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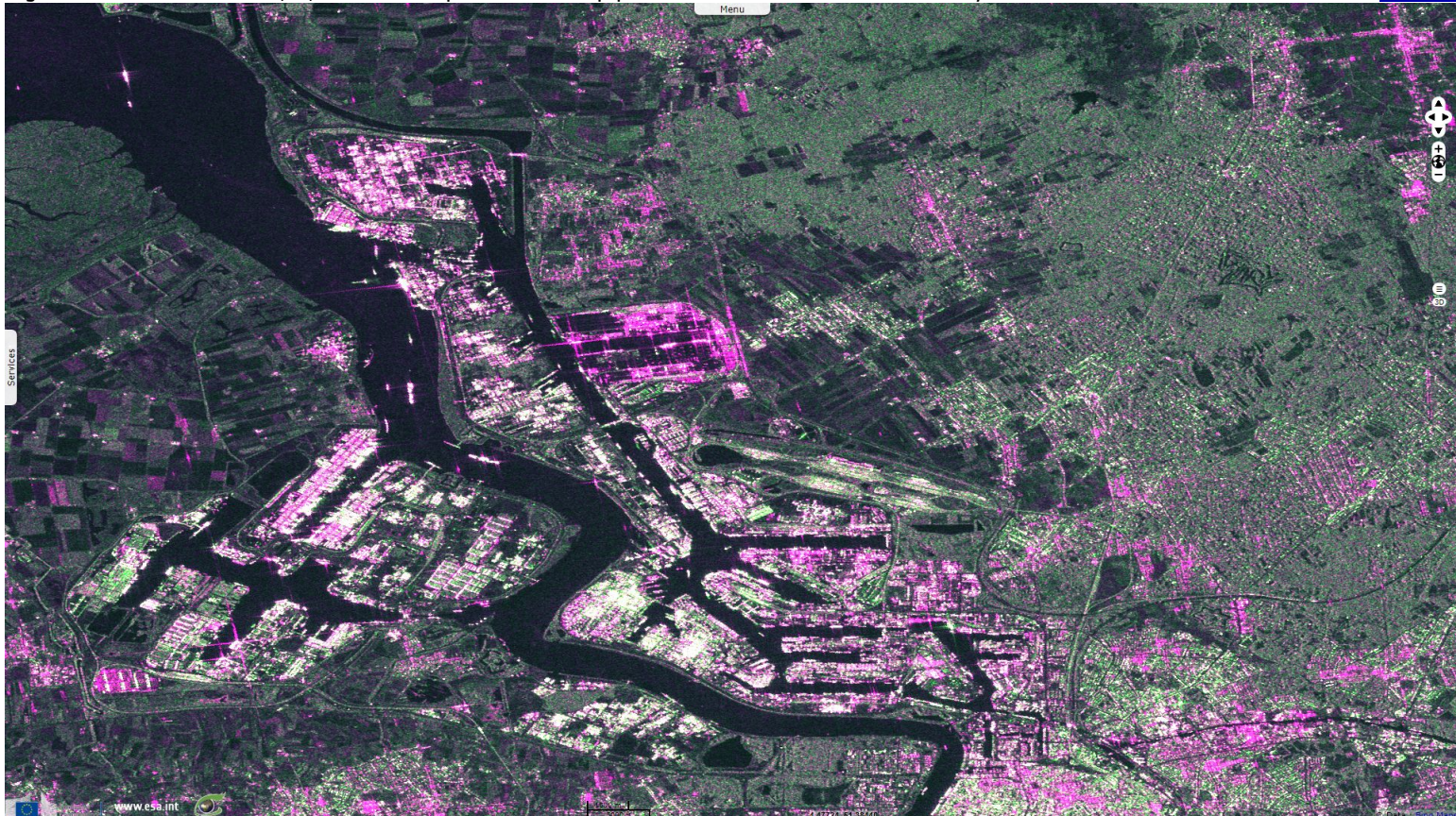

