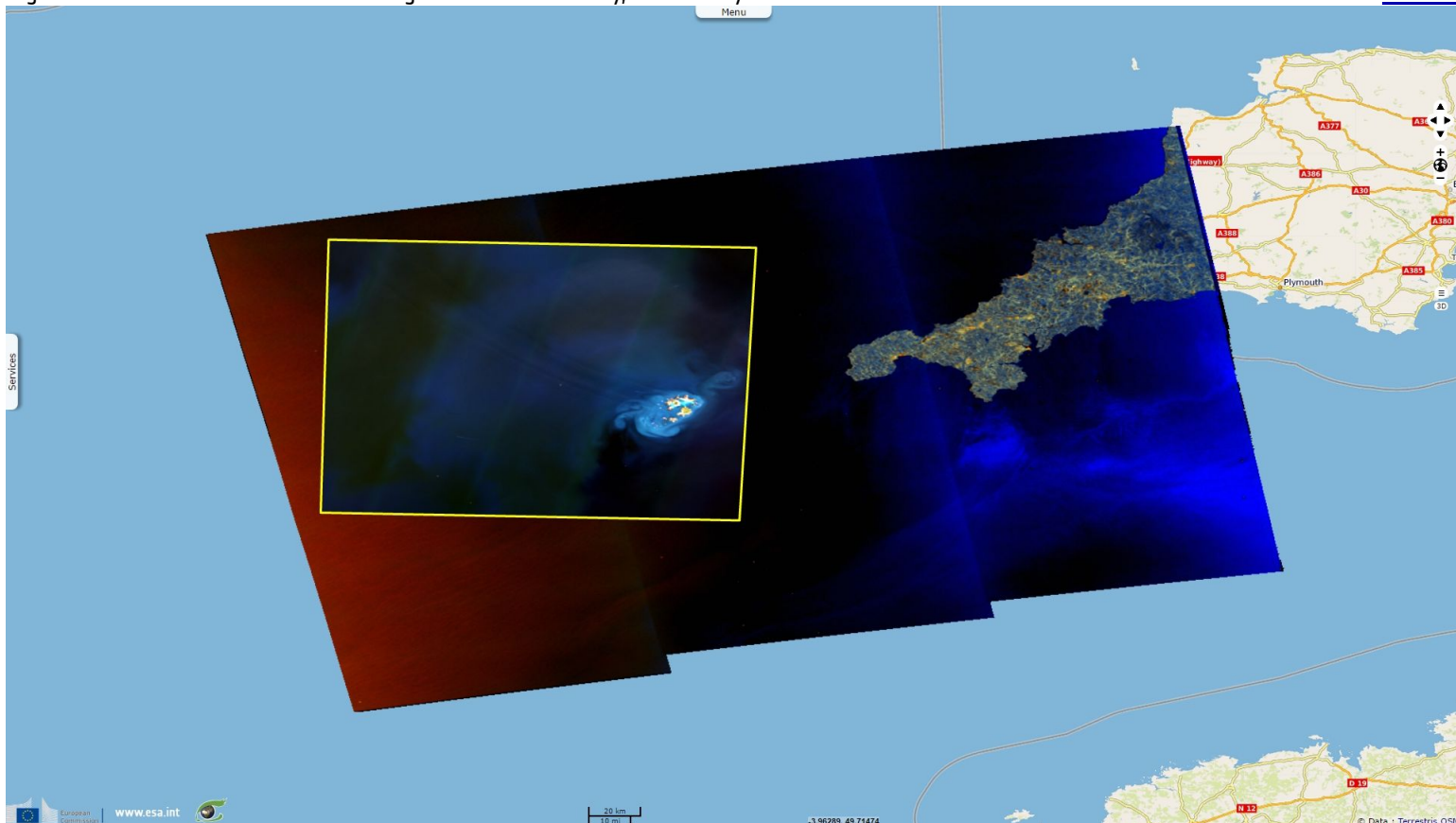


Fig. 2 - Close up view on Isles of Scilly, a Ramsar wetland with 6m tides - 4-3-2 Natural colour.

