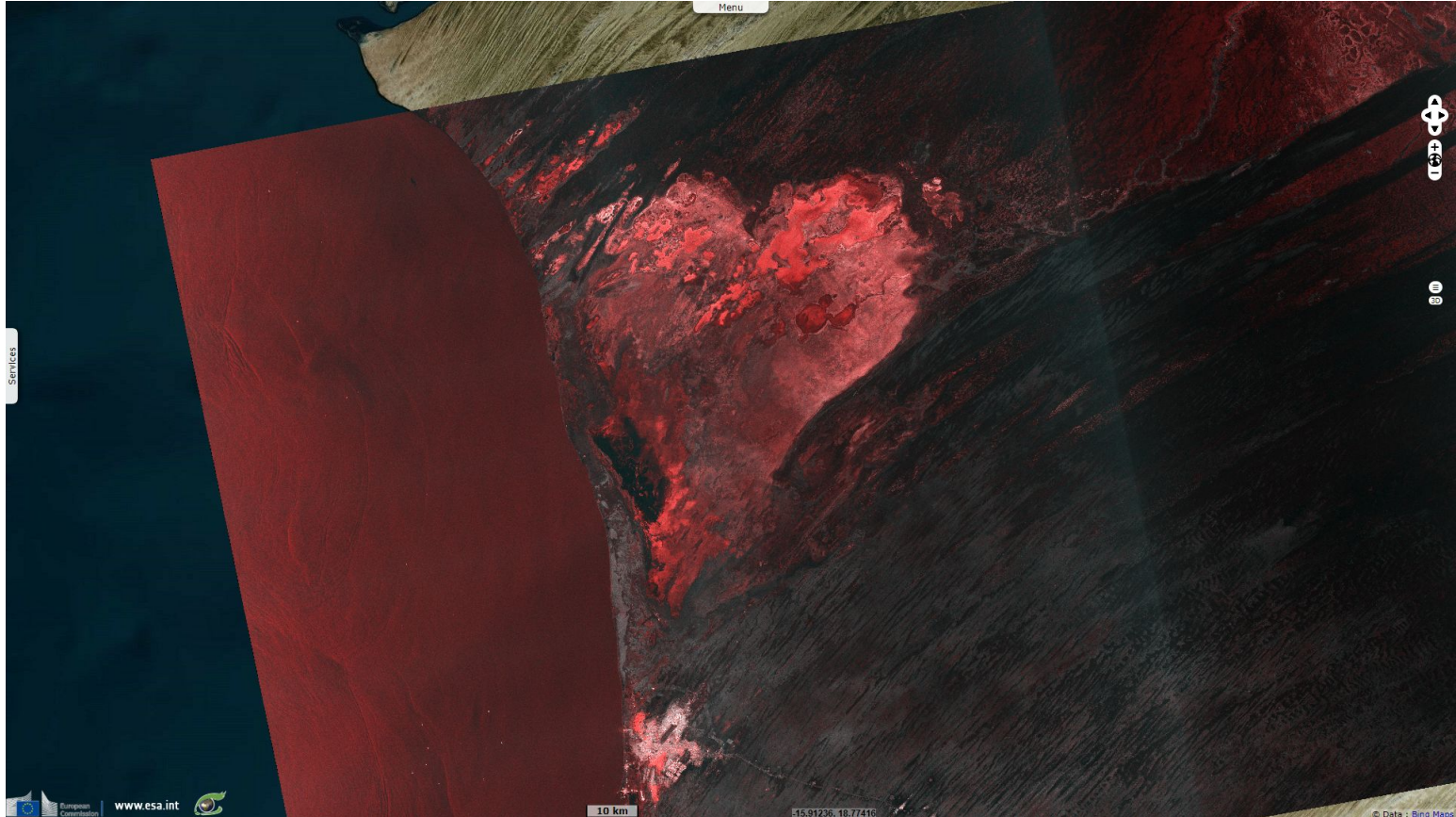


Fig. 2 - 25.08.2017 - Natural colour - Cœur de Voh (New Caledonia, France) was famed by the cover of the "Earth from Above" best-seller.

