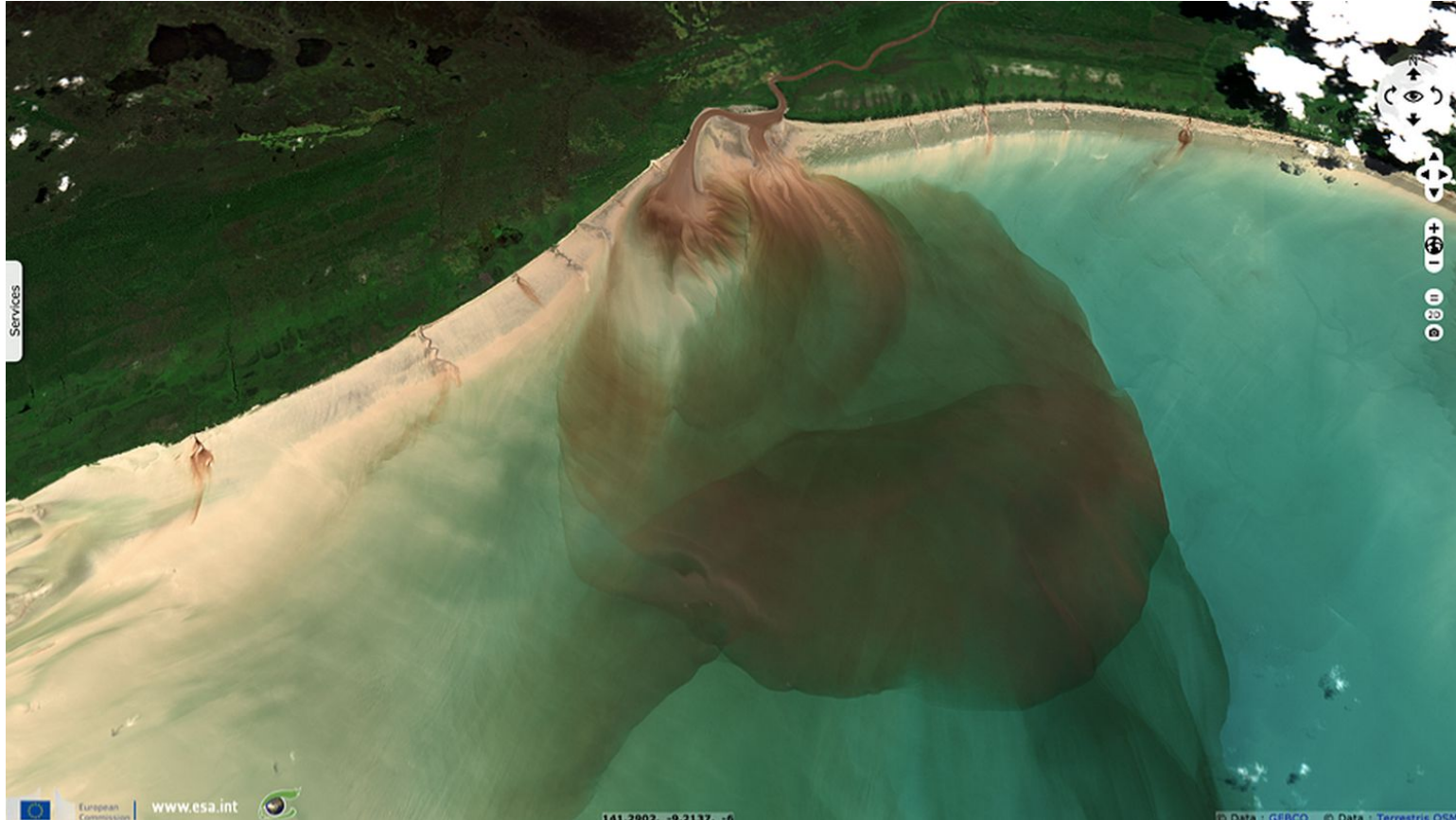


Fig. 2 - (12.02.2017) - 8,4,3 Vegetation colour composite - Mangroves near Kikori, eastern Papua New Guinea.

