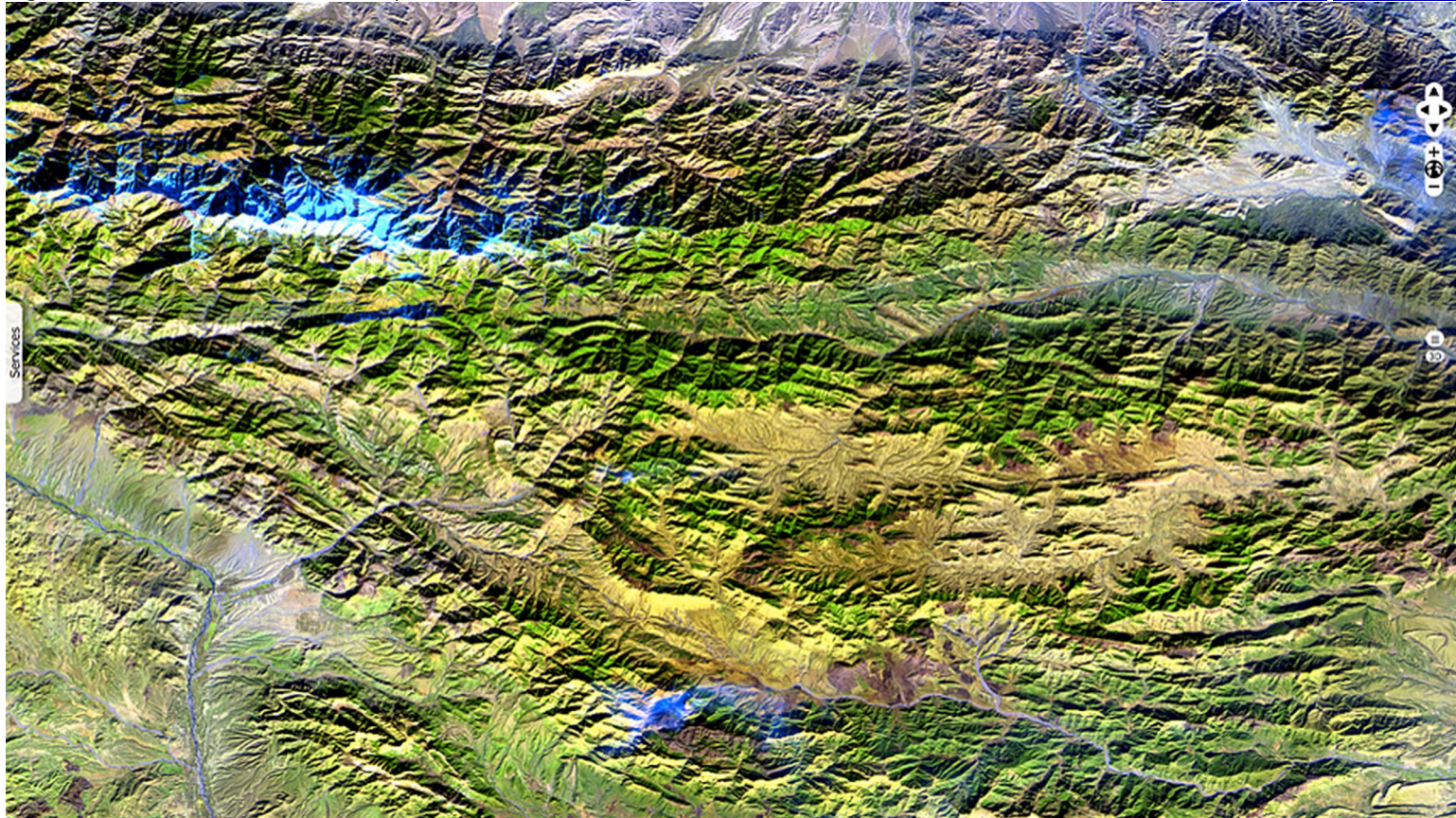


Fig. 2 - 19.01.2017 - Heavy snow and avalanches in January.

