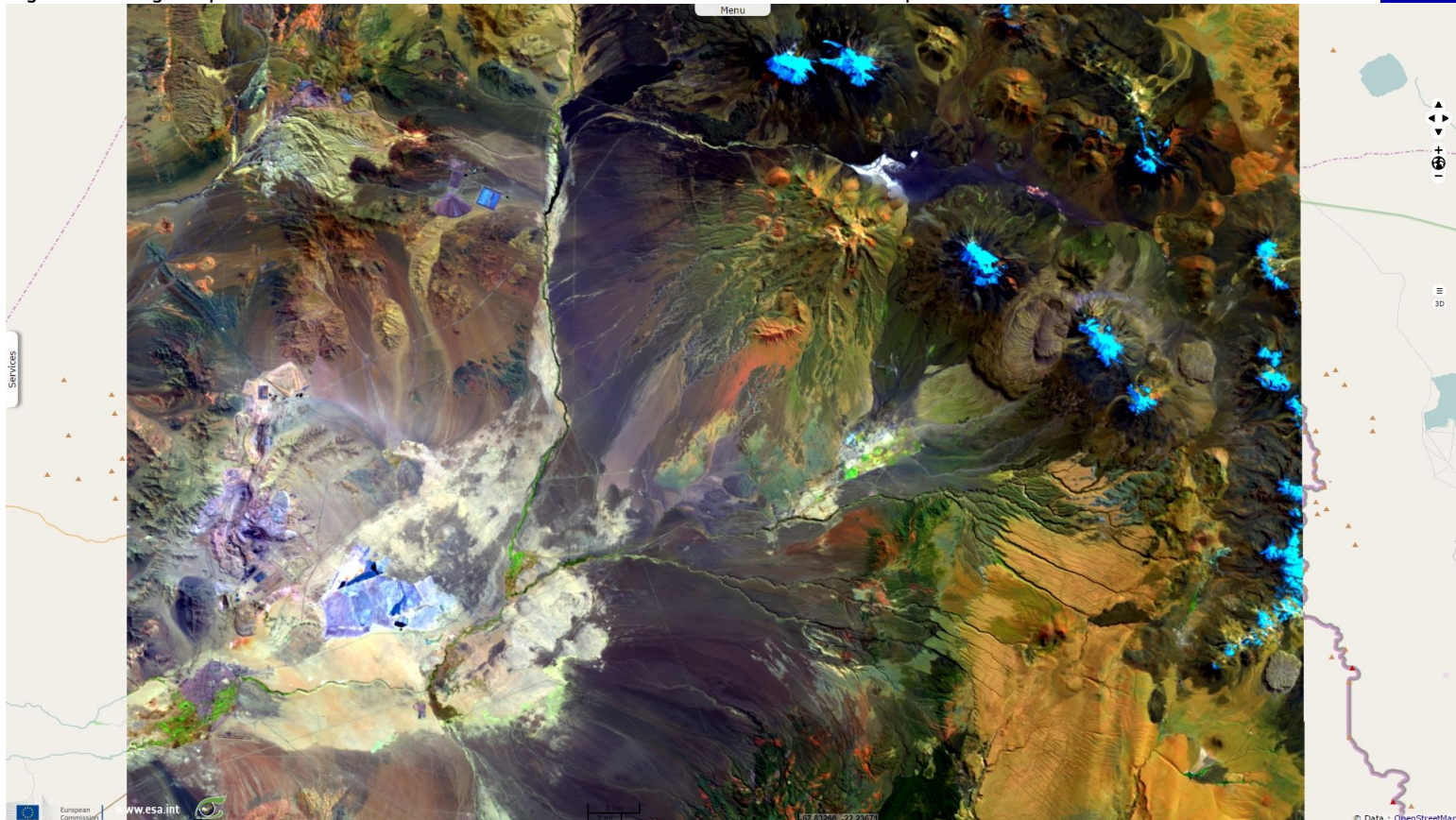


Fig. 2 - Global view of the dramatic scenery in 3D with the relief magnified with a 2x factor.