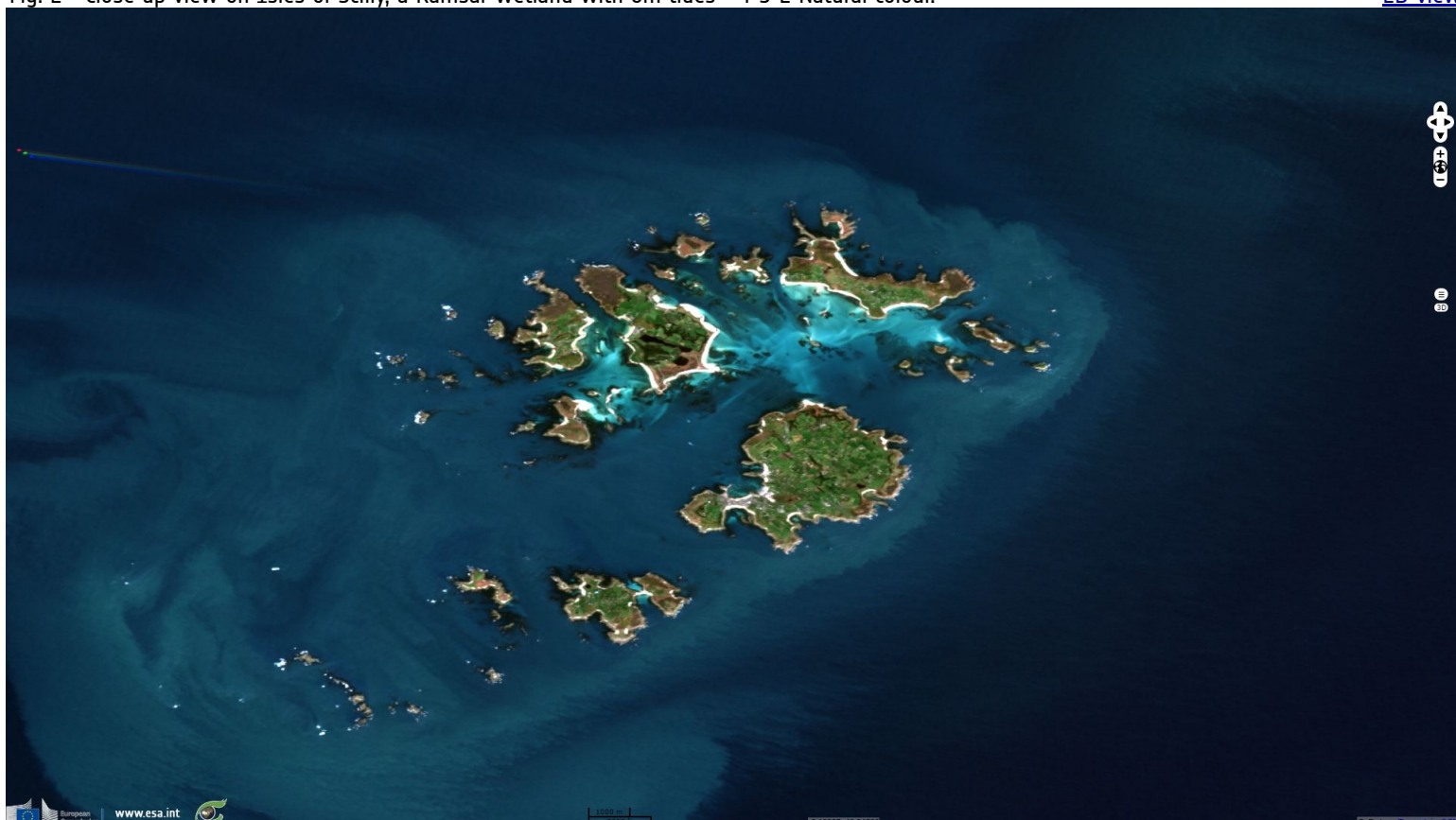


Fig. 3 - The mild climate allows a century-old tropical garden - 11-8A-2 colour composite.