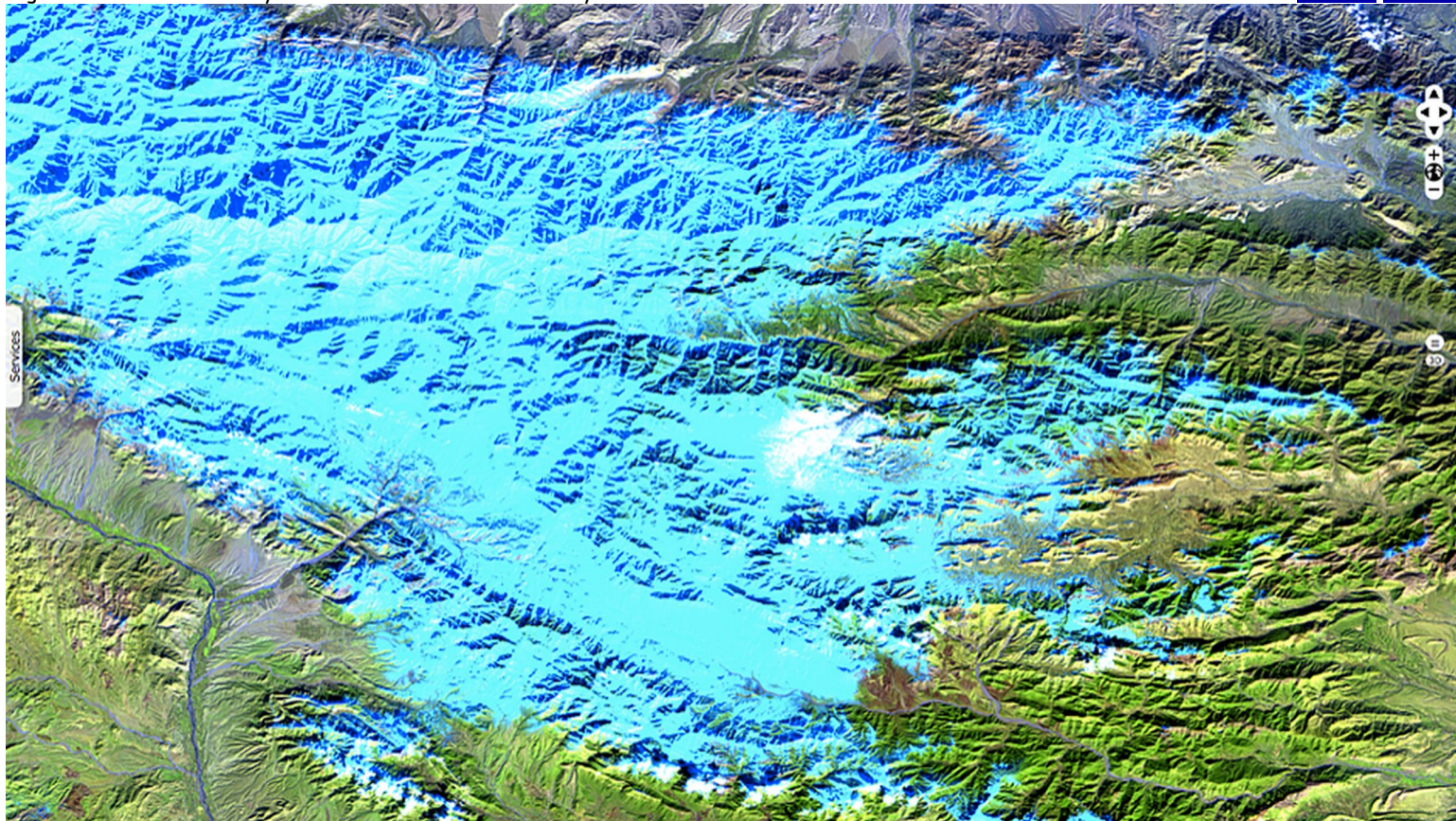


Fig. 3 - Normalised Difference Snow Index (NDSI) - NDI (bands 11,3) with polar lookup table.

