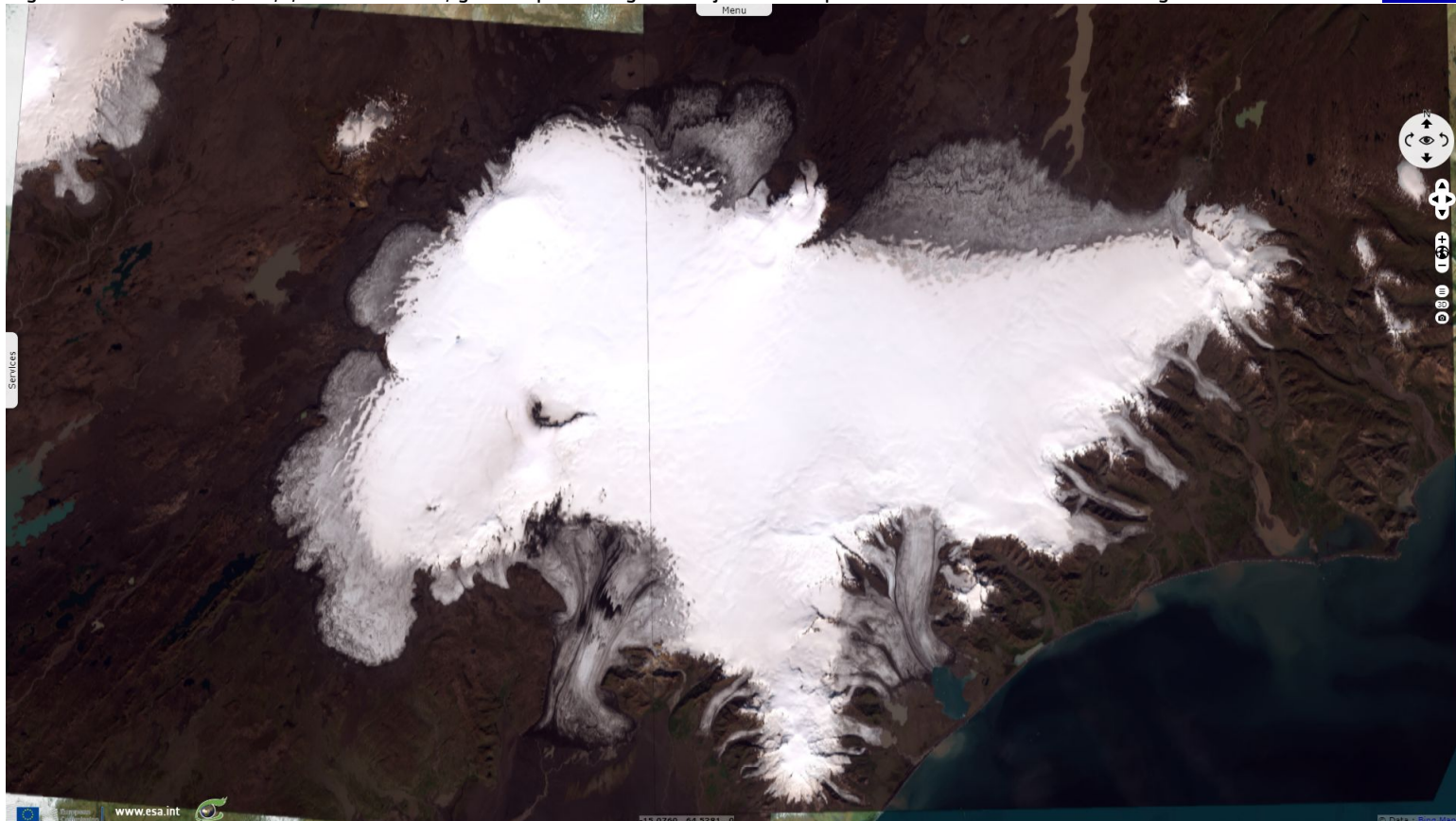


Fig. 2 - 8,4,2 colour composite, gamma processing - The NIR band reveals the presence of vegetation and nuances in ice colour.