Earth from Above is a UN-supported ecological project ran by Yann Arthus-Bertrand. It led to a coffee table book, films & aerial photo exhibits.

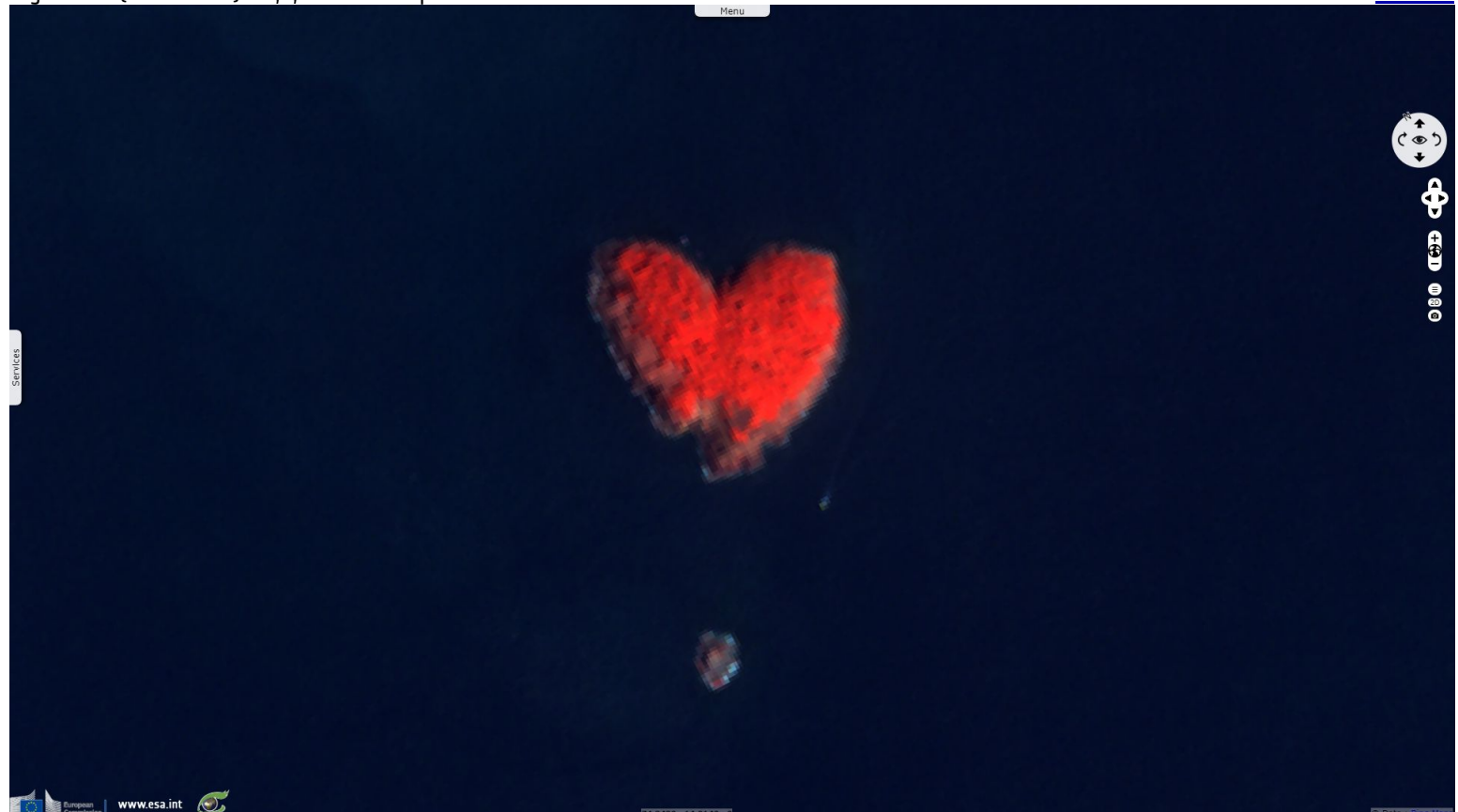
Fig. 3 - S1 (06.05.2018) - hh polarisation - Hollick-Kenyon Peninsula & Cape Agassiz in the Antarctic Peninsula.