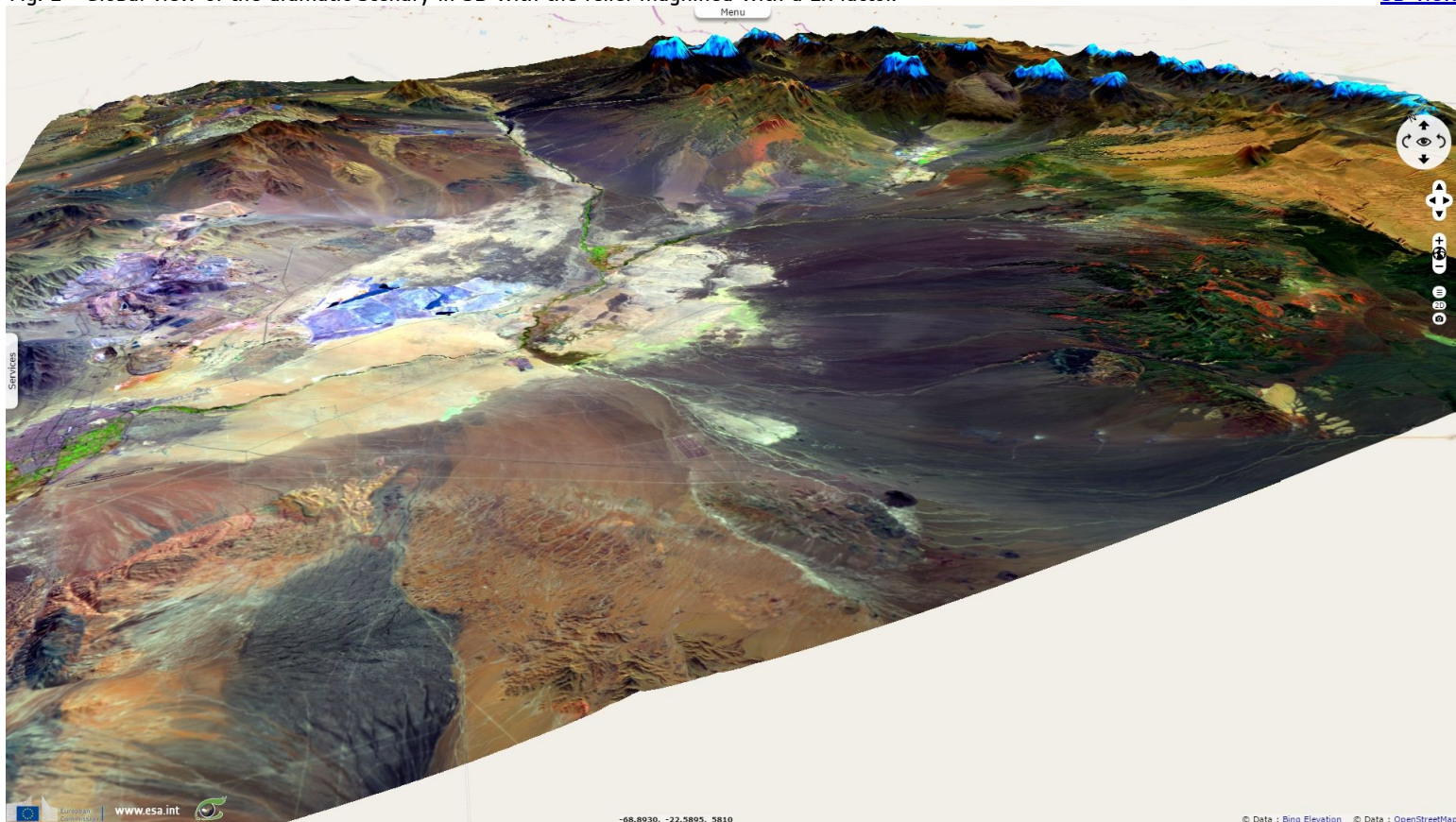


Fig. 3 - Zoom on the 4.3 km long and 3 km wide Chuquicamata, the Radomiro Tomic and the Mansa Mina copper mines.