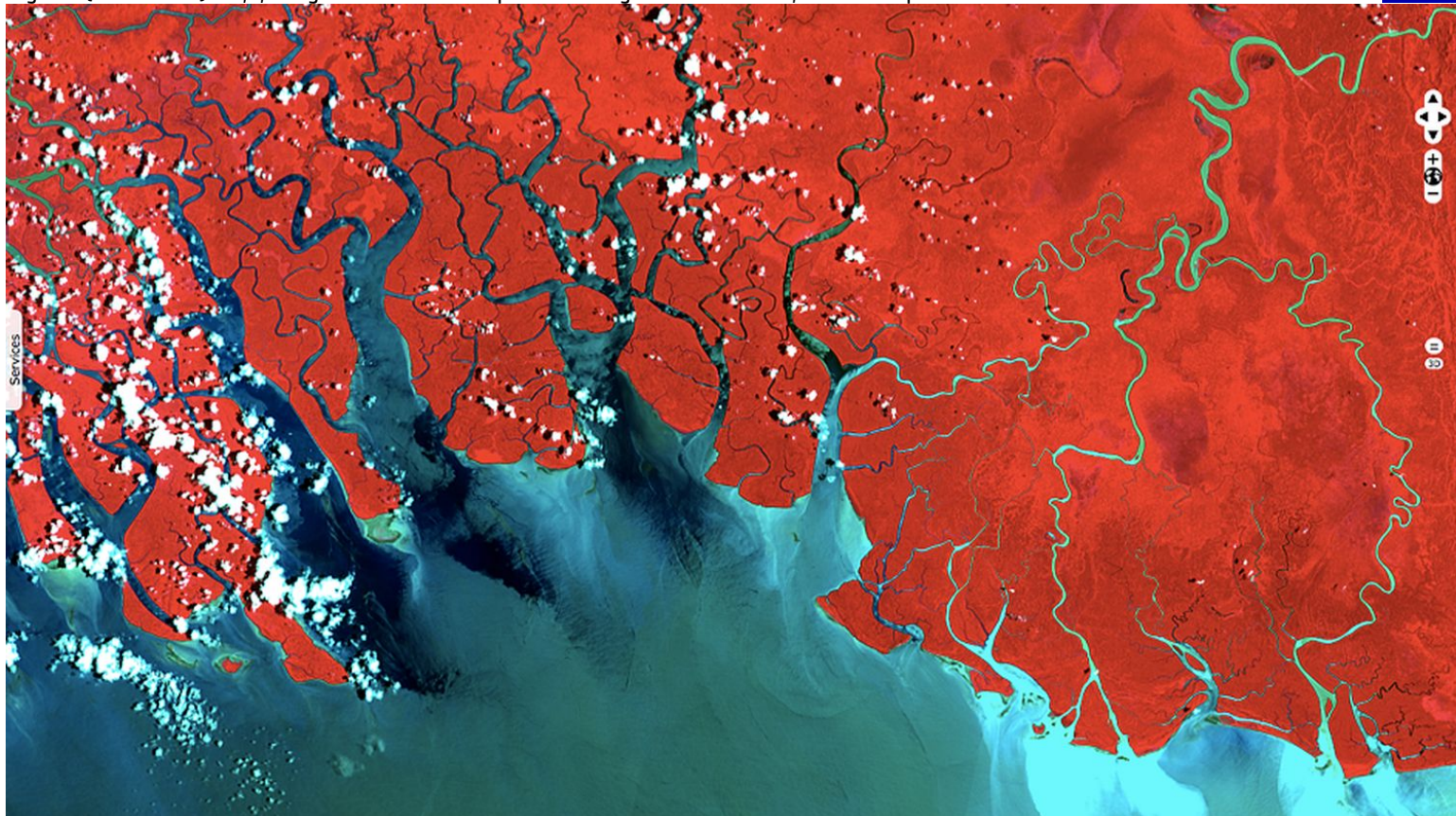


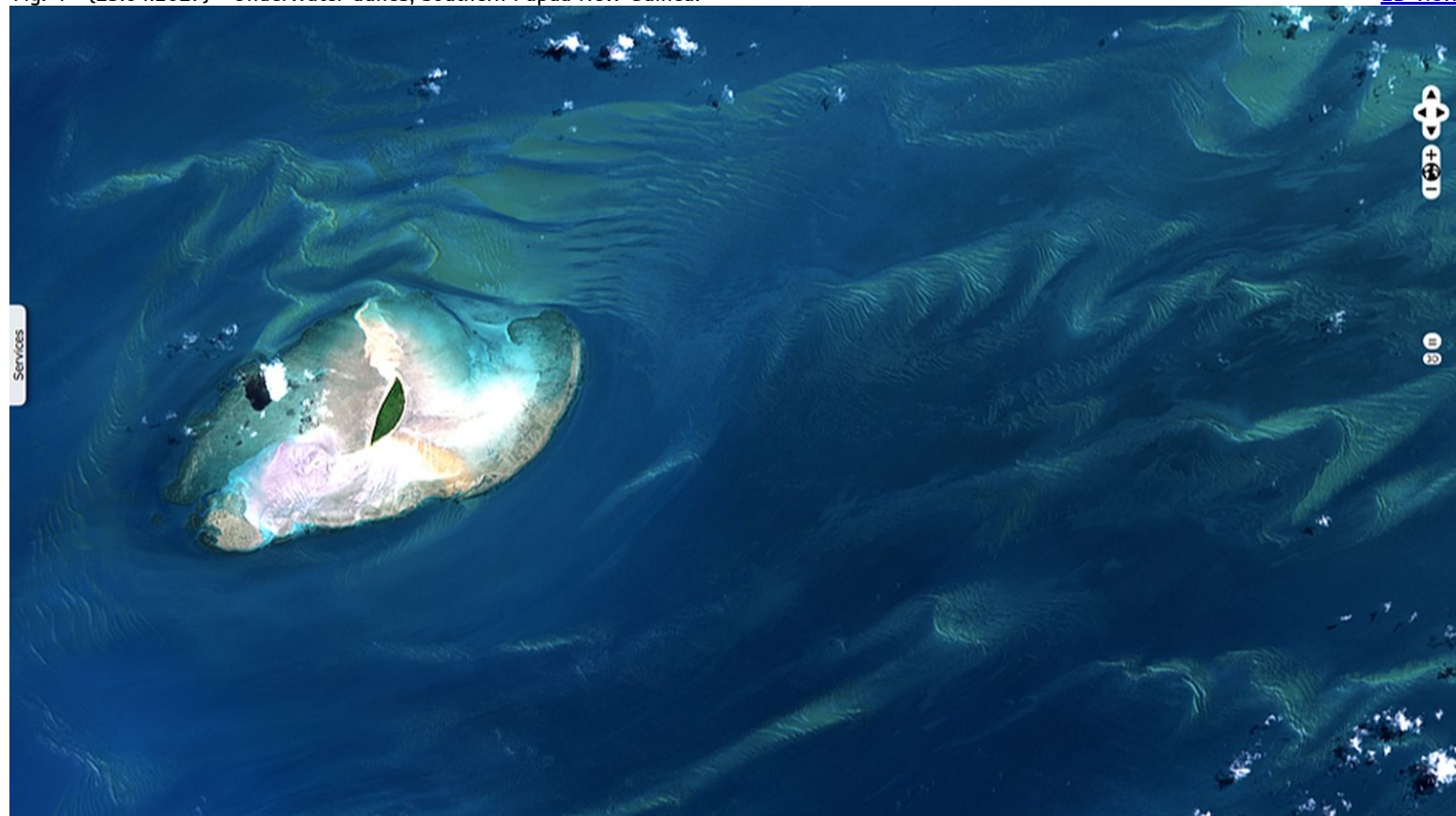
Fig. 3 - (12.12.2016) - 4,3,2 Natural colour composite - Underwater reef structures, Coral Sea.
