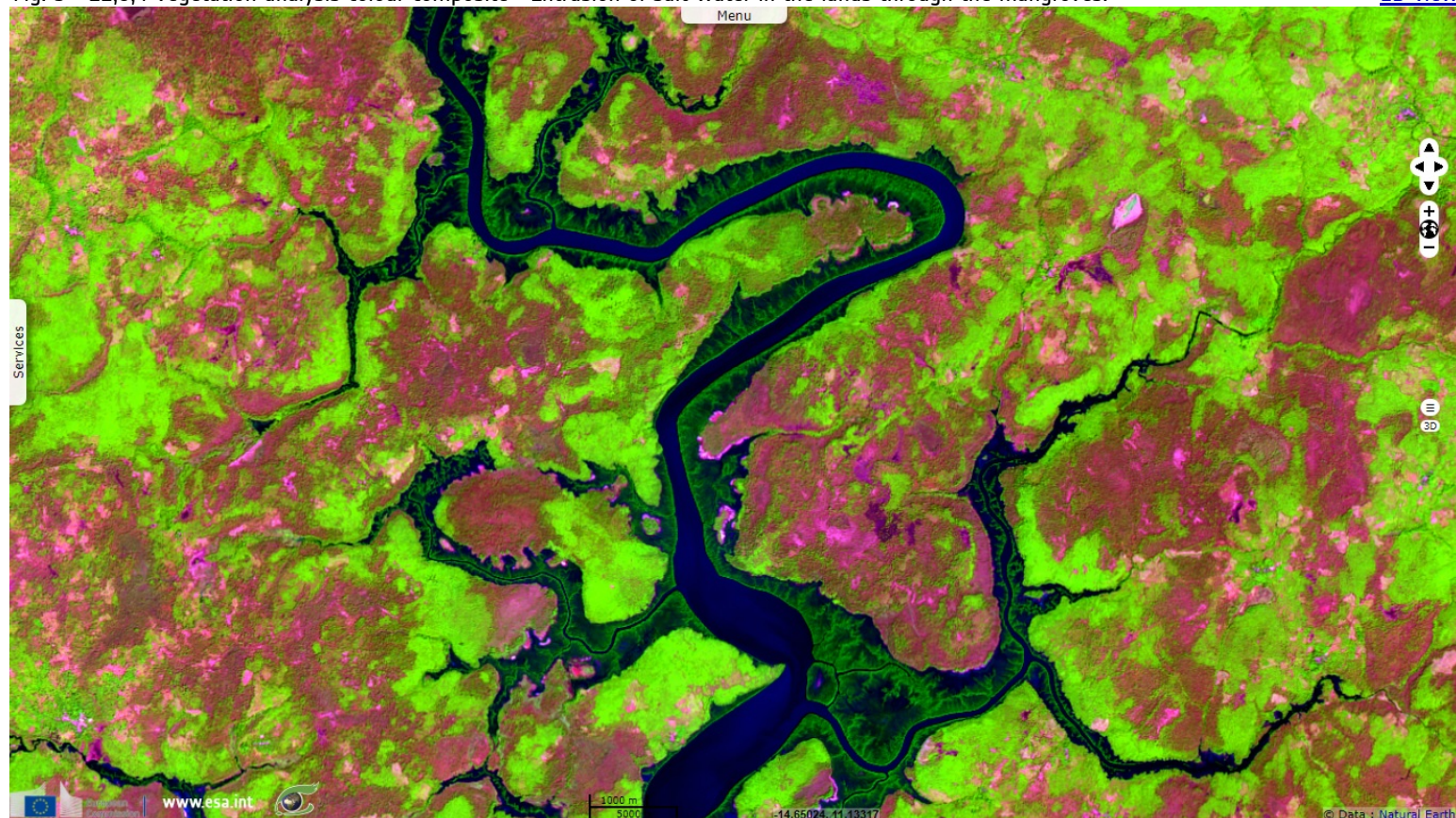


Fig. 4 - 8,4,3 colour composite - Boké, capital of the region, has grown on the banks of the Rio Nunez.