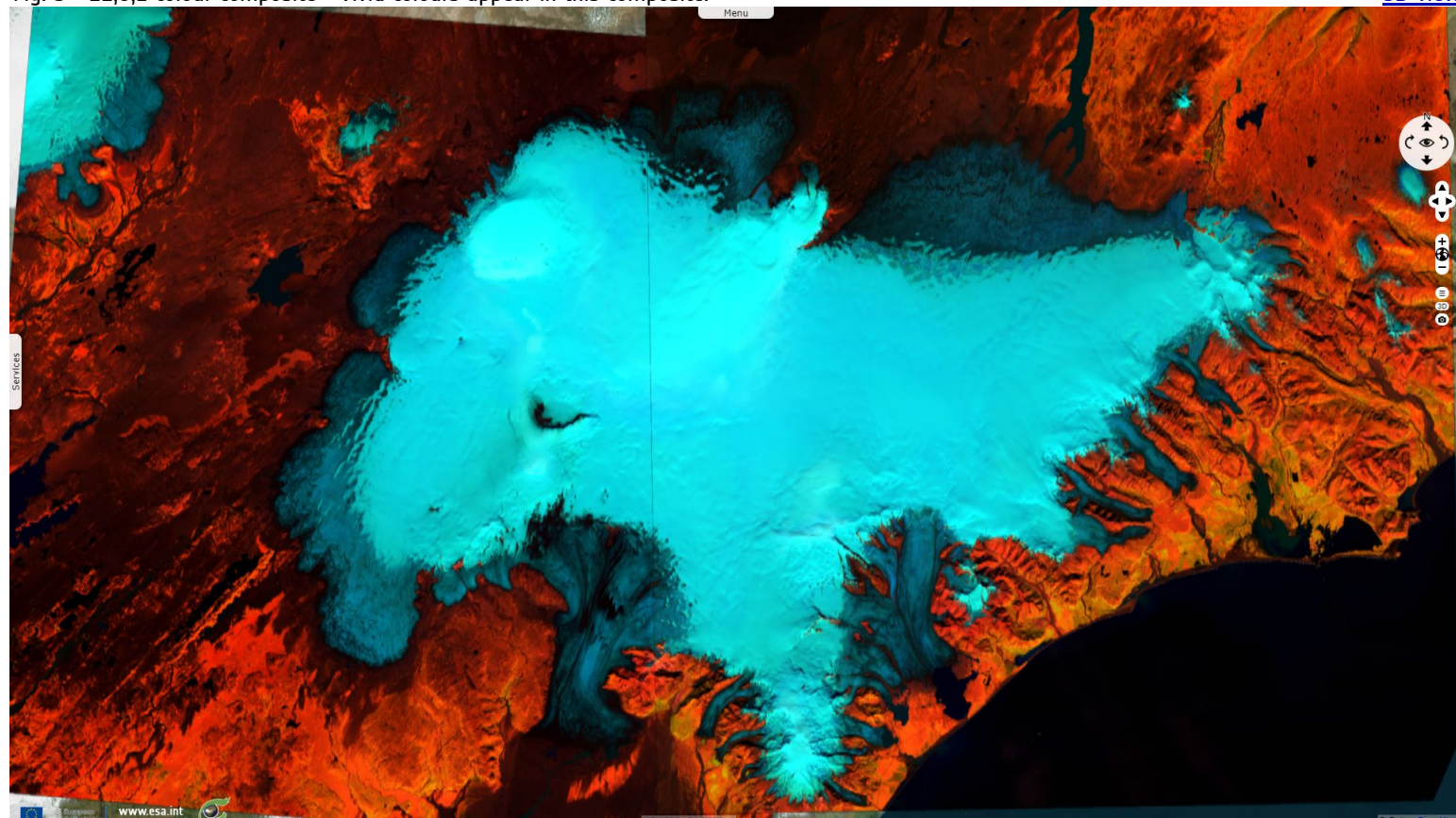
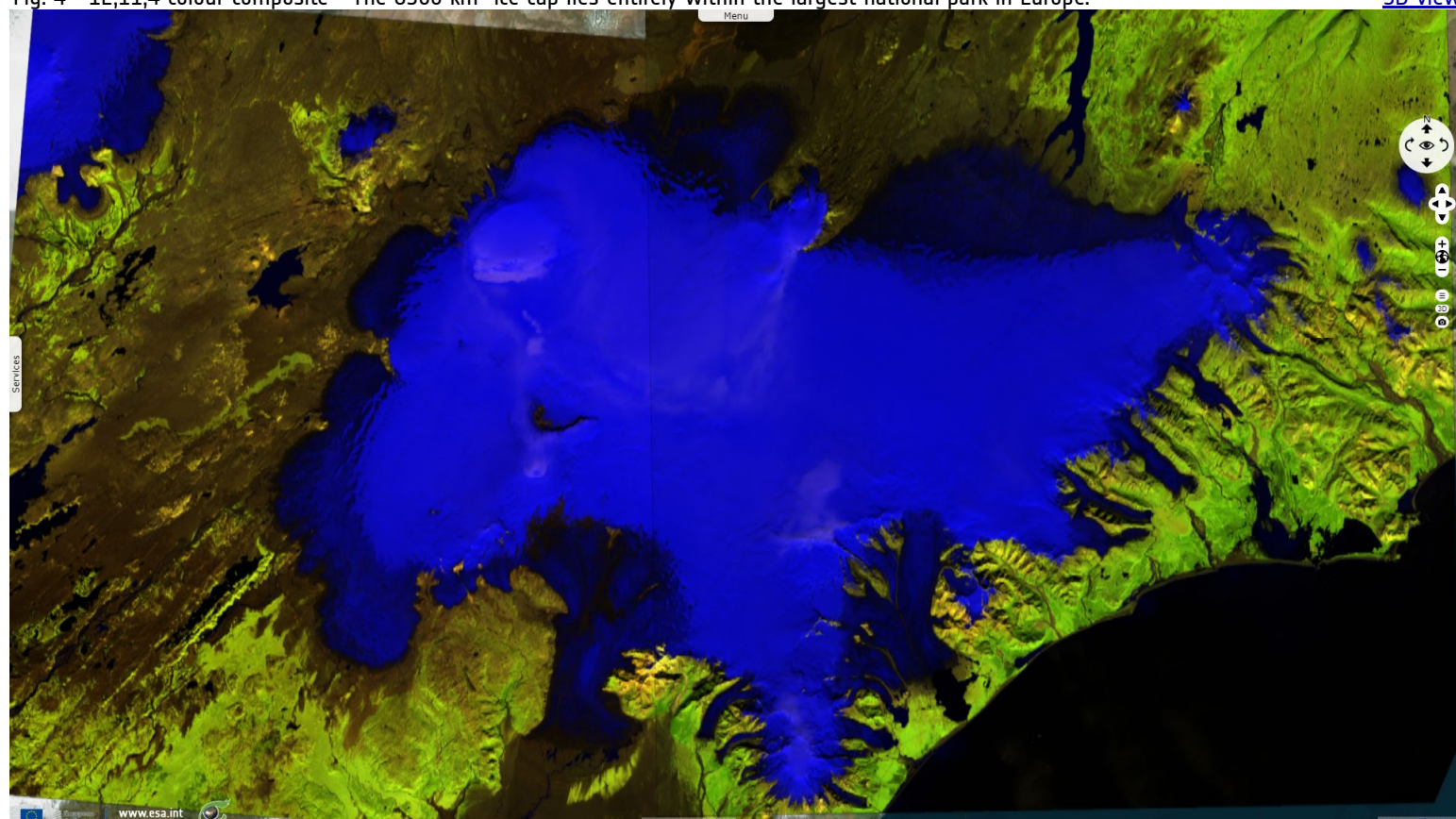


Fig. 4 - 12,11,4 colour composite - The 8300 km² ice cap lies entirely within the largest national park in Europe.