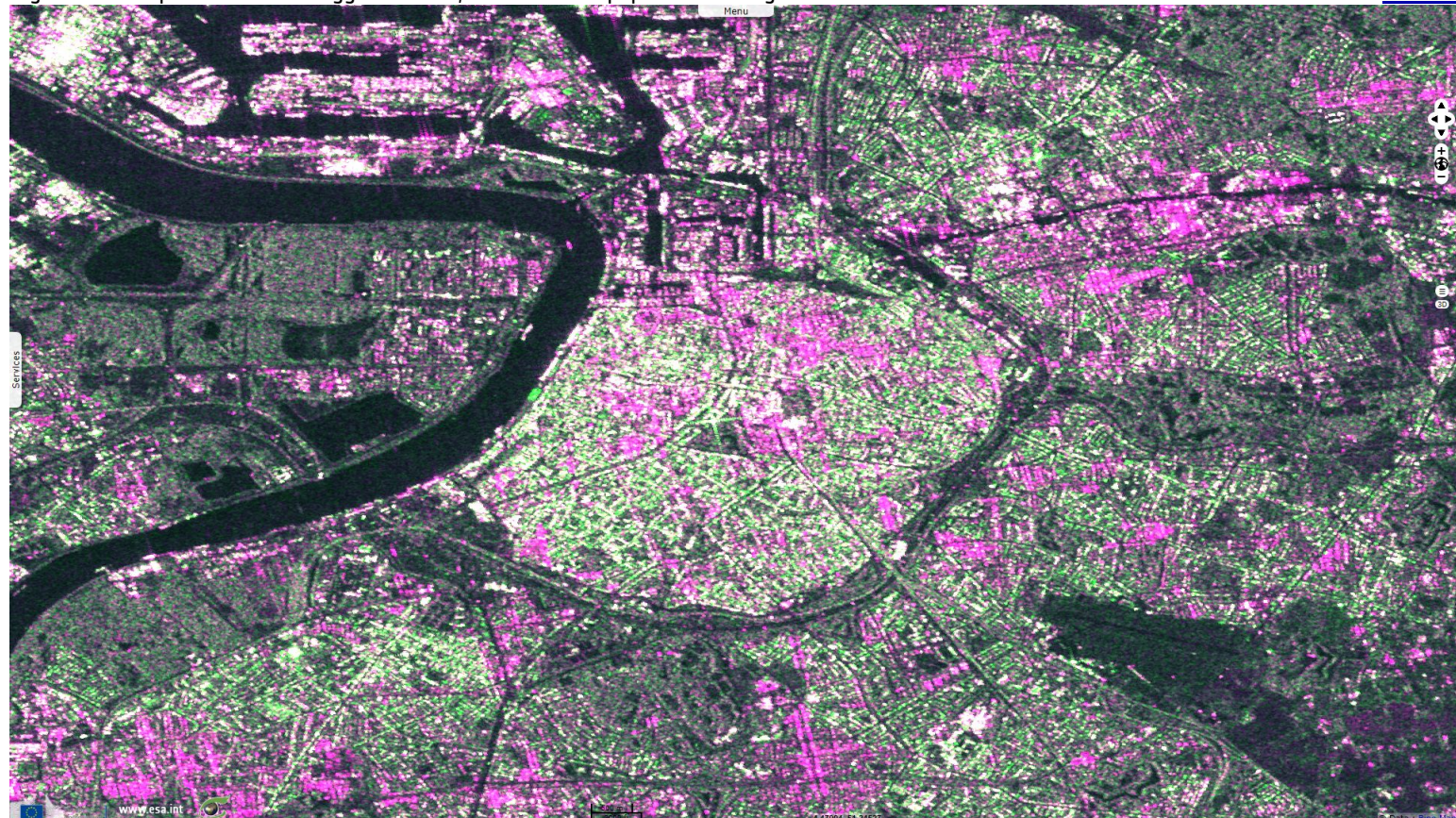


Fig. 4 - 4,3,2 natural colour - At east another canal to the Meuse leads to Maastricht