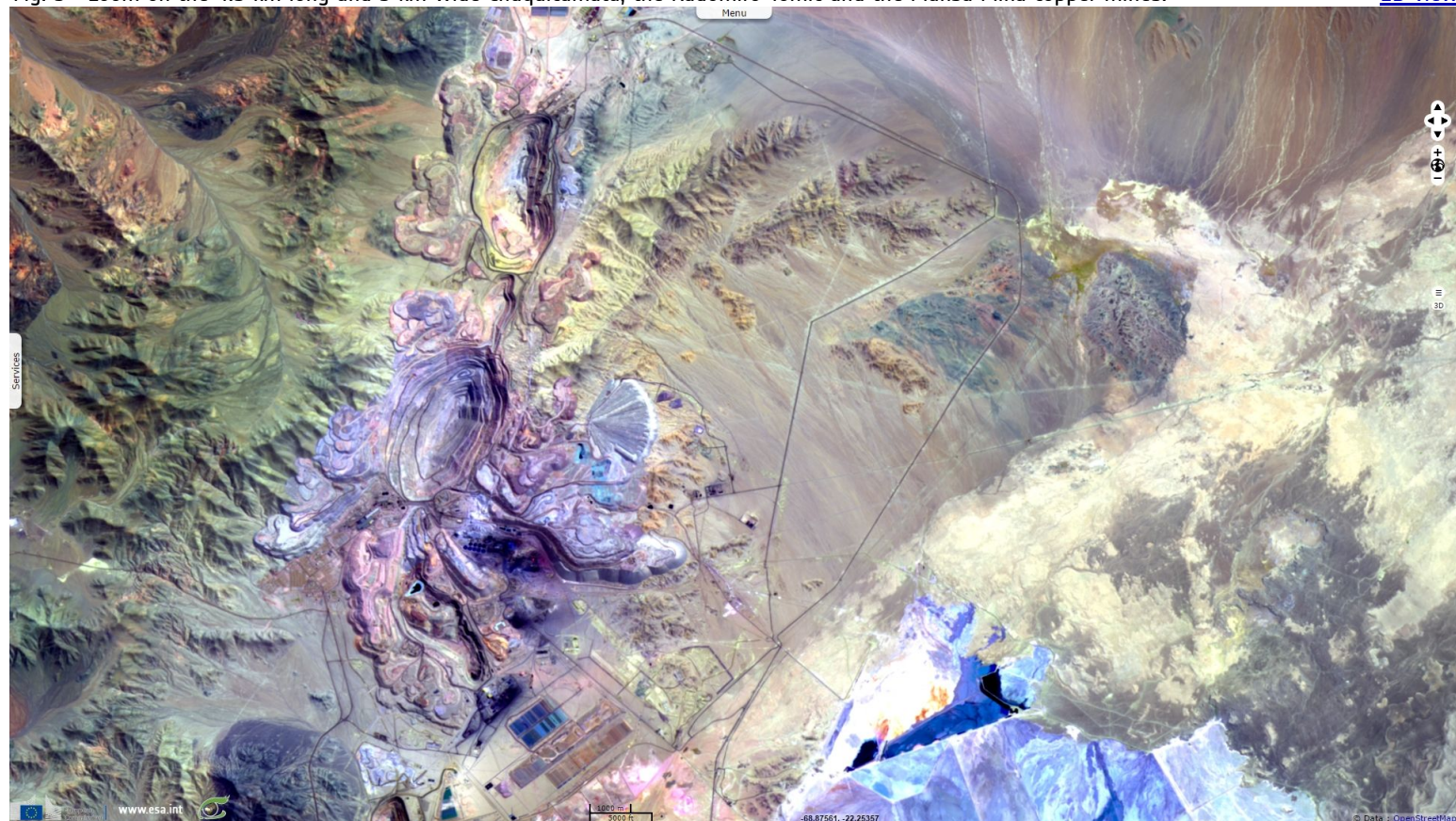
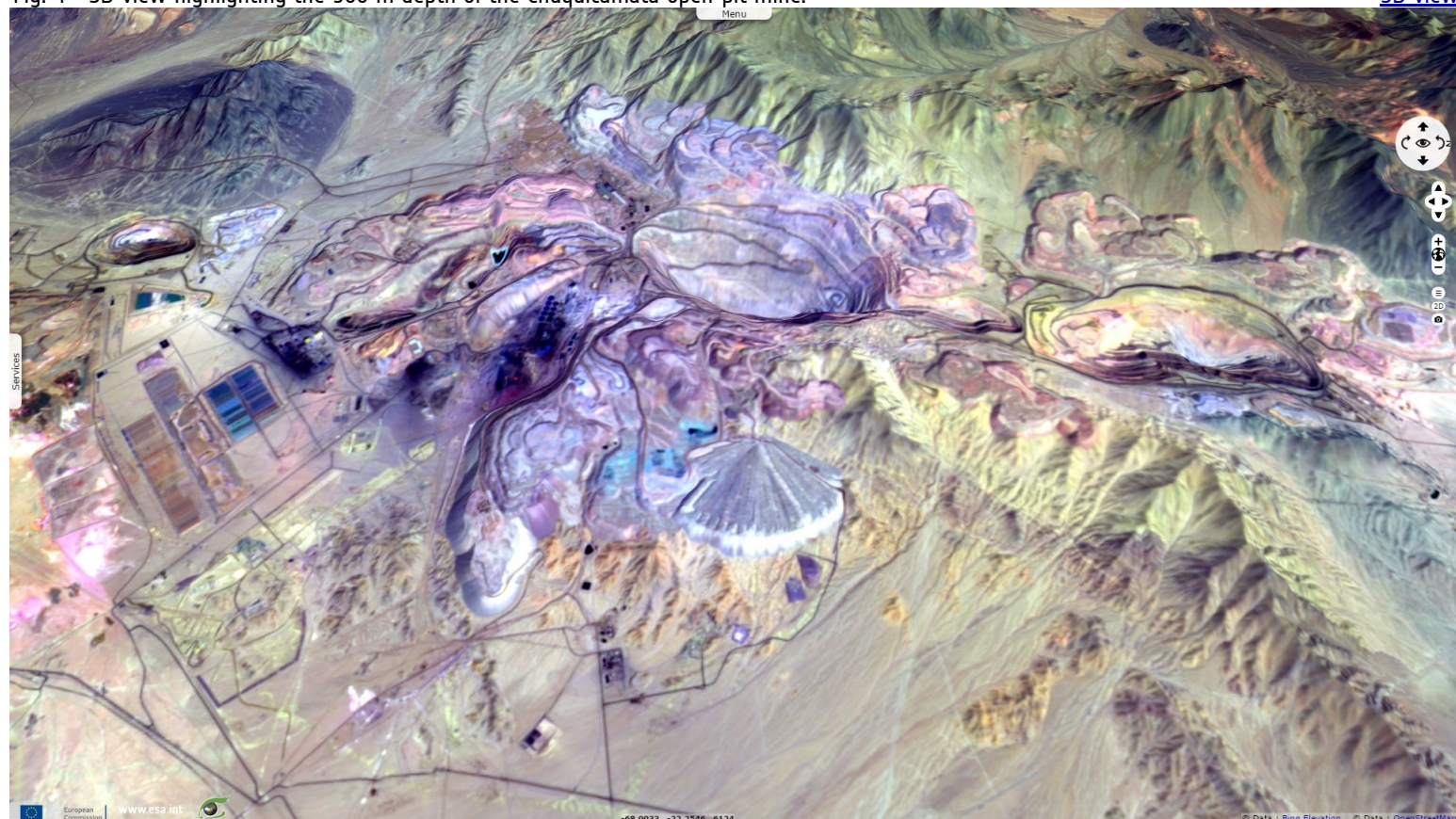


Fig. 4 - 3D view highlighting the 900 m depth of the Chuquicamata open-pit mine.