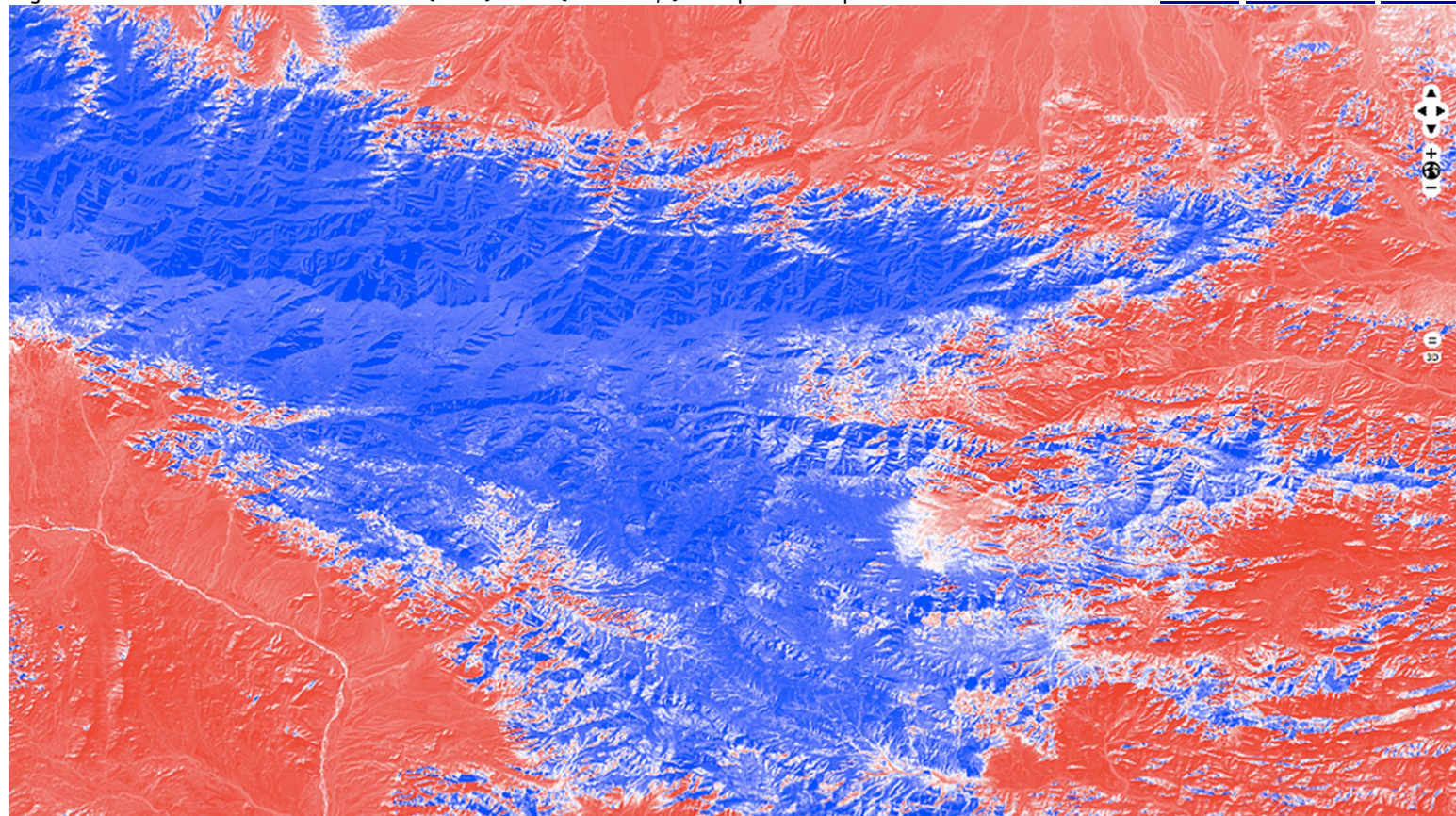
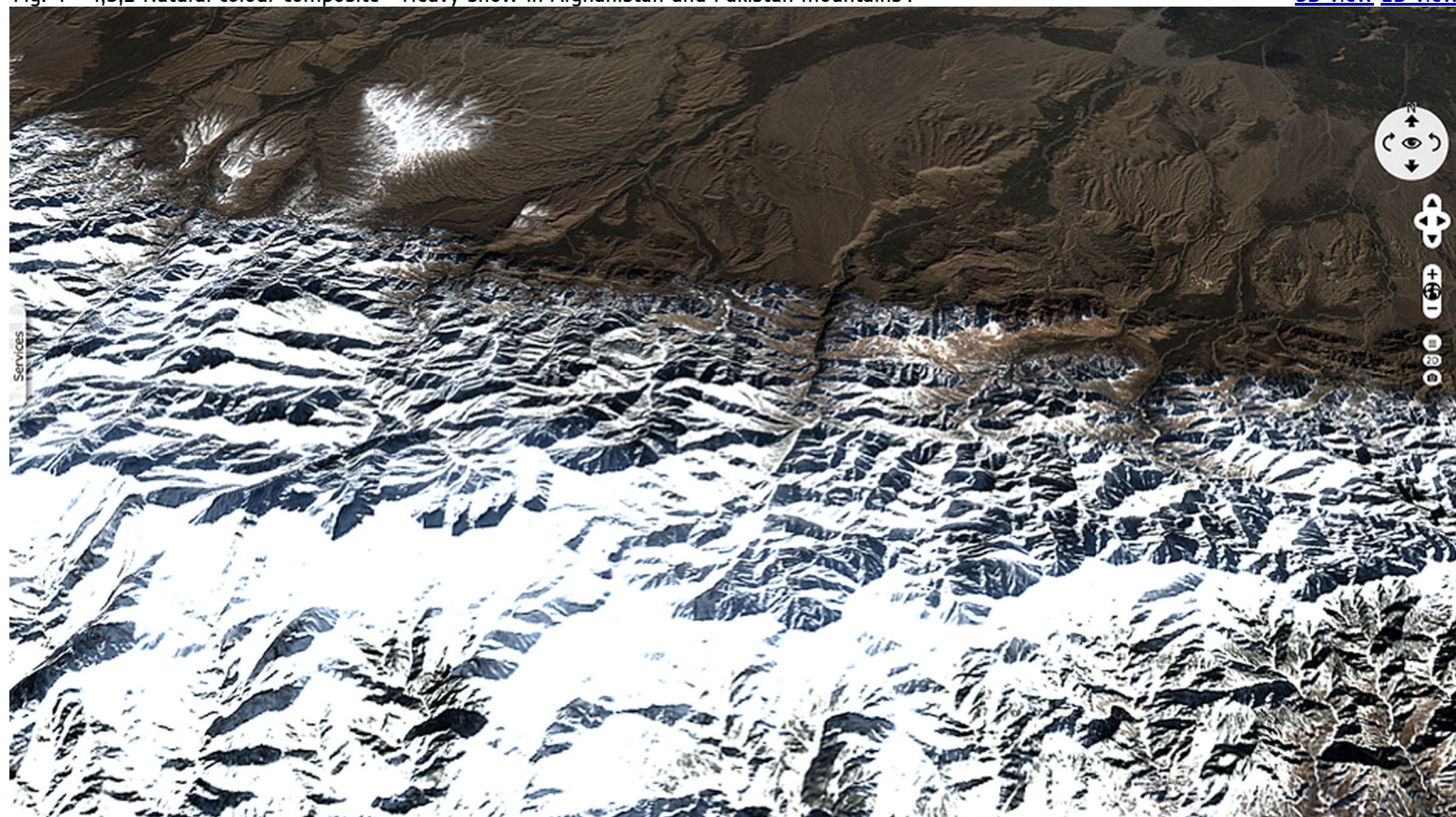


Fig. 4 - 4,3,2 Natural colour composite - Heavy snow in Afghanistan and Pakistan mountains'.