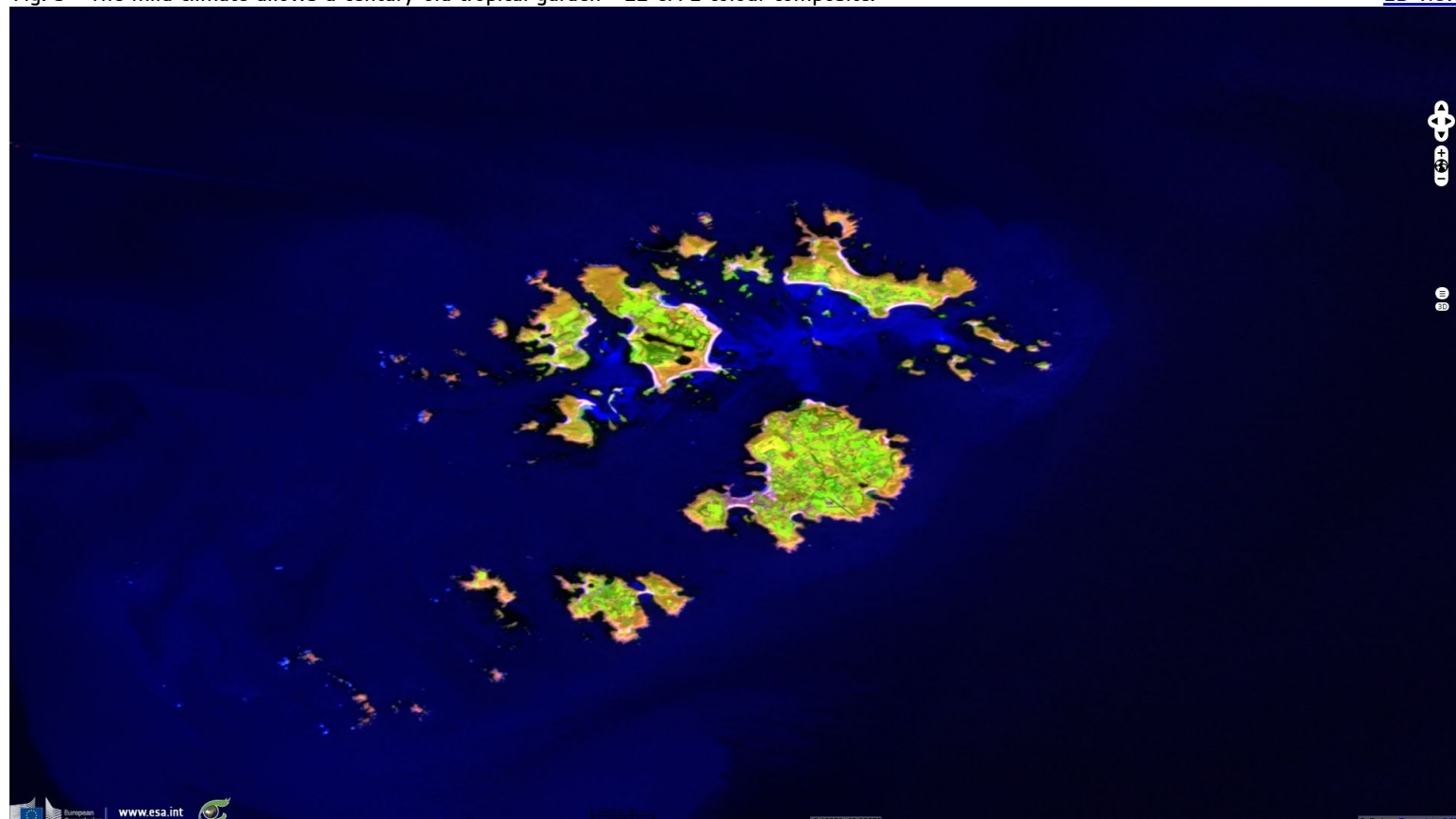
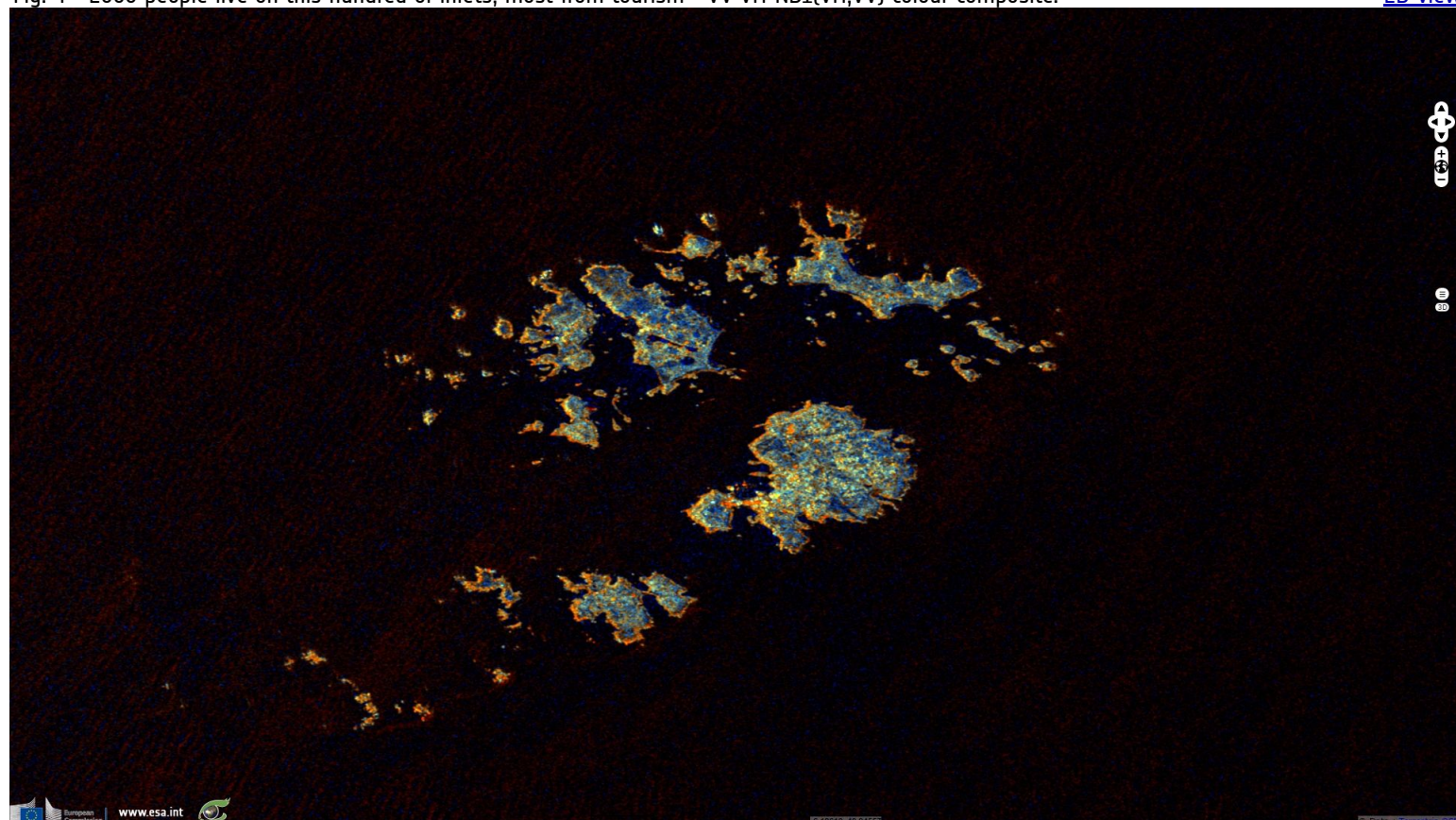


Fig. 4 - 2000 people live on this hundred of inlets, most from tourism - VV-VH-NDI(VH,VV) colour composite.
